Let us talk about the meetings of international graduates of Soviet and Russian universities and the prospects for international humanitarian cooperation.

Rossotrudnichestvo carries out its activities aimed at consolidation of the large community of international graduates worldwide hand in hand with Russian partner universities of the Agency. Such comprehensive efforts to support educational and inter-university cooperation, civil society, the youth, academic community, business and non-profit organizations promote the interests of the Russian Federation and some regions through humanitarian and educational interaction.

The Forum of International Graduates of Soviet and Russian Universities – Representatives of the Education Systems of Middle Eastern and African Countries organized by Rossotrudnichestvo in Egypt (Cairo) on December 17-18, 2022 is one of the most important events in this area. This forum that brought together more than 150 graduates on one platform outlined a priority for the development of cooperation in education and science and technology, its importance and prospects for all participants.

The Forum brought together the heads and staff members of the universities in Middle Eastern and African countries, representatives of national education authorities, executive committees of the associations of graduates from 15 countries of the region such as Egypt, Zambia, Jordan, Iraq, Lebanon, Morocco, the United Arab Emirates, Palestine, the Republic of the Congo, Syria, Tanzania, Tunisia, Ethiopia, and the Republic of South Africa as well as the representative delegations of 30 Russian universities and Rosatom State Corporation. The plenary meeting and roundtable discussions addressed the development of cooperation in the sphere of education, training of local personnel according to the current needs of national economies, and joint research areas. The lively discussion showed that the parties' interest in the development of interaction is really great and can have a lot of positive effects, including training of highly qualified specialists, development of their own scientific and technological potential, expansion of humanitarian cooperation and related strengthening of cross-national awareness and tolerance. The first Forum shows that such events help establish direct contacts with stakeholders, discuss urgent issues of sharing experience in education and science, and enhance efforts to train local personnel through bilateral programs and agreements. That is why Rossotrudnichestvo is planning to develop these practices and is elaborating upon the possibility of organizing such regional events on a regular basis biennially.

How Much Does It Cost to Study in Russia?*

What do prospective students and their parents pay attention to when choosing a country to continue education and apply to a university? According to the surveys, the main benchmarks include, besides the quality of education, successful careers of university graduates, who studied in a particular country, and the cost of studying. Today, the price/quality ratio is one of the reasons why Russian universities are attractive to foreign citizens.



Over many decades, Soviet and Russian universities have provided higher education to people from many foreign countries. For example, among students of Soviet and Russian universities were presidents of some countries:

- José Eduardo dos Santos (1979-2017, Angola)
- Trần Đức Lương (1997-2006, Vietnam)
- Bharrat Jagdeo (1999-2011, Guyana)
- Nambaryn Enkhbayar (2005-2009, Mongolia)
- Thabo Mbeki (1999-2008, South Africa), etc.

In 2022, ten supreme leaders of foreign countries were graduates of Russian universities. According to this indicator, Russia ranks fourth in the world, after the USA, Great Britain, and France. Anywhere in the world you can find political figures, famous scientists, prominent business people who have obtained a higher education degree in the USSR and Russia. *We publish an abridged version of the article by V. When choosing a country, students should take into consideration the cost of studying and general costs, including accommodation. In 2022, the Times Higher Education experts conducted an interesting study. They compared the expenses related to students' stay in 20 states holding top positions in the ranking "The Best Countries to Study Abroad" according to US News. In 2022, Russia ranked 49th in this ranking. For comparison, they chose the following cost parameters: the cost of studying, food basket, health insurance, travel card for public transport, apartment rent (one place), and gym membership.

The data for 20 foreign countries and Russia is given in Table 1.

The countries are ranked by general expenses. As we can see from Table 1, minimum expenses are required in Russia – 257 USD, and maximum expenses – in Singapore, 5,172 USD. As can be seen, the gap is very big. It is a 20-fold gap. Even Moscow, where living and studying is rather expensive like in any other capital in the world, compared to other cities in the same country, is located at the top of the table.

The largest part of expenses is tuition or accommodation costs, with some countries placing tuition first and other countries placing accommodation first. In some countries, the sum of these indicators is more than 90%, and each of the rest of items for this share of expenses accounts for a few percent, most often, less than 10%.

Let us consider the countries by cost of studying and apartment rental price. For this purpose, let us divide them into groups, categorizing them as low-cost, average-cost, and high-cost countries. As we can see from Table 2, the groups located on the diagonal of the table are the most filled ones.

The first group includes the cheapest countries in terms of the cost of both studying and accommodation. **Russia is included in this group.**

The second group includes two countries – Spain and Germany – with average apartment rental prices and the low cost of studying.

The third group includes the countries with high apartment rental prices and the low cost of studying.

The fourth group (the average cost of studying and the low cost of accommodation) has two elements, including **Moscow**. It is the cost of studying that makes Moscow different from Russia in general.

The fifth group consisting of three countries – Italy, France, and Japan – is well-balanced and averaged – the average cost of studying lines up with the average cost of accommodation here.

The sixth group is the most filled and well-balanced, too, but at the level of the high cost of both studying and accommodation.

The table data definitely contains averaged values. However, the results of the study are compelling and rather illustrative when it comes to the affordability of studying and living in each particular country. In contrast to many developed countries offering good education, Russia looks an attractive destination from the standpoint of the ratio of price/quality of studying and living in the cities with welldeveloped infrastructure and available electronic services for international students.

Preparatory Faculty Russian Language with Immersion

We have written more than once that learning Russian is a great challenge for foreigners. And it is not only about the fact that the Russian language is "great and mighty"* and difficult in itself, but also about the fact that learners can experience difficulties depending on what their native language is. You can study Russian, like any other language, independently, individually, in groups, at schools, or at preparatory faculties.

> *From the famous saying by Russian writer Ivan Turgenev,"In days of doubt, in days of anguished thought over the fate of my native land, you alone are my staff and my support, oh great, mighty, true and free Russian language!"



The preparatory faculty course fundamentally differs from other courses, primarily due to intensive immersion in the language environment. Besides, the foundation program is comprehensive because students not only take the Russian language course, from elementary to advanced level, but also prepare for university admission.

As a rule, the preparatory faculty course includes:

- Preparation for admission to various Bachelor's and Master's programs
- Preparation for the state certification exam TORFL-I
- Getting acquainted with the education system in Russia
- Immersion in the Russian language and Russian culture



You can study at a preparatory faculty for

free, within the Russian Government quota, getting monthly scholarships. To find out about the selection process to get a quota, contact the Rossotrudnichestvo Representative Office in your country.

What else should you know about Russian language programs at preparatory faculties?

- The course duration can vary from two weeks to two years
- The study programs take into account the starting level of language proficiency
- The language of instruction is Russian
- Classes are conducted by highly qualified teachers having experience in teaching foreign citizens



Preparatory faculties always provide as much immersion in the socio-cultural environment as they can, with plenty of entertainment and educational events. For example, Baikal State University offers its students:

- The opportunity to participate in international cultural student events, festivals, and national days such as Russian Tea, New Year, Literature and Music Festival for International Students, Shrovetide, and The Best Photo.
- ✓ Sightseeing tours around the city of Irkutsk, to the shores of sacred Lake Baikal, the limnology, ethnography and art museums, and visits to theaters and exhibitions.
- Participation in all-Russian and regional competitions, Olympiads, conferences, and student Spartakiads.

RUSSIAN AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE PROGRAMS

As a rule, every student at the preparatory faculty takes an entrance test and a questionnaire survey to determine their starting level of Russian language proficiency and priorities in educational and scientific interests. Depending on the learning objectives and outcomes and course duration, students are divided into groups by study areas.

The programs are aimed primarily at developing practical Russian language skills (speaking, listening, reading, and writing). So, the programs include modules such as:

- fluent communication
- understanding spoken language
- written speech
- vocabulary expansion
- Russian language grammar
- phonetics (as part of everyday classes)
- getting acquainted with the cultural and linguistic consciousness of Russians
- getting acquainted with Russian traditions and behavior patterns of Russians

Students study Russian as well as major subjects to continue their education or business activities: History, Social Science, Mathematics, Informatics, Literature, Regional Studies, Cultural Studies, etc. The Russian language course is a major part of the one-year foundation program. Emphasis is placed on studying language for science in the chosen study area.

Students can take the state certification test (TORFL) of the Russian Federation and obtain a certificate confirming their level of proficiency in Russian as a foreign language.

After finishing the course, students obtain a university certificate confirming that they have completed the Russian as a Foreign Language program.

STEP 1

Register on the website education-in-russia.com, carefully fill in the electronic application form, and confirm it.

Specify in your application form:

- Your personal data
- Your profession, major, or field of study
- Your education level
- Your Russian language proficiency level

Specify the university you like most in the first place and other universities – in descending order of preference.

You will also be required to submit the following documents:

- A copy of your passport (which is valid at least 18 months from the moment of your expected arrival in the Russian Federation) or birth certificate
- Copies of the documents confirming your education and (or) qualification obtained in a foreign state
- Standard medical certificate confirming the absence of contraindications to studying in the Russian Federation with the HIV infection test results
- Copies of the documents which are notarized and translated into Russian (you can get the full list of documents at the Russian House in your country)





STEP 2

Find yourself	in	the	list	of	candidat	es.

STEP 3

Inform us about your being selected a candidate for studying within the quota at VVSU so that we can confirm you in our system.

Wait for the notification of your admission to the university and further instructions.

STEP 4

Get an invitation to apply for a Russian visa (if required) and inform VVSU about your arrival so that we can make arrangements to meet you at the airport.

NEZHNY JOVGOROD REGION

The Nizhny Novgorod Region is a vast region in the center of European Russia – it is a part of the Volga Federal District. The administrative center, the city of Nizhny Novgorod, is located at the confluence of two rivers – Volga and Oka, 400 km northeast from Moscow.

The Volga River divides the region into two parts – the Left Bank (Zavolzhye) and the Right Bank, which differ very much from each other in natural and climatic conditions. Zavolzhye is a plain. The Right Bank of Oka and Volga is a rolling plain.



The region has more than 9,000 rivers and brooks. The largest rivers are Volga, Oka, Vetluga, and Sura. There is Gorky Reservoir and Nizhny Novgorod hydroelectric power plant in the region.

Switzerland Park <u>Nizh</u>ny Novgorod The climate of Nizhny Novgorod Region is moderately continental. Winters are usually cold and snowy, and summers are short and moderately hot.

Around 48% of the territory is covered by forests. Coniferous forests are a major type of vegetation.



The regional economy is based on the processing industry. The largest share in the industry is taken by manufacturing transportation means and equipment, oil products, metallurgical production, and manufacturing of finished metal products. The key industries are mechanical engineering and metalworking, followed by chemical and oil refining industries, forestry, wood processing and paper industries. The main area of the mechanical engineering industry is transport engineering, including car manufacturing, shipbuilding, diesel engine manufacturing, aircraft engineering, and machine tool engineering, with car manufacturing playing a primary role.

The region is known for the world-recognized scientific schools:

- radiophysics and electronics, including physics of solid microstructures
- nuclear and laser physics
- high energy physics
- nonlinear dynamics
- organometallic chemistry
- chemistry of high-purity substances
- microbiology
- high technologies in medicine: cardiology, traumatology, and orthopedics

The Nizhny Novgorod Region is a large agricultural region. The specializations of agriculture are: grain and potato production in crop farming and meat and dairy production and poultry farming in animal farming.

NIZHNY NOVGOROD

The city of Nizhny Novgorod – the region's administrative center – is a large transport hub. Extensive water, railway, motor transport routes establish reliable ties with raw material supplies bases and districts – consumers of products manufactured in the region as well as large cultural centers.

Nizhny Novgorod is Russia's largest industrial center with the enterprises of mechanical engineering, metalworking, and information technology playing a leading role.

Nizhny Novgorod was founded in 1221 by Prince Yuri Vsevolodovich to protect Russian borders. Under Ivan III, Nizhny Novgorod was a sentry city. It had a regular army. This was the place for Moscow to march against Kazan.

Nizhny Novgorod made a great contribution to the construction of the Russian state. In 1612, Kuzma Minin and Prince Dmitry Pozharsky's militia from Nizhny Novgorod played a decisive role in the liberation of Moscow from Polish intervention.

During the Soviet period from 1932 to 1990, the city was named after Maxim Gorky, the Great Russian writer who was born there.





Today, the city, that once played such a significant role in the history of Russia, is turning into a modern metropolis. Nizhny Novgorod is Russia's largest center of river cruise tourism and the venue of Nizhny Novgorod fair-based international exhibitions.

Nizhny Novgorod is one of the richest cultural centers in Russia. The most prominent artists have received education in the local theater and art schools. The city has opened a large number of theaters, museums and cinemas.

This city can surprise any traveler by an entwinement of modern and ancient buildings, each time rising before your eyes in a completely unexpected appearance. 3

10 FACTS ABOUT NIZHNY NOVGOROD

The most unassailable Kremlin in Russia was besieged five times in its entire history, but was never taken.

Nizhny Novgorod organized the famous militia led by Kozma Minin and Prince Dmitry Pozharsky that liberated Russia from Polish-Lithuanian intervention.

The city has two of the world's four churches built in a special inimitable style at the expense of merchant Grigory Stroganov, a famous "oligarch" of Petrin times.

Nizhny Novgorod has the longest pedestrian ladder in Russia. The ladder is eight-shaped and has 560 steps from both sides and 442 steps from bottom to top from the right side. The ladder looks solid from Volga, and that is precisely why Nizhny Novgorod residents not only hold track-and-field competitions on it, but also use it to create a unique art object.

The Upper Volga Embankment is 80 meters high, which makes it the highest embankment in Russia.

Nizhny Novgorod has a cableway, which is the longest one not only in Russia, but also in entire Europe. It is 3,362 meters long.

The name of Sormovo district was derived from the word "sram", or "sorom" (which means "shame"). Five hundred years ago, "soromnye" ("shameless") people – tramps and beggars were settled there.

Nizhny Novgorod boasts a lot of historic sights associated with Maxim Gorky. One of them is the Bugrovs' Poorhouse that has been preserved to the present day. It was a prototype of the famous homeless shelter from the Lower Depths play.

Nizhny Novgorod has a state-of-the-art planetarium, which is also an ambitious research center. The main hall of the planetarium is equipped with the system of Argus Planetarium projectors – oneof-a-kind Russian counterpart of Western projection systems. The Nizhny Novgorod Planetarium has a digital telescope and Russia's only spacecraft docking simulator accessible to visitors.

One of Stalin's bunkers built at the beginning of the Great Patriotic War, which was never used by the leader, is located in Nizhny Novgorod. The secret bomb shelter was called Special Facility N74.

Tuition fee: 390,000 RUB per year

The six-year course of the game design program "Computer Graphics and Animation Artist" includes design of interface, backgrounds, environments, creatures, and characters for computer games and design of animation and graphics for them. 2D and 3D visualizations of game worlds and locations based on the realist school of drawing and painting are created and animated here. While studying, students create both computer game trailers and animated cartoons. BIOMECHANICAL ANALYSIS OF HUMAN MOVEMENT IN FOOTWEAR DESIGN

Tuition fee: 214,000 RUB per year

As part of the Master's program "Biomechanical Analysis of Human Movement in Footwear Design", a university laboratory of scientific biomechanics of movement has been created. It is equipped with a 3D foot scanner, a system of nine optical infrared cameras, two force platforms, and an electromyography system. The laboratory data helps choose individual footwear and rehabilitation footwear. In cooperation with specialists from health clinics, students conduct research on biomechanics of walking in patients with ICP and osteogenesis imperfecta. Students will study and use in their work optical motion capture systems, force platforms, wireless electromyography, 3D scanning and 3D printing as well as master footwear and shoe insole manufacturing technologies. Such an approach allows students to register biomechanical data, analyze loads on joints, spine, and muscles, and build a multi-component foot model.

PREPARATORY FACULTY

USMU has the Preparatory Faculty for applicants who do not speak Russian.

From November to June, attendees study Russian as well as chemistry and biology. Besides, prospective students get acquainted with the Russian culture and traditions and adapt to independent life.

After completing the course, attendees get a **certificate** of completion of the general preparatory course in medicine and biology.



RUSSIAN LANGUAGE COURSES

The university enrolls students from different countries and ethnic groups. But neither language background nor the prospective students' previous environment influence the speed of learning Russian. The earlier attendees of the Preparatory Faculty start studying it and the harder they study in the classroom and outside it, the better their Russian will be by the end of study.

The most difficult thing about learning Russian is mastering grammar -correct

spelling. As practice shows, students who can read and speak Russian quite well, can have some text writing problems. To neutralize this problem, the university offers additional Russian language courses for degree program students in their first years of study.
