IN ULAANBAATAR

#### STAR DICTATION "LET'S GO!"

The socio-cultural project of Rossotrudnichestvo **Star Dictation** "**Let's Go!"** is held annually in April in Mongolia and other countries. For the first time ever, this humanitarian event took place in 2021, on the 60th anniversary of Yuri Gagarin's flight to space. It brought together more than 17,000 participants from 45 countries. In 2022, the Star Dictation was written by 24,000 people in 62 countries. Since 2022, the dictation has been taken online as part of the Tsiolkovsky International Space Film Festival. This year, the author of the dictation was Anton Pervushin, Russian writer, journalist, space science historian, and the author of fascinating science fiction and popular science books about space.

Everyone, irrespective of their age, education and place of residence, can participate in the event. The main thing is to remind of the historic events related to the events from the space science history and find young talents.



#### **RUSSIAN LANGUAGE COURSES**

The Russian House (RCSC) in Ulaanbaatar offers paid Russian language courses for everyone interested, irrespective of their age and level of education.

You can choose two-month intensive courses or year-long courses. There are also daytime courses specially designed for school leavers.

The attendees of Russian language courses take part in the traditional spring Spartakiad. In March 2023, this sports event took place at secondary school № 49 bearing the name of Marshal and twice Hero of the Soviet Union Issa Pliev. The young men and girls competed in basketball and volleyball.

The winning teams were awarded diplomas and medals, and the mentor teachers who came to cheer their students got a Sunday boost of energy and pride in their students!

Most of our students are senior high school students from Mongolian schools who study Russian from scratch to study in Russia later. Working young people attend our courses to work with Russian companies.

We are happy that our students are not only actively engaged in studying Russian but are also keen on sports as physical fitness is a guarantee of well-being and sound knowledge. As the saying goes, a healthy mind in a healthy body.



The Russian House (RCSC) in Ulaanbaatar has eight regular creative associations where the citizens of the two countries do painting, singing, acting and dancing. It holds Olympiads, meetings with Russian universities' representatives, competitive interviews for admission to Russian universities, and other events.





#### **RUSSIAN MELODY SONG CONTEST**

Creative contests enjoy special popularity among Mongolian young people. The traditional Russian Melody song contest (the city of Baganur) brought together more than 100 participants this year.

The strict jury, including the staff of the Russian House (RCSC) in Ulaanbaatar, assessed the participants of different age groups in the following categories: solo performance, choir performance, and ensembles. What surprised the jury most were the vocal skills of adult competitors working in a wide variety of fields: police officers, engineers, electricians, military servants, preschool teachers, students, and, naturally, Russian language teachers.

The contest was held in two rounds. The first round was the qualifying round where the competitors with the highest scores made it to the finals. And then, three prize winners were identified for each age category. The Russian Melody contest winners received diplomas, money awards and advertising gifts from the event organizers and partners. The Russian House (RCSC) prepared book gifts for the smallest winners and young Russian language teachers.

#### **BROAD SHROVETIDE**

People in Ulaanbaatar have a lot of fun celebrating Shrovetide in a big way. This year, around 1,000 people came to the Russian House (RCSC) to celebrate the traditional Russian festival.

This folk festival is traditionally celebrated in Russia at the end of winter and marks the beginning of spring. According to centuries-old traditions, it is customary to broadly celebrate farewell to winter, welcome guests with generous treats, and have fun.

At the Russian House (RCSC) in Ulaanbaatar, this festival has long become a wonderful tradition, but it was not celebrated due to the pandemic for several years in a row. This year, the event coincided with the Mongolian national holiday.

The spectators were having a great time to the accompaniment of music and dance performances, singing and dancing, taking the Shrovetide pole by storm, taking part in a wide variety of games, larks, and contests, eating pancakes, and dancing in a round.

The Broad Shrovetide lottery drawing became a long-expected peak of the festival. Thirty prizes from the Russian universities, Russian House (RCSC) in Ulaanbaatar and the partners of the Rossotrudnichestvo representative office in Mongolia –companies such as Aeroflot, Gazprombank, Monretrans, the Sezam proper nutrition factory, the FIX PRICE store – were drawn among the event participants.



#### **HISTORY LOVERS CLUB**

In spring 2023, the Rossotrudnichestvo representative office in Mongolia opened the History Lovers Club. The classes on the common Russian-Mongolian history bring together Mongolian young people, historians from Russia and Mongolia, and members of Russian nongovernmental organizations.

Studying the topics related to Russian-Mongolian cooperation will be a key area of our club's activities. Our countries are bound by decades of friendship. The history of Russian-Mongolian relations is rich in interesting facts, which, most regrettable, are unknown to many modern young people. Meanwhile, we should remember history because it is an essential part of our countries' lives.


## INTERNATIONAL CONTEST "TELL THE WORLD ABOUT YOUR MOTHERLAND"

Mongolian school students took an active part in the 5th International Contest "Tell the World About Your Motherland." The organizers stated that 17 works dedicated to the historical landmarks, tourist attractions, and beautiful places in Mongolia became the jewels of the event.

The Innovation Center for Development and Upbringing of Children and Young People, in cooperation with the Committee of the State Duma of Russia on Family, Women and Children Affairs, with support from Rossotrudnichestvo, announced the start of the contest in spring 2023. Mongolian children quickly joined in the project.

Under the terms of the contest, children and young people from all over the world were supposed to choose the most interesting moments of their country's life and make a video or presentation about them. Every year the contest participants' works are published on the Internet, broadcast in Russian and foreign mass media as well as on major state and public platforms.

During the contest "Tell the World About Your Motherland" the participants sent around 10,000 works from 89 regions of Russia and 52 countries. The fifth season brought together the representatives of 35 countries, including Russia, Kyrgyzstan, Belarus, Mongolia, Kazakhstan, Moldova, Uzbekistan, Lebanon, and Vietnam.



What did the Mongolian children tell the world about their Motherland? For example, Khadbaatar Gantulga sent his work in the Video category in the age group of over 15. In his video, he told us about the national park "Mongolia 13th Century." Chinbat Erhembayar presented the Genghis Khan statue in Tsonjin Boldog and told us about its size, symbolism and location.

During the four days, everyone interested could observe the waxing crescent moon, Venus, Mars, and the binary stars as closely as possible.

We participate in the international exhibition "Gateway to Asia" for the second time already, and this year we came to Mongolia again with a telescope to make astronomical star observations for everyone interested.


The sky over Ulaanbaatar is always beautiful, but it is even better in the countryside – there is no artificial street lighting and illumination, and there are always a lot of stars there. We were happy that the weather was fine this time, and the Moon, Venus, and Mars observations were particularly interesting. The most spectacular observations were definitely made in the evening on March 24 when Venus was very close to the Moon. This is a rare occurrence in astronomy, and we are happy to have managed to show it to Mongolian residents.











## INTERNATIONAL CONTEST "PEOPLE OF THE ARTEK"

The most active and inquisitive children have the opportunity to go to Artek, the dream camp for many children. To get a coveted free trip ticket, you can fill in the application with your achievements or take part in the research contest.

The international research event "Artek People" is taking place on the occasion of the centenary of Artek. School students find information about the Artek campers of the past and find out what their fate was and what they achieved in life.

The contest is intended for 12-17-year-old international school students from 29 countries, including young Russian compatriots permanently residing in Mongolia. The contest winners will get a free trip to Artek for the 8th summer shift.

#### **ABOUT PROFESSIONAL IDENTITY**

My career choice was primarily influenced by my mother who was a Russian language teacher. My country choice was also obvious because my parents studied and obtained a higher education in the Soviet Union – my father in Moscow, and my mother in Sverdlovsk (Ekaterinburg). I had been preparing for the Republican Russian Language Olympiad since the 9th grade, and I placed third in it when I was in the 10th grade. This entitled me to free education at one of the Russian universities. I was assigned to study at the Faculty of Philology (the Department of Russian Language and Literature) of M. Gorky Ural State University (now UrFU).



#### **ABOUT ADAPTATION AND STUDIES**

I did not take a pre-university training course. At that time, we were enrolled in the first year directly. That is why blending into the new reality in the new country was a bit of a challenge in the beginning. I am grateful to my student friends who came into my life literally from my first day at the university. They made my adaptation as painless as possible.

The learning process was not easy. The first year at the Faculty of Philology for foreigners whose level of Russian is elementary is an acid test of strength. Literature, Russian Language, Old Slavonic, and Foreign Language, as well as some general philological subjects such as Introduction to Philology, General Linguistics, Literary Theory require utmost involvement and understanding of the material. To say that it was hard to study is an understatement.

Despite all difficulties, I am very happy to have traveled this path and obtained a decent education. I do not think I could have coped with it without support from our great teachers and friends.

After earning my Bachelor's degree, I pursued my Master's degree. I have been working at the Russian House (RCSC) in Ulaanbaatar since December 2010 to this day.

Today the Russian House (RCSC) in Ulaanbaatar has the Russian Language Center offering a wide variety of programs for those wishing to study Russian, including one-year morning courses and one-year daytime courses for 12th graders. As a rule, oneyear courses are designed for young people planning to obtain a higher education at Russian universities later. In summer we offer intensive training programs for those leaving for Russia and for those who wish to replenish their knowledge of the Russian language and get acquainted with Russian culture in their free time.

In general, the Russian House (RCSC)'s activities go beyond teaching Russian. We hold plenty of various events for different audiences. #### **ABOUT THE POWER OF THE DREAM**

I should say that I had been dreaming of studying in Russia since childhood, and my way was not short and easy. The story of my admission to a theater university began in 2011. Then I studied at the Mongolian Conservatory, and this was my first attempt. Unfortunately, I failed it. After graduation from the conservatory, I worked for more than four years as an actress at the opera and ballet theater before my long-cherished dream came back to my memory.

In 2014, I realized that I wanted to become a stage director. I began to study the information on admission and possible study options, but... unfortunately, I was late for the admission campaign. So, the second opportunity was missed.

A year later, I went back to studying Russian at the Russian Center of Science and Culture. Then, in between learning grammar and educational dialogues, I talked about my dream with my Russian language teacher. That's when the time came for my third attempt. After I was actively engaged in mastering the language for a year, I went to Moscow to apply to GITIS.

There is a funny story about that trip to Moscow. The point is that my friend who was to meet me completely forgot about it. I found myself alone in a big city with heavy baggage. At the moment, I was completely at a loss, and, frankly speaking, I was very frightened. The surprising thing is that a complete stranger from Mongolia helped me that day.

I recall that period of time with huge gratitude and love. During the eleven days spent in the Russian capital, I got a bunch of impressions. This time, everything worked out for me. I successfully passed my exam and came back to comfortably prepare for the beginning of the academic year.



#### **ABOUT GITIS AND RUSSIA**


At the beginning of the academic year, I realized that it would not be easy. Despite all my efforts and preparation, it was difficult to study. In fact, our student day lasted from 9 a.m. till 11 p.m. I should also say that the Russian language remained the greatest challenge for me as a foreigner during all my university years. The Russian language, which is beautiful but incredibly difficult, tested my patience every day. I am extremely grateful to my fellow students for their patience, support and help in mastering the language. I am not sure I would have been able to cope with it without them.

Despite all the difficulties, I had a very happy time studying at GITIS.

I was eager to master my profession, and I was in the best place for this. Just so you understand, there is only one opera house and one drama theater in Mongolia. In this respect, huge theatrical Moscow was a source of eternal inspiration for a Mongolian student.

I have a wonderful memory from this period of my life. When I was a first-year student, my fellow students presented me with the return tickets to Mongolia. This was a New Year surprise. That moment was truly enchanting because that New Year's Eve was the last one spent with my father. I have been carrying this warm memory of my great fellow Isaakyan students\* through all my life.

#### **ABOUT CAREER AND DESTINATION**

In my first year at GITIS, I wanted to stay in Moscow and continue my career in Russia. It was not until much later that I realized that I should come back to Mongolia and develop dramatic art here. That's exactly what happened.



I came back to the Opera and Ballet Theater in Ulaanbaatar in a new position. Now I am a theater director. I am grateful to the theater administration for the opportunity to implement interesting cultural projects and to the Russian House (RCSC) for their support and strong creative connection. I am interested in Russian, Mongolian and Chinese academic literature dedicated to international relations and regional studies. I took an active part in the scientific, social and cultural and creative life of the university. 



Russia is the world's largest state by area. This fact alone makes this country interesting to foreigners who once ask the question, "What is Russia like?" Dear friends, Russia is diverse, and its diversity is determined not only by its geography but also by its extraordinary ethnic makeup. In each issue, we tell you about interesting locations, sights, cities, and whole regions. Today we invite our readers on a journey to Yakutia.

#### **GEOGRAPHY**

Without exaggeration, Yakutia is amazing. The vast territory in Northeast Siberia, which is bigger than Argentina, is bounded by the Laptev Sea and the East Siberian Sea to the north.

Yakutia is a land of astonishing contrasts: boundless tundras alternate with arctic deserts, spellbinding glaciers neighbor on thermal springs, mighty rivers alternate with mirrors of lakes, and ancient cliffs frame picturesque valleys. Here, in the very heart of Siberia, you can witness nature creating genuine art. In this region, snowy mountain peaks neighbor upon green forests, preserving the amazing diversity of flora and fauna, including rare and protected animal and plant species.

Yakutia is a place where pristine nature is barely impacted by human economic activities. This happened thanks to its geographical location in combination with the sparse population, rugged relief and severe climate. And yet, this is a region with extremely high industrial, educational and scientific potential, well-developed infrastructure, and a rich culture.

#### **YAKUTSK**

Yakutsk, the capital of the Republic of Sakha (Yakutia), is the modern center of business and cultural life, attracting people by its unique atmosphere and prospects. Located on the banks of the Lena River, it embodies dynamic development and a harmonious combination of Siberian nature and northern urban planning in rather harsh weather conditions.

The city with an extremely interesting history and cultural heritage manifesting themselves in national traditions and crafts is not only a point on the map, but the place where the old is blended with the new, creating a rich and attractive environment for life, work and development. The city develops major technological centers and boasts an excellent business environment. The eventful and cultural life: events, festivals, concerts and theatrical performances vitalize Yakutsk, and its modern parks, shopping centers and sports facilities make it a comfortable place for life and entertainment.

The biggest city located in the permafrost zone has more than 350,000 residents and is constantly growing. More than 60% of the ablebodied population are employed in trade and service, which indicates the development of the sector and availability of a wide range of goods and services and makes Yakutsk livable.



#### **ECONOMY**

The region's economy is based on the mining and processing industry. Yakutia is rich in a wide variety of mineral raw materials. The proven reserves of diamonds, gold, uranium, stibium, iron ores, coal, tin, mercury, hydrocarbons, and rare-earth metals strike the imagination. 95% of the diamonds mined in Russia are of Yakut origin. Mineral wealth and industrial infrastructure make Yakutia attractive to investors. The Republic of Sakha is one of the country's leaders in sustainable growth of industrial manufacturing. In 2022, 616.2 billion rubles were invested in the economy of Yakutia.

The transportation system includes highways and railways, water and air transport. Most freight traffic flows are accounted for by water transport on large rivers and the Northern Sea Route. In winter, when river navigation stops, the role of air transport increases significantly. There are 23 airports in the republic.

The introduction of modern technology solutions and innovations takes the region's agriculture to the next level. The experience of successful crop farming, meat and dairy production and commercial business management in the permafrost zone is actively studied and supported at the country level. The greenhouse business volume is on the increase.

Expansion of infrastructure and transport links plays an important part in the economy of Yakutia. The implementation of major infrastructure projects, such as the railway bridge across the Lena River, promotes expansion of regional opportunities and boosts investment attractiveness.









Yakutia invests a lot in the development of education and science, which contributes to training of highly qualified specialists and innovation-driven growth in all sectors. The IT industry is rapidly developing– there is a whole constellation of successful companies developing software, services and applications, and games.

All these facts show that the economy of Yakutia is on the upswing. The region successfully combines its natural potential with modern innovations, creating a favorable environment for business, investment, and personal development.

#### **NATIONAL IDENTITY**

The Republic of Sakha (Yakutia) is a multinational region where the Yakut population predominates. This fact leaves its mark on cultural life, everyday life and leisure. Telling you about Yakutia, we could not pass by local cuisine, festivals, and cinema.

Besides Russian national festivals, Yakutia celebrates a whole range of ethnic festivals such as the Ysyakh, the Republic Day, Olonkho, the Day of the Arctic, the Day of Mother Language and Alphabet. Yakut traditional summer festival, the Ysyakh, is the most prominent festival among others.

**The Ysyakh** can be called the main ethnic holiday in Yakutia and the biggest cultural event in the republic. Festivals and celebrations are held in all population centers at the end of June, on the days of summer solstice. This bright festival combines long-standing traditions of the peoples of Central Asia, South Siberia, Turkic people of the Caucasus. During the days and nights of the Ysyakh, people set up festival bonfires, make a bloodless sacrifice in honor of the Aiyy deity, participate in fortune telling, play games, and dance.











Not a single festival can do without a feast. Yakut national cuisine can offer a lot of foods for gourmets. Yakut traditional cuisine includes meat, fish, dairy products, berries and herbs cooked in different ways. Harsh conditions in the region do not allow for growing fruit and most vegetables, so they are not used in the traditional cuisine. Besides, the use of all components of the raw product in the cooking process is a distinguishing feature of this cuisine. So, giblets, bones, cartilages, blood are used.

#### The most popular ethnic foods are:

- Khaan delicate blood sausage made from beef or foal blood
- Oyogos horse or colt meat (most often, brisket), served hot (roasted), frozen after boiling or raw, like stroganina
- Stroganina frozen fish, foal meat or liver cut into thin slices and served with salt and black cracked pepper
- **Is miine** gizzards soup with potatoes and vermicelli served with fresh spring onions
- Kyorchekh national dessert made from heavy cream whipped with cowberry or cranberry

#### PLACES TO VISIT, TO SEE, AND TO BE SURPRISED BY

Yakutia is extremely vast, diverse, and, sometimes, quite unapproachable. It remains in the hearts of those coming here once and for all. You will not remain indifferent to a great number of unique sights and landmarks of the region and capital. We have made a small list of places the readers should visit to get an idea of the republic, its heritage, nature, history and, last but not least, people living there.

#### TREASURY OF YAKUTIA

This is a unique exhibition providing a deep insight into the true natural and mineral wealth of the Yakut land. The exhibition halls are dedicated to the history of extraction and processing of precious metals, jewelry art and the amazing diversity of precious and semiprecious stones.

The World Mammoth Museum was set up in 1991, and it is a structural subdivision of North-Eastern Federal University today. The exhibition and collections of the laboratory museum are fully dedicated to mammothology and, without exaggeration, are of universal importance because 75% of the world's known mammoth burial sites were discovered in Yakutia. You can see the remaining mummies of ancient animals here. Many exhibits are one of a kind in the world.


#### THE SUN ABOVE ME NEVER SETS (2019)

#### **STRUCTURE**

Under the guidance of scientists, the university successfully develops 14 scientific schools, seven of which are listed on the register of leading scientific schools in Russia.

Many years of research and academic work have allowed the university to create eight museums exhibiting excellent visual aids for extending and consolidating students' theoretical knowledge.

The museums present the anatomical material, from the biggest to the smallest fauna species. One of the eight museums, the Anatomic Pathology Museum, is one of the leading museums in the world and is under protection of UNESCO.

The structural subdivisions of the university include the fundamental library with the collections comprising 234,000 items.




