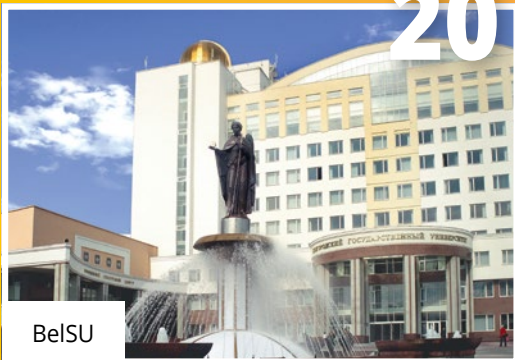

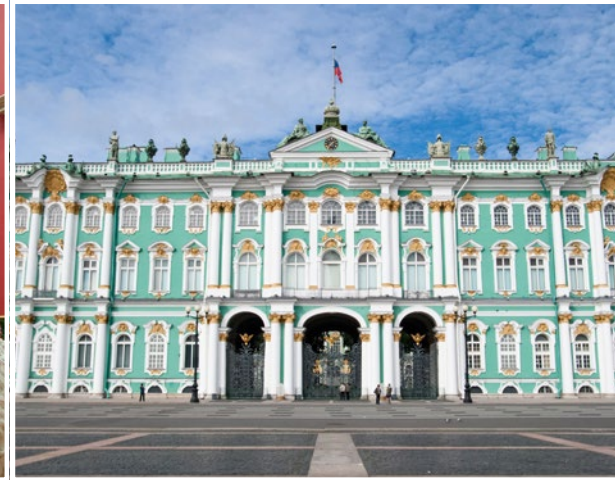

Darwin Museum

📍 Moscow, Russia

In one of our last issues, we already gave a review of the most popular cultural sites in Moscow, the capital of Russia. Today we want to tell you about the largest natural history museum in Europe – the State Darwin Museum.

The museum's richest exhibition consists of more than 400,000 items and tells us about the evolution theory development history, the diversity of life on Earth, variation and heredity, natural selection and struggle for existence in nature.

Today it is one of the most popular museum complexes in the capital of Russia. More than 600,000 people visit it every year. Now we will tell you how the Darwin Museum was founded and why you should definitely visit it when in Moscow.

STORY BEHIND

The Darwin Museum was founded on October 7, 1907 by biologist Aleksandr Kots. Interestingly, the year when the scientist was invited to teach the Darwinian theory to the attendees of the Higher Women's Courses is considered the date of its foundation. The museum exhibition started with a rich personal collection of rare taxidermied animals that Kots collected from the very beginning of his research.

Aleksandr Kots' wife, zoologist Nadezhda Lodygina shared his passion for science and helped him make and organize the museum collection.

Initially, the Darwin Museum had no building of its own. As the number of exhibits was increasing, the issue of construction of a separate museum building with storage and exhibition rooms was getting more and more pressing. However, the museum managed to implement the construction project only in 1994.

ABOUT THE EXHIBITIONS

The exhibition areas are 5,000 m². The exhibitions presented at the museum cover a huge area of scientific knowledge of the evolution process, the diversity of life on Earth, variation and heredity of species, natural selection and struggle for existence.

Interestingly, the museum collections consist not only of the taxidermied animals and fossil remains of animals, including extinct ones, but also of the works of art by animal painters and sculptors. There is an outstanding collection of natural history books, including rare and unique copies of *On the Origin of Species* by Charles Darwin and *The History of Snakes and Dragons* by Ulisse Aldrovandi.

Today the museum makes active use of the interactive multimedia models. Visitors have access to the halls with the moving animal models, audio- and video transmissions, living insects, attractions, and quests. Every week you can attend lectures and meet well-known scientists and travelers at the Darwin Museum venues.





The Russian Museum

📍 Saint Petersburg, Russia

The Russian Museum is the world's largest museum of Russian art, a unique architectural and artistic complex in the historic center of Saint Petersburg.

Russia's first state museum of Russian fine arts was established in 1898 by order of Emperor Nicholas II. To organize exhibitions and collections, the museum was given the Mikhailovsky Palace with the adjacent areas and buildings such as the side wings and garden.

The Russian Museum collection was made up of the objects and works of art handed over from the Winter, Gatchina and Alexander Palaces, the Academy of Arts, and the Hermitage. A good part of the museum collection consisted of the exhibits donated by the private individuals.



Today the museum collection consists of more than 440,000 exhibits and covers all historic periods and trends in the development of Russian art, main arts and genres, movements and schools over more than 1,000 years.

- **The Old Russian Art** is represented by the icons of the 12th–15th centuries, the works by Andrei Rublev, Dionysius, Simon Ushakov, and other masters.
- **The Collection of Fine Arts of the 18th Century – the First Half of the 19th Century** is represented by the works by Karl Bryullov, Dmitry Levitsky, Carlo Rastrelli, Orest Kiprensky, Fyodor Bruni, and many others.
- **The Second Half of the 19th Century** includes the works by world-famous artists such as Fyodor Vasilyev, Illarion Pryanishnikov, Alexei Savrasov, Alexander Morozov, Ivan Aivazovsky, Ivan Shishkin, Ilya Repin, Viktor Vasnetsov, Vasily Surikov.
- **The Collection of the End of the 19th Century – the Beginning of the 20th Century** comprises the works by Isaac Levitan, Mikhail Vrubel, Valentin Serov, Alexandre Benois, Boris Kustodiev, Nicholas Roerich.
- **The Soviet Art Collection** comprises the works by Kuzma Petrov-Vodkin, Alexander Deineka, Vera Mukhina.
- **The Department of Modern Art** established at the end of the 1980s is dedicated to new arts such as installation, photography, video art.

Today the total museum area is more than 30 ha. The museum complex comprises:

- **Mikhailovsky Palace**, one of the most beautiful buildings in Saint Petersburg, was erected according to the project of famous architect Carlo Rossi in 1819-1825. The palace was rebuilt to meet the Russian Museum's needs. Today it displays an essential part of the exhibition.
- **Benois Building** was built in 1914-1919 as a pavilion to organize the artistic associations and unions' exhibitions. It locates the permanent exhibitions of the art of the end of the 19th century – the beginning of the 21st century.
- **Stroganov Palace** – a witness to numerous historic events – was built in 1753-1754 by architect Francesco Rastrelli. Today in the halls of this architectural masterpiece you can see the original interiors and admire the richest collection of objects and works of art.
- **Mikhailovsky Castle** – the largest architectural monument in Petersburg of the 18th century built by order of Emperor Paul I has been a part of the Russian Museum complex since 1991.
- **Mikhailovsky Castle Pavilions** constitute an impressive architectural ensemble with the castle building. In the museum pavilions, you can attend online lectures and visit multimedia exhibitions. It has the Coordination Center of the Russian Museum: Virtual Branch project.
- **The Marble Palace** – a unique Russian architectural monument of the 18th century in a fine state of preservation – is located at the Palace Embankment of the Neva River. The palace has the permanent exhibitions of Saint Petersburg and German collectors.
- **Summer Garden** – Emperor Peter I's favorite garden – had been the center of court and social life for most of its history. The picturesque garden is open to the public all year round.
- **Peter I's Summer Palace** is one of the few historic buildings that were not destined to be rebuilt. You can visit the palace from May to September.
- **Peter I's House** – Peter I's wooden house at the Petrograd Side – is a unique architectural monument and the oldest building in Saint Petersburg. The original exhibition is represented by the objects of the time of Peter I.
- **Mikhailovsky Garden** – a rare landmark of landscape architecture of the 18th century – the first third of the 19th century – combines the French and English styles. The garden visitors can go on tours, attend theater performances, festivals and concerts on a regular basis.





State-of-the-art technologies have made the treasures of the Russian Museum closer and more accessible. The museum's virtual branch allows art lovers from all over the world to take a walk around the museum halls and get acquainted with a part of the Russian art collection.

How to read in Russian

Reading is definitely the best way to replenish your vocabulary and memorize grammar. Teachers of Russian as a Foreign Language recommend going beyond study materials and read original literary works to see how numerous grammar rules are used in the language and really feel it. At the same time, reading remains one of the key challenges for Russian language learners. Today we want to try to gain insight into the reading difficulties that arise, why they arise and how you can overcome them.

READ BOOKS YOU ARE INTERESTED IN

If you read something you are not interested in, you will not get much benefit out of such reading. Be serious about choosing the genre, author and even text length. If you are a fan of a short story genre, don't compromise your integrity. Be pragmatic and rational. Reading for pleasure is your main assistant.

PAY ATTENTION TO TRANSLATED LITERATURE

If you have already read the book by the foreign author in your native language, it pays to start reading the same book in Russian. Getting a general idea of the book content and context will help you easily understand a text written in Russian.

CHOOSE A DIFFICULTY LEVEL THAT SUITS YOU

If your dream is to read *Crime and Punishment* in the original, but your level of Russian is far from being advanced, pay attention to more understandable Russian literature classics. For example, Chekhov is famous for his simple writing style and is a good choice for those who continue learning Russian.



GO BEYOND NOVELS

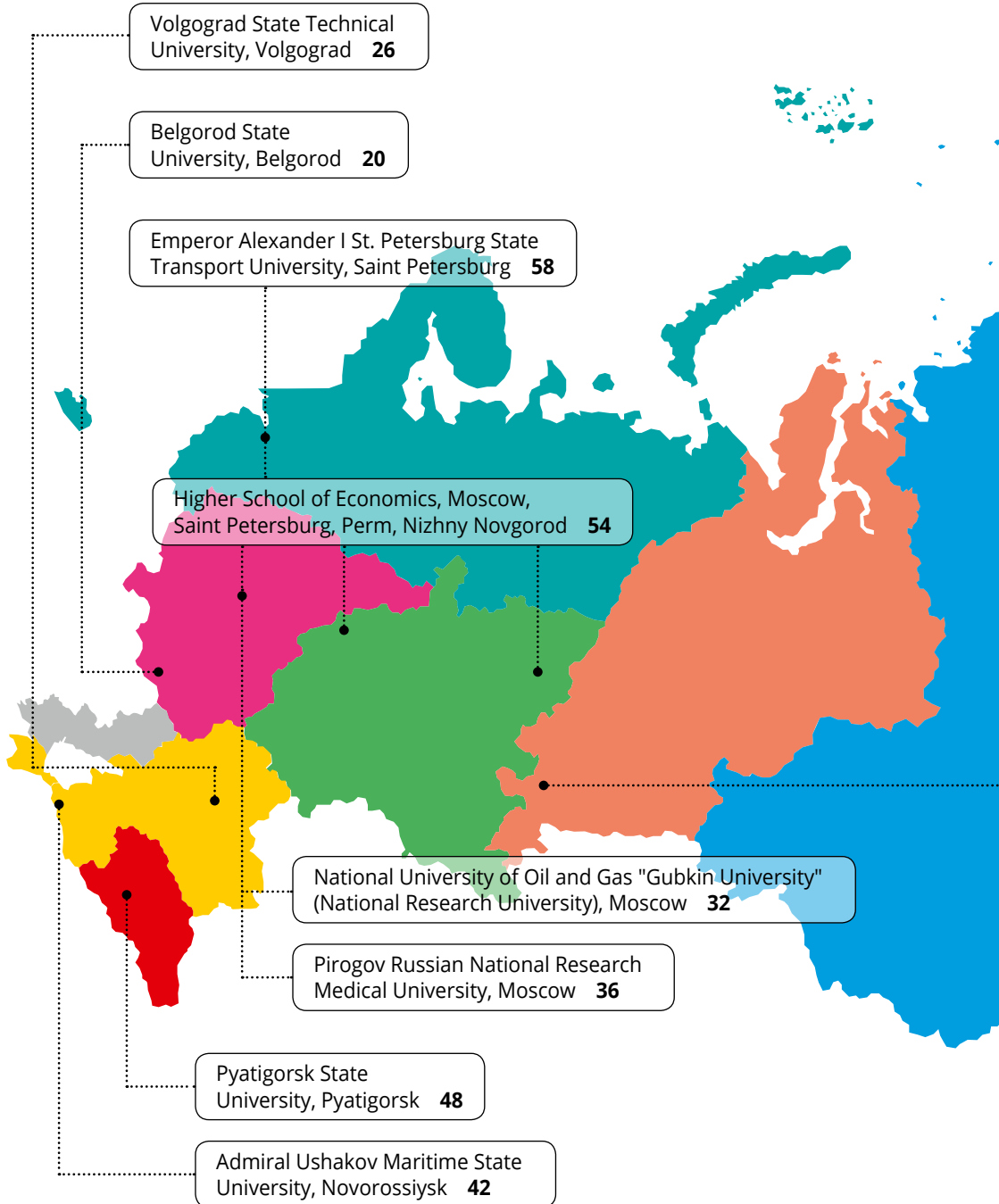
Read short stories, journals, thematic websites and articles. They will provide insight into a variety of genres of the language and styles. Short modern texts will help you intersperse your speech by including new phrases and words in it.

RUSSIAN FAIRY TALES ARE NOT EASY READING

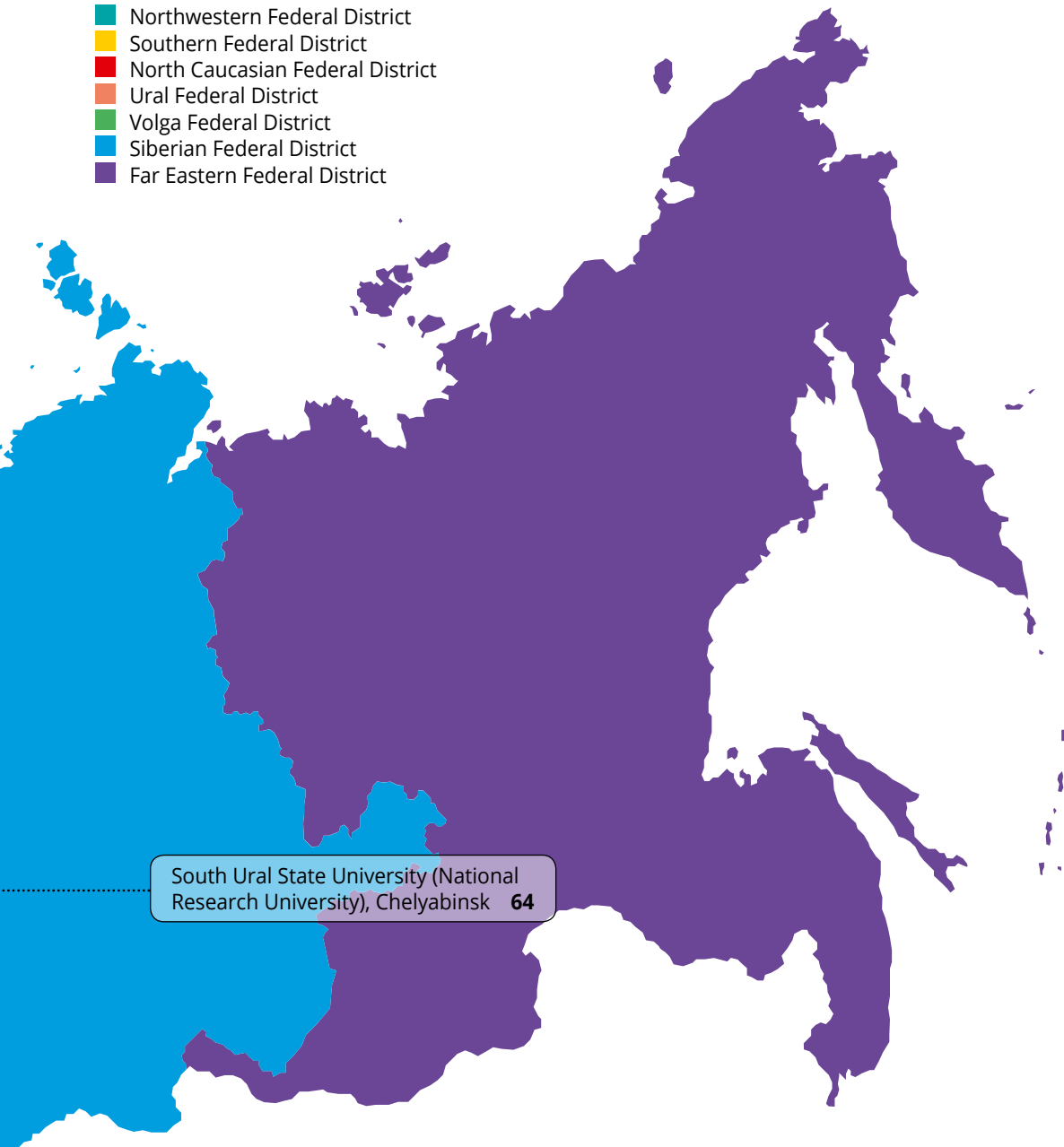
Children's literature is considered easy to read but this cannot be said about Russian fairy tales and folklore. Originality and abundance of Russian fairy tales has its roots in ancient ages. Many words and terms are considered obsolete and are not used in everyday speech today. All of this can become a great obstacle with a mixed result. If you have paid attention to children's books, choose contemporary authors.

Belgorod is a multinational advanced city in the south of the Central Russian Upland, the scientific, cultural, economic and spiritual center of the Central Black Earth Region of Russia.

The history of Belgorod has been a matter of dispute for specialists up to the present day. Some historians consider that modern Belgorod stands in place of the ancient settlement of the 10th century, which is supported by some archeological evidence. However, most of them stick to the view that Belgorod was founded in 1596 by order of Tsar Feodor Ioannovich as a defensive fortress. For centuries, the city has been a place of fierce battles a good many times.

Belgorod boasts a great number of tourist attractions, historic sites as well as buildings of the 19th century and early 20th century in a good state of preservation. The most prominent monument is the 22 meter high Monument to Prince Vladimir.

The city has five universities where more than 40,000 students, including foreign citizens, are studying.

THE DIORAMA MUSEUM "THE BATTLE OF KURSK. BELGOROD DIRECTION"

The history of Belgorod, like that of the whole region, is inextricably linked with the dramatic events of war history. The diorama museum is dedicated to the bloody period of the Great Patriotic War (1941-1945), in particular, to the largest tank battle – the Battle of Kursk. The permanent exhibitions include the Military Hall of Fame, the Belgorod Liberation Hall, and the combat equipment exhibition "Weapon of Victory."

CONTACT MUSEUM OF MEDIEVAL MILITARY AFFAIRS

Visitors of the Museum of Medieval Military Affairs can immerse themselves in the atmosphere of the Middle Ages, try on the costumes, and take part in martial entertainments. The Museum was founded in 2019, and it offers a major exhibition of household and military affairs items of the 11-14th centuries.

USPENSKY CATHEDRAL OF ST. NICHOLAS

One of the most beautiful and the oldest active Orthodox church in Belgorod was built in 1703 at the expense of the community and donation from Peter the Great. This church is a perfect example of Russian architecture with its challenging history.

Volgograd – a hero city with a glorious and difficult fate – is located in the southeast of European Russia. The city history dates back to 1589 – the time of foundation of the permanent observation fortress Tsaritsyn. In 1925, Tsaritsyn was renamed Stalingrad. During the Second World War, it became a place of one the bloodiest battles in the history of mankind. The outcome of the Battle of Stalingrad determined the war outcome to a great extent. In 1961, the city was renamed Volgograd.

Today Volgograd is a major industrial, educational and scientific center that stretches for 100 kilometers as a narrow strip along the Volga River bank. More than 20 universities and branches in the city train specialists in higher education and postgraduate education. 57,000 students are studying at the Volgograd universities.

The city boasts numerous historical sites related to the events of the Civil War and the Great Patriotic War. A great number of sights attract thousands of tourists every year.

MAMAYEV KURGAN

It is the memorial complex located at the 102.0 meter hill where the cruelest battles were fought for control of Stalingrad. Ascension to the memorial alleys, near the monuments and landmarks leaves a lasting impression in every visitor's heart.

THE MOTHERLAND CALLS

The immense monument at the top of the Mamayev Kurgan is so extraordinary and moving that it inevitably attracts all eyes. Making a 85-meter sculpture became a challenging engineering task. It is the first monument completely made from reinforced concrete. The sword in the statue's hands was made from steel using the aviation technology.

THE BATTLE OF STALINGRAD PANORAMA MUSEUM

The museum complex was built in the historical place where the 13th guards rifle division of Major General A. I. Rodimtsev landed in September 1942. The museum halls and depository are located at the two levels of the complex. The permanent exhibition of military equipment items is located in the central square of the museum.

Novorossiysk is the largest Black Sea port in Russia, an important transportation hub, industrial center and picturesque resort. It is a part of the Krasnodar Territory. The city is located on the shore of the deep-water Tsemes Bay and surrounded by the North Caucasus mountains. The geographical location ensures a warm subtropical climate.

The first references to the settlements in the place of present-day Novorossiysk date to the 1st–3rd centuries AD. In different periods of history, the territory belonged to Ancient Greece and the Ottoman Empire. In 1829, according to the Treaty of Adrianople, Turkey ceded it to Russia. The convenient location at the confluence of trade routes has made Novorossiysk participate in numerous dramatic historic events.

Today it is a city with well-developed modern infrastructure and a lot of curious locations to visit and relax.

MIKHAIL KUTUZOV MUSEUM SHIP

The light gun cruiser under 68-bis project was set afloat on November 29, 1951. Until 1988, the cruiser was a part of the combat ships of the Black Sea Fleet, and it became a museum in 1998. Today the museum ship is open to the public. Anyone interested can take a walk along the deck of the ship that won honor in battle and has a remarkable history, look into the chief cabin and visit an exhibition dedicated to the events of the Second World War.

YURI GAGARIN PLANETARIUM

The planetarium has been open to the public since 1961. It was named after the first man in space. Today at the planetarium you can look at the stars on the domical ceiling, visit the exhibitions of the interactive cosmonautics museum, and attend a wide variety of events held at the planetarium venues.

RESERVE MUSEUM OF REGIONAL STUDIES

The Novorossiysk Reserve Museum unites several cultural and historical objects and displays around 150,000 exhibits. The museum exhibitions tell us about the history, culture and nature of Novorossiysk as well as the history of the territory and everyday life of local residents in ancient times.

Pyatigorsk is the oldest spa and mud cure resort of federal importance in Russia located in the central part of Fore-Caucasus. The city was founded in 1780 as Konstantinovskaya fortress that was a part of the Azov-Mozdok system of defensive fortifications after the Russo-Turkish War. In 1803, Emperor Alexander I officially recognized the state significance of the Caucasian Spas region, and the famous resort began to develop.

Pyatigorsk is called a natural museum of mineral waters. More than 100 mineral springs with different chemical composition are used for curative and recreational purposes.

Today it is a scientific, cultural and tourist center with well-developed infrastructure and a great number of sights. The city has 18 universities and branches where around 20,000 students, including foreign citizens, are studying.

MIKHAIL LERMONTOV STATE RESERVE MUSEUM

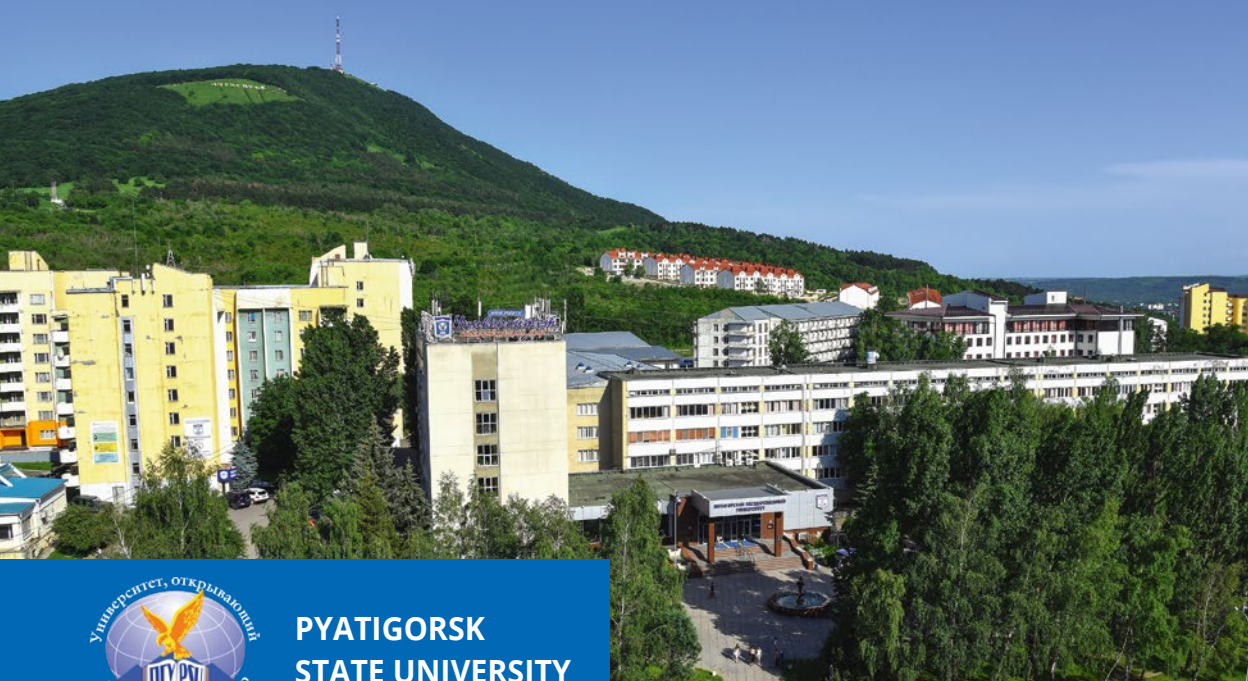

The permanent exhibition of the museum consists of four parts: Lermontov House, Lermontov and the Caucasus, Mikhail Lermontov in Fine Arts, and Alyabyev's House.

TSVETNIK PARK

The oldest park in the city was created in 1828 according to the drawings made by the architects, the Bernardazzi brothers, in the place of the wasteland near the Nicolaevsky baths. Today it consists of numerous picturesque alleys, bowers, grottos, architectural monuments and sculptures.

CABLE CAR TO THE TOP OF MOUNT MASHUK

Saint Petersburg is one of the most beautiful metropolitan cities in the world. It is the second largest city in Russia (more than 5 million people). It is located on the shore of the Gulf of Finland, 720 km from Moscow. It has many unofficial names and titles, such as the City on the Neva, St. Pete, Northern and Cultural capital of Russia, the cradle of the revolution, the city of white nights... It is famous for its numerous rivers and canals connected by bridges, architectural monuments, and plenty of tourist attractions. It has a rich history and is one of the symbols of Russian statehood in general.

Saint Petersburg and some territories in the Leningrad Region are known for their creative spaces, loft projects, roof tours, and other popular entertainments and art locations.

Almost all cultural institutions in Saint Petersburg provide considerable discounts for students. On certain days of the week, you can get free admission to most museums, in particular, the State Hermitage Museum, the State Russian Museum and its branches, the Puppet Museum, the State Museum of the History of Religion, the Russian Museum of Ethnography, the Kunstkamera Museum, and the Suvorov Museum.

SAINT ISAAC'S SQUARE

This is one of the most beautiful and main squares in Saint Petersburg. The square ensemble comprises St. Isaac's Cathedral, Monument to Nicholas I, the Mariinsky Palace, administrative buildings, hotels, and the Blue Bridge over the Moika River. The square is included in the UNESCO World Heritage List.

PALACE SQUARE

Several historical and architectural landmarks at once are concentrated here. Among them are the former residence of Russian emperors – the Winter Palace as well as Small and New Hermitages, the General Staff building with the Triumphal Arch, the Alexander Column dedicated to the victory of Russia in the Napoleonic War. The square is included in the UNESCO World Heritage List.

SENATE SQUARE

This is one of the oldest architectural centers in Saint Petersburg. On the north side, it is opened to the Neva River, and we can see St. Isaac's Cathedral behind Alexander Garden to the south. On the west side are the Senate and Synod buildings. To the east is the Admiralty building. The Bronze Horseman, a monument to Russian Emperor Peter I, is a calling card of the square and a symbol of the city.

Chelyabinsk is a major European-type metropolitan city located at the geological boundary of Ural and Siberia, on the eastern slope of the Ural Mountains. The city was founded in 1736 as a Chelyabinsk fortress at the intersection of flourishing trade routes. In the Soviet period, Chelyabinsk became one of the country's largest industrial centers. It boasts around 150 major enterprises of metallurgy, mechanical engineering and metalworking production, instrument engineering, chemical, light and food industries.

Chelyabinsk is ranked among the Top 3 Russian metropolitan cities with the most developed internal transport infrastructure. It holds a great number of cultural and sports events. The city boasts plenty of museums, theaters, festival venues, recreation parks.

The city has 16 universities and branches where more than 70,000 students, including foreign citizens, are studying.

GAGARIN CENTRAL PARK OF CULTURE AND LEISURE

HOLY TRINITY CHURCH

The oldest church in Chelyabinsk was erected in the 1760s. The first church mentioned in the historical accounts was wooden. The construction of a modern red-brick building began in 1911. The church was built in neo-Russian style, and a shipboard-type layout creates an image of the ark of salvation.

CHELYABINSK METEORITE

On February 15, 2013, a meteorite fell on the territory of the Chelyabinsk Region. While falling, it was destructed in a dense atmosphere and exploded with a power of 300-500 kilotons. The event did not go unnoticed all over the world and was covered in mass media and social media. The largest meteorite fragment called "Chelyabinsk" is displayed at the State Museum of the South Ural History.
