The Little

Golden Calf

This is a satirical novel about the adventures of charismatic schemer and crook Ostap Bender. It is included in the golden collection of Russian literature. The action takes place against the backdrop of Soviet mundanity of the 1930s and is a bright parody of reality. A combination of realism and such literary techniques as hyperbole, pun, grotesque produced a facetious story with multiple meanings. In 1949-1956, the novel was called ideological sabotage and banned.

Laurus

non-historical novel

The main character of the novel Laurus is a medieval herbalist Arseny. He has the gift of healing but is unable to save his beloved. He decides to walk his earthly path by devoting his life to her. He nurses the plague stricken and wounded, wretched and feeble, and the more he sacrifices himself, the more evident his gift becomes. But can love and sacrifice save a human soul?

This is a very profound and multi-layered novel about people, God, love, and sacrifice. It is written in modern Russian and Old Russian, has been translated into more than 30 languages, and has won recognition from critics and readers.



ZAKHAR PRILEPIN The Pathologies novel/realism

The outskirts of Grozny city. War in the Caucasus. The group of young and angry special operations forces soldiers came to war.

Svyatoy Spas is a quiet town lost among Russian hills and plains. The six-year-old boy, living his childhood tenderly and sensitively. The grown-up young man, loving passionately and jealous till it bleeds.

But the line between the past and the present, between peace and war is blurred. The main character, Egor Tashevsky – a man with a restless and attentive state of mind – tries to fit the war into his concept of normality and mentally lives his broken childhood and sybaritic youth again.

The Pathologies is a complex and cinematic novel about ruthless war, persistent hope, and people at war. The novel stands out from other works by addressing a distressing theme of the Chechen War and harsh realism.

One Billion Years to the End of the World

DMITRI HVOROSTOVSKY (1962-2017)

opera/romance

The Soviet and Russian opera singer, beautiful baritone who has left a rich creative legacy. An outstanding man of art, a man with a big heart, Hvorostovsky was nominated for Grammy three times, performed at the best world venues, and cooperated with the outstanding contemporary conductors. Hvorostovsky's singing and performing talent significantly exceeds the opera genre. He performed not only opera arias but also romances, Russian folk songs, spiritual music works, and patriotic songs. Hvorostovsky's music is profound, full of sense and feelings, and it leaves indifferent very few people.

KINO Punk rock

The Kino band and its leader, singer, and song writer Viktor Tsoi (1962-1990) are considered Russian rock pioneers. The band greatly influenced the development of Russian rock culture and was on a lot of tours to the former USSR countries and other foreign countries. Kino's music is still popular and inspires many contemporary musicians. For Russian language learners, the songs of the Kino band are a real find. The texts of the songs are simple and understandable and strike a chord because they are about love, life, people, and feelings, e.g. sadness or lust for freedom. In Russia, you can hardly find someone who does not know such songs as "Kukushka" ("Cuckoo"), "Zvezda po imeni Solntse" ("A Star Called the Sun"), and "Pachka Sigaret" ("A Pack of Cigarettes").

Marina was born in the town of Anadyr in Chukotka (try to find it on the map \bigcirc). Since she was a child, she had been doing music and learned three instruments – the violin, the piano, and the guitar. She wrote her first song in 2016 and experimented with the popular cover songs. Today the singer has five studio albums. The album "The Tales of a Wood Nymph" was characterized by the audience as "elf pop" that combines touching texts, melodious and clear voice, deep basses, and choral accompaniment. The hit "Comets" was one of the TikTok trends.

PETR NALICH

This Russian singer and composer writes songs and music for theatrical performances, movies, and cartoons. The clip for the funny song "Guitar" entered the top of the most viewed Russian clips and was viewed more than eight million times. The song "Lost and Forgotten" was performed at the Eurovision Song Contest 2010. Nalich is an outstanding singer, performing classical opera repertoire, romances, and author songs. Petr Nalich and his band have 13 studio albums mixing musical genres and styles in their tracks.

POPULAR EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AND THEIR BENEFITS

As evidenced by international experience, the share of professionals with university degrees, who work in the field of land use planning of economically developed countries, is at least 60% of the enterprises' number of staff. Every year, more than 70% of SULUP graduates get employed by government authorities, organizations and institutions, and agricultural enterprises of Russia. According to the data from the performance monitoring of the universities of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of Russia, the share of employed graduates was 80-100% in 2017-2012.

GENERAL MEDICINE

Specialist's program

Language of instruction: **English ***, **Russian**

Duration: **6 years** Tuition fee per year: **218,000 RUB**

During the first three years the only language of instruction is English. Starting from the fourth year, students use Russian during practical classes in clinical subjects and when communicating with patients. Mastering Russian is an important part of the learning process.

Every year students undertake an internship at the healthcare organizations in the city and get their first qualification of an advanced registered nurse practitioner as early as their third year of study.

The following plays an important role in mastering the program:

- The anatomy museum with a rich collection of unique exhibits
- The simulation center fitted with state-ofthe-art equipment
- The learning management system (LMS)

Graduates are knowledgeable about patient examination techniques and well-versed in modern diagnostic methods and treatment technologies.



LEARNING RUSSIAN

The first introductory course is offered to applicants at the stage of applying to the university.

Starting from the first year, students begin studying Russian as a foreign language systematically – they take elementary, basic and advanced courses and study medical Russian.

Training is provided by experienced teachers such as philologists who are knowledgeable about the most advanced teaching methods.

By the fourth year, students can communicate freely in Russian with patients, collect complaints, interview patients, participate in professional communication.



ARRIVAL AND ACCOMMODATION

Kemerovo is a cozy green city for comfortable stay and various types of extracurricular activity.

Summers are warm, the average temperature is +20-22°C, but the temperature can often reach +30°C. Winters in Kemerovo are snowy, the average temperature is -10-15°C, and sometimes there are -30°C frosts and even lower temperatures.

Kemerovo has an international airport, but sometimes it is more convenient to get by plane to the airport in the city of Novosibirsk, which has a commuter bus to Kemerovo. The fare is 1,300 RUB.



Upon arrival, students contact the **International Student Office** where they get comprehensive assistance in executing migration documents and getting health insurance.

Students are accommodated in the dormitory within walking distance of the main building. Near the campus are boulevards and parks for walking and doing sports, supermarkets and cafés, public transport stations. The accommodation fee is 1,100 RUB per month.

Tutors from among students and teachers who are group advisors help students solve social and everyday problems.

International students are actively integrated into the social environment of the university, city, and region. They get acquainted with the national culture and traditions of the peoples of Russia and the world, and participate in student creativity festivals.

NEZHNY JOVGOROD REGION

The Nizhny Novgorod Region is a vast region in the center of European Russia – it is a part of the Volga Federal District. The administrative center, the city of Nizhny Novgorod, is located at the confluence of two rivers – Volga and Oka, 400 km northeast from Moscow.

The Volga River divides the region into two parts – the Left Bank (Zavolzhye) and the Right Bank, which differ very much from each other in natural and climatic conditions. Zavolzhye is a plain. The Right Bank of Oka and Volga is a rolling plain.



The region has more than 9,000 rivers and brooks. The largest rivers are Volga, Oka, Vetluga, and Sura. There is Gorky Reservoir and Nizhny Novgorod hydroelectric power plant in the region.

Switzerland Park <u>Nizh</u>ny Novgorod The climate of Nizhny Novgorod Region is moderately continental. Winters are usually cold and snowy, and summers are short and moderately hot.

Around 48% of the territory is covered by forests. Coniferous forests are a major type of vegetation.



The regional economy is based on the processing industry. The largest share in the industry is taken by manufacturing transportation means and equipment, oil products, metallurgical production, and manufacturing of finished metal products. The key industries are mechanical engineering and metalworking, followed by chemical and oil refining industries, forestry, wood processing and paper industries. The main area of the mechanical engineering industry is transport engineering, including car manufacturing, shipbuilding, diesel engine manufacturing, aircraft engineering, and machine tool engineering, with car manufacturing playing a primary role.

The region is known for the world-recognized scientific schools:

- radiophysics and electronics, including physics of solid microstructures
- nuclear and laser physics
- high energy physics
- nonlinear dynamics
- organometallic chemistry
- chemistry of high-purity substances
- microbiology
- high technologies in medicine: cardiology, traumatology, and orthopedics

The Nizhny Novgorod Region is a large agricultural region. The specializations of agriculture are: grain and potato production in crop farming and meat and dairy production and poultry farming in animal farming.

NIZHNY NOVGOROD

The city of Nizhny Novgorod – the region's administrative center – is a large transport hub. Extensive water, railway, motor transport routes establish reliable ties with raw material supplies bases and districts – consumers of products manufactured in the region as well as large cultural centers.

Nizhny Novgorod is Russia's largest industrial center with the enterprises of mechanical engineering, metalworking, and information technology playing a leading role.

Nizhny Novgorod was founded in 1221 by Prince Yuri Vsevolodovich to protect Russian borders. Under Ivan III, Nizhny Novgorod was a sentry city. It had a regular army. This was the place for Moscow to march against Kazan.

Nizhny Novgorod made a great contribution to the construction of the Russian state. In 1612, Kuzma Minin and Prince Dmitry Pozharsky's militia from Nizhny Novgorod played a decisive role in the liberation of Moscow from Polish intervention.

During the Soviet period from 1932 to 1990, the city was named after Maxim Gorky, the Great Russian writer who was born there.





Today, the city, that once played such a significant role in the history of Russia, is turning into a modern metropolis. Nizhny Novgorod is Russia's largest center of river cruise tourism and the venue of Nizhny Novgorod fair-based international exhibitions.

Nizhny Novgorod is one of the richest cultural centers in Russia. The most prominent artists have received education in the local theater and art schools. The city has opened a large number of theaters, museums and cinemas.

This city can surprise any traveler by an entwinement of modern and ancient buildings, each time rising before your eyes in a completely unexpected appearance. 3

10 FACTS ABOUT NIZHNY NOVGOROD

The most unassailable Kremlin in Russia was besieged five times in its entire history, but was never taken.

Nizhny Novgorod organized the famous militia led by Kozma Minin and Prince Dmitry Pozharsky that liberated Russia from Polish-Lithuanian intervention.

The city has two of the world's four churches built in a special inimitable style at the expense of merchant Grigory Stroganov, a famous "oligarch" of Petrin times.

Nizhny Novgorod has the longest pedestrian staircase in Russia. The staircase is eight-shaped and has 560 steps from both sides and 442 steps from bottom to top from the right side. The staircase looks solid from Volga, and that is precisely why Nizhny Novgorod residents not only hold track-and-field competitions on it, but also use it to create a unique art object.

The Upper Volga Embankment is 80 meters high, which makes it the highest embankment in Russia.

Nizhny Novgorod has a cableway, which is the longest one not only in Russia, but also in entire Europe. It is 3,362 meters long.

The name of Sormovo district was derived from the word "sram", or "sorom" (which means "shame"). Five hundred years ago, "soromnye" ("shameless") people – tramps and beggars were settled there.

Nizhny Novgorod boasts a lot of historic sights associated with Maxim Gorky. One of them is the Bugrovs' Poorhouse that has been preserved to the present day. It was a prototype of the famous homeless shelter from the Lower Depths play.

Nizhny Novgorod has a state-of-the-art planetarium, which is also an ambitious research center. The main hall of the planetarium is equipped with the system of Argus Planetarium projectors – oneof-a-kind Russian counterpart of Western projection systems. The Nizhny Novgorod Planetarium has a digital telescope and Russia's only spacecraft docking simulator accessible to visitors.

One of Stalin's bunkers built at the beginning of the Great Patriotic War, which was never used by the leader, is located in Nizhny Novgorod. The secret bomb shelter was called Special Facility N74.

We are leaving for Gorodets. **Gorodets** is one of the oldest Russian fortress towns whose proud history stirs up many disputes among scholars even today. The exact date of the town's foundation is not fixed. However, starting out from the first references in chronicles, it can be said that the town was founded in 1150–1172. The fortress town was to protect the southern borders of the Russian state from raids of hostile neighbors. It was repeatedly attacked and was burned down, but it was always restored and had been a major trade. political and industrial center for centuries. In the 18th century, bread trade was booming and shipbuilding and woodworking crafts were developing here. And later, it was a place where the first major metallurgical. woodworking, and leather manufacturing plants of the Nizhny Novgorod Region were established.

Taking into account the Gorodets' status as a commercial and industrial center located at the intersection of the major trade routes, it is no wonder that it was a place where rich merchant families settled. And this fact was one of the drivers of the town and region's development. The splendid houses with rich and exquisite decoration, churches, hospitals, and the necessary infrastructure were built.

Gorodets is a place where Alexander Nevsky, Grand Prince of Vladimir, passed away in 1263.

Throughout its history, Gorodets has gone through periods of rise and fall caused by military clashes, disasters, political turbulence, and trade and industry development. **Today it is a major tourist center that attracts many tourists from across Russia and the world every year.**

Gorodets is exceptionally remarkable and beautiful. It is actually a museum town. Most of the ancient buildings have been preserved here. Local authorities make efforts to preserve the historic and cultural heritage in good order. So, in the uphill part you can enjoy a walk among the houses of the 19th century and delve into the atmosphere of that time.

The town center includes only four streets, including the streets named after Andrei Rublev, Vladimir Lenin, Alexander Nevsky, and Revolution Embankment. **And this is the place where all the main museums of Gorodets are located.**

City of Masters is a whole complex where you can see the wooden architecture works of the 16th-19th centuries, from the princely tower to the peasant log house. Despite the fact that the buildings in the City of Masters are actually modern buildings constructed in the style of Old Russian wooden architecture, the complex is still the most visited site in Gorodets. It holds various events, meetings, master classes where you can get an idea of folk crafts in Gorodets and even learn to make toys and painted crockery.

Of the ancient fortress standing on the borders of the Old Russian state, only a small fragment of the fortress wall has been preserved until now. To see this sight, you should climb up the Knyazhya Gora mountain.

Feodorovsky Monastery – an active friary – is one of the most ancient Russian monasteries. It was founded in 1154. The sanctuary is most famous for its copy of the Feodorovskaya lcon of the Mother of God. The icon itself has not been preserved. It burned down together with the wooden chapel during the invasion of Batu Khan. The light and beautiful monastery complex, which is a witness of historic events, is open to parishioners and visitors.

Today's guest of our HED_people column is Ahmed Said Amer, a graduate of Nizhny Novgorod State University of Architecture and Civil Engineering.



Studying in Russia became a very important stage of my life. The eventful and challenging stage that I managed to go through with the help of God.

Take the Russian language, for instance. Learning a new language, immersion in an unfamiliar culture, building relationships with my colleagues and fellow students required major efforts. There can hardly be anything more important than motivation in learning the Russian language because it is very hard to learn. Pronunciation of all these long difficult words is a challenge for persistent learners.

I was lucky to get the greatest support from my family on my way. My wife moved with me and accompanied me. Help and assistance from my teachers, colleagues, and even neighbors greatly facilitated the process of adaptation to a new country.

Or, for example, the quality of teaching and requirements for students. I had occasion to be present at the defense of a doctoral thesis. And I was shocked by the serious approach to training of specialists in Russia. At that moment, I realized that it wouldn't be easy.



One of the most persistent myths about Russia says that Russia is an extremely cold country. And that's what I really had occasion to experience. Russian winters are rather harsh. However, Russian people are welcoming and friendly. I learned it first hand.

At the very beginning, I was sent to Far Eastern Federal University. Here, in the east of Russia on the Russky Island, I studied Russian. And it was here that I realized how vast this country was. Next, I moved to Nizhny Novgorod, a beautiful city on the Volga River. In fact, I would advise everyone who is going to Russia or is already here to visit as many various cities as possible. The diversity of this country is really striking.



People often ask me, "Why Russia?" And what can I say? Why not? Russia is a wonderful country with a welcoming atmosphere, rich culture, and centuries-old history. And what is more, I acquired a taste for Russian food, especially borscht and fish. In Russia, there are so many ways to cook fish.

I spent three years and nine months in Russia. I dealt with Russians at work, at university, in the street, at the market, and at the bank. Russians are really good people. They are proud of themselves and their history. They maintain their identity and cherish their traditions. Of course, all foreign policy challenges of recent years influence the world's perception of this country and its people, and this makes the development of cultural and educational relations between our countries even more important. Egypt and Russia have an eventful history of bilateral relations. For example, President Gamal Abdel Nasser adopted a policy of rapprochement between the Egyptian and Russian peoples. This period went hand in hand with the development of economic, cultural, and humanitarian relations. Today we can see an increase in mutual interest between our countries.
