Accessible Education in Russia for Vietnamese Citizens

Vietnam-Russia relations have a long-standing and glorious history. Today, international bilateral relations focus on scientific and technological development and improvement of the education systems as well as achievement of social and economic objectives of the two states. Vladimir Murashkin, Head of the Russian House in Hanoi, talks about cooperation in education and the opportunities for Vietnamese applicants.

Russia is one of Vietnam's key partners in education and science and technology cooperation. It provides ample opportunities for training highly qualified Vietnamese specialists. A large part of the Vietnamese political elite and intellectuals got their education in the Soviet Union and Modern Russia. Such a situation, in combination with territorial proximity, makes education in Russia attractive to a great number of young people who are still planning their future.

OUTSTANDING VIETNAMESE GRADUATES OF SOVIET AND RUSSIAN UNIVERSITIES

Phạm Tuân – the first Vietnamese cosmonaut, Hero of the Soviet Union, graduate of Gagarin Air Force Academy.

Chan Dang Khoa – Vice President of the Association of Vietnamese Writers, graduate of Maxim Gorky Literature Institute in Moscow. He is the author of 12 books of poems, four volumes of short stories and novels, and a literary criticism article.

Nguyen Van An – Chairman of the National Assembly of the Socialist Republic of Vietnam (2001-2006).

Nguyen Dang Phat – Secretary General of the Vietnam – Russia Friendship Association, graduate of Moscow State University.



The number and quality of educational programs delivered by Russian universities is so high that applicants are spoiled for choice and can choose any field of study, from ballet to space. Such fields of study as **economics, medicine, IT, a wide range of engineering specialties** are most popular among Vietnamese applicants. Creative fields of study such as painting and singing are also in high demand.

To date, more than 3,000 Vietnamese citizens are studying in Russia. This figure will be on the increase in the foreseeable future because the national economy's demand for personnel for high-tech industries of the national economy will remain high.



Vietnamese citizens can study at Russian university on a fee-paying basis. The cost of educational programs is considerably lower than at European and US universities.

Education is one of the control points in Russia-Vietnam cooperation. Your country has helped us train more than 10,000 highly qualified specialists. Many graduates have taken top leadership positions in Vietnam, such as the positions of Prime Minister, Secretary General, heads of ministries and government agencies. Many of them work in such important fields as the oil and gas industry and atomic engineering.

The Russian Government allocates one of the biggest quotas to citizens of the Socialist Republic of Vietnam to study in Russia. For the 2024/2025 academic year, 1,000 quota places were allocated to Vietnamese citizens.

To participate in the competitive selection to get a quota place from the Russian Government to study in Russia, Vietnamese candidates must fill in the application form and submit all required documents on the portal **"Education in the Russian Federation for Foreigners"** education-in-russia.com.

As candidates from Vietnam participate in the portfolio competition, they should wait after submitting their applications until the overall ranking is compiled. Further selection takes place based on this ranking.

The existing selection system allows talented and ambitious young people to get an education at the top Russian universities. The qualifications obtained, knowledge and skills make them sought-after specialists for national and international companies. As the evidence from practice shows, graduates of international relations faculties have some competitive advantages in their job search irrespective of the degree they earned: the educational institution status, qualification level, Russian language proficiency, international communication experience.



Phạm Tuân is a Hero and a Legend

Preparing our regular column HED_people, we were thinking about who should be chosen as a hero for the special Vietnamese issue of our magazine. And the editorial team quite rightly chose Phạm Tuân, the first Vietnamese cosmonaut. The story of Phạm Tuân, a top-notch pilot, cosmonaut, patriot, outstanding leader, and just an amazing person, is an inspiring story of a deed which is worth telling. Vietnamese pilot, Hero of the Vietnamese War Phạm Tuân flew into space on July 23, 1980 on board the Soyuz 37 spacecraft. This event became a milestone one in the history of the Vietnam-Russia friendship.

Tuân was born into a peasant family. Since childhood, he had been dreaming of becoming a pilot to protect his homeland from enemy planes. His way to the dream was not easy. Tuân, who suffered from malnutrition and was not strong and healthy enough to become a pilot. But, like in any story of overcoming, poor health was just an obstacle to overcome. He was persistent and determined, did sports and made himself fit, and, at last, he became a cadet at Gagarin Air Force Academy.

In fact, he was a top-notch pilot. He shot down the unshootable American bomber B-52. Generally speaking, he was doomed: he was to fly up to it, he shot it down, but after that he was pursued by the American fighters. They even did not shoot him down at once because they realized that when he would start landing... It was night, runway lights would be lit, he would be seen very well, he would move at low speed, and they would shoot him up like a partridge. He really flew up to his airdrome and disappeared. The lights were not lit. He turned out to have been training to land Mig-21 in the dark. He showed such a class! This could be done very seldom. It means that it was almost impossible to shoot down B-52 because there was the guard, savers around it. And surviving it was even more impossible!



In 1979, Phạm Tuân was selected to participate in the Interkosmos Soviet program. He took a training course and in July, 1980 he took a flight on board the Soyuz 37 and Soyuz 36 spacecraft and the Salyut 6 space station. During the Olympic Games in Moscow, Viktor Gorbatko and Phạm Tuân entered orbit. Without exaggeration, the whole world was observing the crew's work.

Tuân spent a total of 7 days, 20 hours and 42 minutes in space. On board the station, he carried out a biological experiment on azolla to grow plants on board the international space station and took photos of Vietnam from Earth orbit.

For Vietnam, as a war-ravaged country, Phạm Tuân's access to the space orbit was a great deed, miracle and hope for revival. Tuân was not only the first Vietnamese cosmonaut in orbit but also the first person from an Asian country to fly into space. His flight was ten years ahead of Japan.

On July 31, 1980, Gorbatko and Tuân were awarded the title of Hero of the Soviet Union. On August 1, during the cosmonauts' visit to Vietnam, they were awarded the title of Hero of Labor of the Socialist Republic of Vietnam.

In 2000, Lieutenant General Pham Tuân became the Head of the Main Directorate of Defense Industry of the Ministry of Defense. In 2002, he became the Chairman of the Military Commercial Joint Stock Bank. He retired in January 2008 and lives in Hanoi now.

Today, Phạm Tuân is an outstanding citizen of his country, a symbol of courage, a living legend, a person who epitomizes determination and bravery.

Let us talk about the meetings of international graduates of Soviet and Russian universities and the prospects for international humanitarian cooperation.

Such comprehensive efforts to support educational and inter-university cooperation, civil society, the youth, academic community, business and non-profit organizations promote the interests of the Russian Federation and some regions through humanitarian and educational interaction.

The Forum of International Graduates of Soviet and Russian Universities – Representatives of the Education Systems of Middle Eastern and African Countries organized by Rossotrudnichestvo in Egypt (Cairo) on December 17-18, 2022 is one of the most important events in this area. This forum that brought together more than 150 graduates on one platform outlined a priority for the development of cooperation in education and science and technology, its importance and prospects for all participants.

The Forum brought together the heads and staff members of the universities in Middle Eastern and African countries, representatives of national education authorities, executive committees of the associations of graduates from 15 countries of the region such as Egypt, Zambia, Jordan, Iraq, Lebanon, Morocco, the United Arab Emirates, Palestine, the Republic of the Congo, Syria, Tanzania, Tunisia, Ethiopia, and the Republic of South Africa, as well as the representative delegations of 30 Russian universities and Rosatom State Corporation. The plenary meeting and roundtable discussions addressed the development of cooperation in the sphere of education, training of local personnel according to the current needs of national economies, and joint research areas. The lively discussion showed that the parties' interest in the development of interaction is really great and can have a lot of positive effects, including training of highly qualified specialists, development of their own scientific and technological potential, expansion of humanitarian cooperation and related strengthening of cross-national awareness and tolerance.

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The first Forum shows that such events help establish direct contacts with stakeholders, discuss urgent issues of sharing experience in education and science, and enhance efforts to train local personnel through bilateral programs and agreements. That is why Rossotrudnichestvo is planning to develop these practices and is elaborating upon the possibility of organizing such regional events on a regular basis biennially.

Russian Languages Tips for Learning

The Russian language is steadily ranked among the top hardest languages to learn. The learner's first language can become an additional challenge in mastering Russian. V. Samuseva, RFL teacher at the Preparatory Department of Moscow Institute of Physics and Technology, talks about why it happens, how to cope with it, and how students from Vietnam learn Russian as a foreign language.

Our experience of working with Vietnamese students at the MIPT Preparatory Department shows that most of these students are hardworking and persistent in achieving their goals, which is certainly a positive factor. However, students from Vietnam have to face some difficulties in the learning process. The point is that the Vietnamese and Russian languages belong to different typological groups, so cross-language interference is inevitable. It manifests itself at all levels: phonetic, grammatical, lexical, and socio-cultural levels.

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ARTICULATION

As early as at the initial stage, students face problems when studying the Russian alphabet. There are more consonants in the Russian language than in the Vietnamese language. For example, Vietnamese has no sounds [zh, sh, ts] and some other sounds in Vietnamese, so students have to master new variants of articulation. Besides, the difference between such sounds as [y] and [i], [s], [sh] and [ts] becomes a considerable difficulty. Due to this, students make such mistakes as: "byl" is pronounced as "bil," "nios" – "niosh," "tsentr" – "sentr." In Vietnamese, such Russian consonants as [b-v], [d-z], [t-s], [t-ch] are not differentiated, which can lead to mistakes in pronunciation: "byl – vyl," "roditeli – roziteli," "veter – vecher."



Taking into account the considerable language differences, you should place emphasis on articulation and pronunciation of new unfamiliar sounds.

Another important point is palatalization of consonants. Vietnamese has no such a phenomenon, and consonants are not palatalized. For example, students pronounce the hard sound [l] in the word "pal'to."

Real challenges are caused by a combination of two consonants in the Russian language. As a rule, one of the consonants drops: "stranitsa" – "tranitsa." Sometimes an additional vowel is pronounced between the two consonants. For example, the word "plokho" reads [p"lokho].

Another special thing about Vietnamese is that it is syllabic, unlike Russian. It means that words are pronounced and written as separate words irrespective of the number of syllables. That's exactly why the Vietnamese find it hard to pronounce polysyllabic Russian words as one word, in one breath.

With all this in mind, work on pronunciation and articulation requires a system approach. Try to do as many diverse tasks as possible to practice the pronunciation of fricatives, hard and soft consonants and pronunciation of polysyllabic words as one word.

WORD STRESS

Many difficulties are caused by word stress. To be fair, native speakers of many other languages share this pain with Vietnamese students . Accentuation in cognate words can embarrass even advanced students. As you know, stress in the Russian language is movable and can differ even in derivative words and forms of the same word. For example, if in the noun "nachálo" the stress falls on the second syllable, Vietnamese students try to keep the same stress in the derivative verb: "nachál" instead of "náchal."

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Special emphasis should be placed on question intonation in a Russian sentence without an interrogative word because declarative and interrogative sentences have identical patterns here.

You can overcome these difficulties not only by studying general rules but also by practicing active listening and reading.



GRAMMAR

Vietnamese has no grammatical gender. It plays a huge part in the Russian language because nouns agree with many parts of speech in gender. That is why genders and inflection of nouns for gender is a stumbling stone.

The same can be said about the case system, which does not exist in Vietnamese, but is one of the key elements of Russian grammar.

It is impossible to successfully master Russian without understanding the importance of gender and prepositional case system. It is important here that you do not neglect both written and oral exercises and memorizing rules and words. Use visual aids such as tables, diagrams, and situational pictures that will facilitate honing the skill using particular speech patterns. Have patience and practice!

LEXIS

Students can also make lexical mistakes caused by the differences in speech patterns. For example, if you say "spasibo" (*"thank you"*) to a Vietnamese student, they will answer "nichego" (*"nothing"*) (in translation into Russian), while in Russian we answer "pozhalujsta" (*"my pleasure"*) or "ne za chto" (*"not at all"*).

The socio-cultural differences in Russian and Vietnamese societies also have an impact. For example, according to the etiquette rules, Vietnamese school and university students address their teacher using the word "prepodovatel" (*"teacher"*), while in Russian it is fine to address people by name and patronymic or last name. That is why, even realizing the necessity and appropriateness of using names and patronymics when communicating with Russian people, Vietnamese students say that they feel uncomfortable. **This problem** will be gradually solved when students practice and immerse themselves in the cultural environment.

GENERAL MEDICINE

Specialist's program

Language of instruction: **English ***, **Russian**

Duration: **6 years** Tuition fee per year: **235,000 RUB**

During the first three years the only language of instruction is English. Starting from the fourth year, students use Russian during practical classes in clinical subjects and when communicating with patients. Mastering Russian is an important part of the learning process.

Every year students undertake an internship at the healthcare organizations in the city and get their first qualification of an advanced registered nurse practitioner as early as their third year of study.

The following plays an important role in mastering the program:

- The anatomy museum with a rich collection of unique exhibits
- The simulation center fitted with state-ofthe-art equipment
- The learning management system (LMS)

Graduates are knowledgeable about patient examination techniques and well-versed in modern diagnostic methods and treatment technologies.



LEARNING RUSSIAN

The first introductory course is offered to applicants at the stage of applying to the university.

Starting from the first year, students begin studying Russian as a foreign language systematically – they take elementary, basic and advanced courses and study medical Russian.

Training is provided by experienced teachers such as philologists who are knowledgeable about the most advanced teaching methods.

By the fourth year, students can communicate freely in Russian with patients, collect complaints, interview patients, participate in professional communication.


ARRIVAL AND ACCOMMODATION

Kemerovo is a cozy green city for comfortable stay and various types of extracurricular activity.

Summers are warm, the average temperature is +20-22°C, but the temperature can often reach +30°C. Winters in Kemerovo are snowy, the average temperature is -10-15°C, and sometimes there are -30°C frosts and even lower temperatures.

Kemerovo has an international airport, but sometimes it is more convenient to get by plane to the airport in the city of Novosibirsk, which has a commuter bus to Kemerovo. The fare is 1,300 RUB.



Upon arrival, students contact the **International Student Office** where they get comprehensive assistance in executing migration documents and getting health insurance.

Students are accommodated in the dormitory within walking distance of the main building. Near the campus are boulevards and parks for walking and doing sports, supermarkets and cafés, public transport stations. The accommodation fee is 1,100 RUB per month.

Tutors from among students and teachers who are group advisors help students solve social and everyday problems.

International students are actively integrated into the social environment of the university, city, and region. They get acquainted with the national culture and traditions of the peoples of Russia and the world, and participate in student creativity festivals.

Studying in Russia became an exciting and challenging adventure for me. From a new country to a new culture and way of life – everything was unusual, and I had to get accustomed to it.

The language barrier became the first obstacle I had to face. Despite the difficulties, studying Russian in Russia and speaking practice did me a world of good: I became more confident, and this laid the groundwork for my educational path in Russia.

In the beginning, Russians seem to be distracted and rather grim. This impression changed after I had made friends with my fellow students. I found out that Russian people are rather friendly. Besides, the stereotypes about Russians also turned out to be false. Russians don't play with bears and don't drink vodka for breakfast. \bigcirc

One of the key aspects of the Russian way of life that caught my attention was a focus on individualism and privacy, compared to community thinking which is predominant in Vietnamese culture. That's why building relationships and networking with local residents required a different set of social skills and respecting personal boundaries.

The academic system, which is different from the Vietnamese one, also was a source of concern. And here, assistance provided by the teachers and staff members of the International Department turned out to be invaluable.
