Russian Higher Education for Applicants from Mongolia

Mongolia highly values the level of Russian education, shows great interest in the culture of our country. There has been an increase in the number of quota places to study at Russian universities. Offline and online events organized by Rossotrudnichestvo allow the university representatives to get acquainted with school students and take part in the selection of the most talented applicants.

Acting Head of the Rossotrudnichestvo representative office in Mongolia, Acting Director of the Russian House in Ulaanbaatar Valeria Kilpyakova talks about how Mongolian young people apply to Russian universities, what majors they choose, and about many other interesting things.

ABOUT MOTIVATION TO APPLY TO RUSSIAN UNIVERSITIES

The prestige of Russian higher education, despite some decline in the beginning of the post-Socialist period, is maintained at a rather high level.

Firstly, Mongolia still has the socialist-era infrastructure technologically based on Soviet/ Russian standards – the Ulanbaatar railway, the Erdenet mining and processing plant, the CHP system. **Maintenance and periodic update of these technologically complex facilities requires relevant specialists that can be trained only in Russia.**

Secondly, academic and educational relations established in the course of socialist years, in particular, through the system of joint research expeditions, also could not disappear completely. **The need to continue research objectively created an environment for the reproduction of new personnel by sending Mongolian young people to Russian universities.** The factor of influence of the older generation of Mongolians on their young compatriots' mindsets plays an important part.

ABOUT QUOTAS

The number of quotas increases from year to year, and competition is low so far. Due to the pandemic, competition at Russian universities reduced to two applicants per place. This is due in no small part to poor knowledge of the Russian language because of the insufficient number of Russian language classes on the school curriculum: two hours per week in 7-8th grades, three hours in 9th grades, and senior – 12th grades have no Russian language on the curriculum at all.

ABOUT WHERE TO SEARCH FOR THE INFORMATION ON RUSSIAN UNIVERSITIES

People mostly search for the information on Russian universities on social media platforms (the page of the Russian House in Ulaanbaatar on Facebook (Meta is banned across the Russian Federation) has 25,000 followers), from relatives and friends, on the website of the Ministry of Education of Mongolia, radio and TV.

The Russian House hosts live streams on Facebook (Meta is banned across the Russian Federation), online education fairs, career guidance events with the participation of universities. Such online meetings have been actively introduced since the second half of 2021.

The information on the study opportunities in Russia is disseminated through Russian Language Centers (RLC) supervised by the Russian House. There are 53 RLC throughout Mongolia: 24 in Ulaanbaatar and 29 in aimaks.

Russian language Olympiads in aimaks allow gifted children from faraway provinces to obtain certificates that guarantee free tuition at Russian universities funded by the Russian Government.

The Russian House actively cooperates with Russian schools where Mongolian citizens study. For example, with the branch of Plekhanov Russian University of Economics – 1,700 students, the joint Mongolian-Russian school \mathbb{N} 3 – 2,700 students.

ABOUT ADMISSION TO RUSSIAN UNIVERSITIES

The Rossotrudnichestvo representative office is Mongolia's single operator to recruit foreign citizens to fill the Russian Government quotas. Applicants register on education-in-russia.com and participate in the portfolio competition.



The portfolio competition has been held at the Rossotrudnichestvo representative office in Mongolia since 2020. In pre-covid times, the representatives of top Russian universities used to come to Mongolia and conduct selective tests.

Young people planning to apply as first-year university students are interviewed. These are mostly school leavers who finished schools using Russian educational programs. Other Mongolian applicants join the preparatory faculty, so the portfolio competition is held for them.

To pass the competitive selection and make the list of candidates, young people should take an active part on the Olympiads on major subjects, as well as in the Russian language and other subjects competitions. University Olympiads add some points to the candidate's portfolio, and their public and volunteering activities and participation in sports and cultural and educational contests and festivals, research and practice conferences are also taken into account.

We recommend that those dreaming of studying in Russia follow the page of the Russian House in Ulaanbaatar on Facebook (Meta is banned across the Russian Federation) which contains detailed information on requirements and conditions for participation in selective tests.

From now on, each candidate becomes personally responsible, which is the first step towards completion of selective tests.

ABOUT POPULAR MAJORS

Russia's higher education system traditionally has a high-quality school of training specialists for various sectors of the economy, so active career guidance counseling for school and university students, including Mongolian ones, is always relevant. Now our task is to turn young people's attention to regional universities of Russia, not only Moscow or Saint Petersburg universities. We offer excellent higher education in Krasnoyarsk, Novosibirsk, Ulan-Ude, and other territories located near to Mongolia.

Such fields of study as medicine, law, international relations, economics are especially popular among Mongolian students. The number of those wishing to pursue a degree in Psychology is on the increase. IT and engineering majors also become popular.



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In the coming years, Mongolia may need, in relation to construction of the Soyuz Vostok pipeline, professionals specializing in Electric Power Engineering and Electrical Engineering; Oil and Gas Engineering; Automation of Technological Processes and Production. Tomsk Polytechnic University has already announced its readiness to start admitting and teaching students from Mongolia in the following academic year.

Today more than 300 citizens of Mongolia have a TPU degree. The cluster which is being developed now – the Russian House in Ulaanbaatar – the Soyuz Vostok pipeline – TPU does the work for the long run. **The personnel for the pipeline the section of which will cross Mongolia may be needed very soon, and Mongolian young people are very likely to get a prestigious and soughtafter profession.**

In 2022, we celebrate the 100th anniversary of the day when the first Mongolian students were admitted to Soviet and Russian universities and more than 100 years of diplomatic relations between our friendly countries. For Mongolian students, studying in Russia is an opportunity not only to get a decent education but also to live in a beautiful country with rich culture and outstanding art. Former school students can apply to Russian universities for educational programs of higher, secondary, and continuing professional education.

To familiarize Mongolian young people with higher education in Russia, we have collected the key aspects of admission to Russian universities.

Career development is very important to me. To begin with, I ask myself, "If I choose one or another country and university of this country, what practical benefits will I have in Mongolia?" That's why, keeping in mind my interests and plans for the future, I've chosen a Russian university.

First of all, I've made my choice because the animal breeding and economic management methods in Buryatia, especially in Selenginsky District, are very similar to the same methods in the central aimaks of Mongolia. I, for one, chose this university because of its territorial proximity to Mongolia. That's why I started examining the information about the cities and universities which are within reach. Of course, the first city I considered was Irkutsk, which is well known by many Mongolians, but the admission threshold there was higher than that in Ulan-Ude.

ADMISSION TO RUSSIAN UNIVERSITIES

Every year the Russian Government allocates quota (free for students) places for Mongolian young people to study at Russian universities. There were 600 such places this year.

Mongolian citizens can also study at Russian universities on a fee-paying basis. The cost of the educational programs is significantly lower than that of programs at universities in Europe and America, and Asian countries.

RUSSIAN HOUSE IN MONGOLIA

Russia and Mongolia have long been maintaining amicable relations. They have been cultivating contacts in the field of science, education, culture, sports, and other areas. The Russian-Mongolian friendship days and cross festivals of culture are held on a regular basis. Many Russian universities cooperate with educational institutions in Mongolia.

To familiarize school students with Russian education, the Rossotrudnichestvo representative office – Russian House in Ulaanbaatar – holds some events for them:

- Russian language and natural sciences Olympiads – the winners can get an education quota place at a Russian university
- Russian language courses if attendees successfully complete them, they can apply for an education quota place at a Russian university
- various events held in Russian and with the translation into Mongolian
- educational services fairs where staff members of prestigious Russian universities present their educational programs and tell the participants about admission requirements

ADMISSION REGULATIONS AT RUSSIAN UNIVERSITIES

Foreign citizens can take entrance exams held by the university even if they have valid results of the Unified State Exams. The admission office will take into consideration a better result.

Foreign citizens have the right to combine the results of the Unified State Exams (USE) and entrance exams. For example, if the applicant passes the USE in the Russian language with high scores, they submit the result to the admission office. But if the applicant is dissatisfied with their USE score in mathematics, they can take the entrance exam to try to improve their result. Finally, the highest score is chosen.

Foreign citizens are eligible for state-funded places if they apply under the international education agreements or have compatriot status. Applicants applying within the Russian Government quotas apply to a university as part of a special competition for foreign nationals.

Those applying as compatriots cannot exercise special rights – neither social rights nor rights related to the applicant's achievements.

Some universities have reduced the number of entrance exams for international applicants applying for fee-paying places (on a contract basis) to one. Foreign citizens apply as part of a special competition without competing with Russian applicants. However, you should bear in mind that the number of entrance exams is determined by a university itself. You must get more specific information from the admission office.

The procedure for translating foreign documents into Russian is changed. Some universities undertook to perform this procedure.

The document recognition certificate (if necessary) is submitted not later than on the day of enrollment consent submission. So you should find out beforehand where you can undergo this procedure, how to pay the duty, and clarify other issues for yourself.

Foreign documents must be legalized, if necessary.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR RUSSIA

- Russia entry form completed on the State Services website
- Valid negative PCR test and retest taken within 72 hours from the date of arrival in Russia. As of the date of receiving the test results in Russia, students must isolate themselves. At the same time, they can study online
- If the PCR test is positive, applicants or students undergo a twoweek quarantine
- To continue their education offline, international students must submit two negative PCR tests to the university

Some top universities admit foreign citizens to Bachelor's / Master's / Specialist programs based on the portfolio competition. Prepare separate files for each university you are going to apply to.

For example, Saint Petersburg State University assesses motivations letters, academic training documents, documents confirming the level of proficiency in the language of instruction as well as individual achievements.

Peoples' Friendship University of Russia will count the grade average of the previous education result. Special focus will be on the subjects related to future majors, participation in major disciplines contests, recommendations from non-governmental organizations, unions, associations of Russian and foreign institutions. For Master's programs, the positions of the previous university in the world ranking will be taken into account.

Mongolian graduates of Russian universities come home after graduation with solid background and hold senior positions at the ministries, major enterprises, in the real sector of the economy.

ACCOMMODATION

In my native country, I worked as a computer technology teacher at a polytechnic college. I got an offer to take part in a PhD scholarship program. I applied for it, and Pacific National University chose me.

In the beginning, I took a preparatory course in an engineering group. I studied Russian, speech styles, mathematics, physics, and Russian geography. Russian was the most difficult subject.

In Rwanda, we know little about Russia, only that it is a country with super technology, which ranks among the top five best countries in the world. When I was coming to Russia, I wasn't worried. I read about the country and knew that the police work well here. And if you come legally, everyone will be happy to see you.

The education system in Russia is more developed than that in Rwanda, as it exists for a longer time. Teachers have more opportunities for enhancement in Russia. There are libraries and laboratories. That's great.







Competition for quotas to study at Russian universities

Every year the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of Russia and Rossotrudnichestvo announce admission of foreign citizens, stateless persons and compatriots living abroad to study at Russian universities in state-funded places within the quota. One of the ways to get an invitation from a Russian university is to successfully undergo the selection process abroad – in the foreign citizen's country of residence. Let us look at this stage in detail.

APPLYING WITHIN THE QUOTA



The information about each application pursued is sent by the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of Russia to Rossotrudnichestvo that brings it to the notice of Russian and foreign embassies and its representative offices abroad. The documents of approved candidates are sent to the universities.

The university must compile the list of international applicants until July 1. If future majors require creative abilities, special physical or psychological characteristics, foreign nationals will be invited to take an additional exam – it must take place until August 5. The university may decide to conduct this test online but only if the person taking the test is accurately identified.

What about applicants who were not admitted to the universities they chose? In this case, their documents will be submitted for review to the two universities that have the smallest number of international students and offer the same study program. 3

After applicants are notified by Russian and foreign representative offices that they have been admitted to the university, they must contact the university's International Relations Department or the International Office by email or phone and inform them about the date of their arrival.

Students from some countries must undergo the process of recognition of their foreign education document before they arrive at a Russian university to study. The legalization procedure was covered in HED Issue 6.

Universities will not accept foreign candidates' documents not translated into Russian, translations that are not certified, and documents that are not completed according to the requirements as well as documents independently submitted by the citizens of the country of stay.



Right after your arrival at the university, you should contact the International Relations Department or International Office to execute all the documents required in the territory of Russia. For this purpose, bring your passport and migration card which was issued at the border when entering Russia. Health insurance policies are executed separately.

Upon arrival, applicants submit their original documents.
