Good opportunities for your future career

For students from Central Asia

Every year a lot of international students come to study at Russian universities. Russian education is especially popular among students from the CIS countries – 85% of students come from Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Kyrgyzstan.

High-quality training, living conditions, well-developed campus infrastructure, active international cooperation, exchange programs, opportunities for successful personal development in science, sports and Olympiad movement – all of this attracts talented students to Russian universities.

PARTNERS AND FRIENDS

For many years, Russia and the countries of Central Asia have been united by the ties of friendship and traditions of mutual support, trust and respect. The Russian regions support the expansion of relations and exchanges with the partners from Asia in art and culture, through public associations, religious, economic or other associations, contribute to the development of cooperation among youth organizations and student exchange.

Our countries successfully implement largescale joint projects. For example, Uzbekistan is building the first nuclear power plant in cooperation with the Russian specialists. Sangtudin Hydropower Plant-1 (it provides over 12% of electric power output in the republic) has been working in Tajikistan for over ten years. Last year Russia's largest automobile corporation KAMAZ supplied around 2,000 pieces of automotive equipment to Turkmenistan. Kyrgyzstan has launched the Talas gold ore plant. Mineral fertilizers are jointly produced in the Zhambyl region of Kazakhstan. Cultural and humanitarian relations between our countries are also well-developed. Children have the opportunity to go to Russian schools. Central Asia has the Internet resource "Russian School Support System" supported by Rossotrudnichestvo. With its assistance, students and teachers have the opportunity to gain free access to thousands of e-books of diverse content and various purpose. Significantly, studying at Russian-language schools provides applicants from the CIS countries with the opportunity to apply to Russian universities on equal terms with Russian citizens.

Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, and Uzbekistan have Russian Houses, and Turkmenistan has the Embassy of Russia. In the absence of language barriers, Russian universities take an active part in educational platforms and fairs held in the CIS countries and organize various Olympiads.

According to the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of Russia, 85% of international students come to Russia from the CIS countries: Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Turkmenistan, Tajikistan, Kyrgyzstan. Every year around 160,000 citizens of the Central Asia states study in Russia, 60,000 of them studying within the quota.





SOUGHT-AFTER SPECIALISTS IN THE COUNTRIES OF CENTRAL ASIA

These are general data. And now let's see what specialists are most sought-after in the countries of Central Asia.



In **Kazakhstan**, the shortage of qualified engineers is being felt in the construction and machine-building industries today. No less pressing is the issue of filling the vacancies in metallurgy, power engineering and oil and gas industries.

Today the most popular fields of study among the citizens of **Turkmenistan** are linguistics, economics, international relations, oil and gas engineering, informatics and computer engineering, architecture, psychology and dentistry. There is an interest in training engineering personnel as well as IT specialists. The leading economic sector in **Kyrgyzstan** is agriculture. It mainly includes crop farming (growing grain, cotton, tobacco, oil-bearing crops, horticultural crops and gourds), beef and dairy cattle breeding, sheep breeding. It creates around 40% of the gross added value and employs more than half of ablebodied population. The share of farming lands is over 50% of the entire territory of the republic.

Tajikistan , like any other CIS countries, has long been suffering a shortage of qualified personnel for the hi-tech industry, in particular, for creating IT parks. Besides, the country has huge hydropower potential, non-ferrous metal stocks, rare opportunities for agriculture, great prospects for the development of tourism.

Over the last twelve years, the number of students from **Uzbekistan** at Russian universities has increased more than threefold. Medicine and engineering and technology majors – especially metallurgy, mechanical engineering, geology and mineral exploration, informatics and computer engineering are most popular among those applying for full-time studies. At the same time, extramural students prefer economics and management.

In 2021, Russia ranked fifth in the world by the number of international students. The number of citizens of the CIS countries enrolled in Bachelor's, Specialist's and Master's programs within the Russian Government quota has increased by a quarter over the last two years.

WHY STUDY AT RUSSIAN UNIVERSITIES

- Russian universities and teachers take a unique approach to teaching
- Students come to Russia to get high-quality and sometimes more affordable education. Many of them even manage to earn a degree for free. Every year state-funded places for foreign citizens are allocated – 23,000 were allocated in 2022. Within the government quota they can enter more than 450 state Russian universities. For this purpose (in some cases), they must pass required exams*. At regional universities the competition is low, and the minimum score is sufficient for admission
- The citizens of the country often underestimate the place they live in. To foreigners, Russia seems a territory with unique nature, architecture and a combination of two cultures – Asian and European. History lovers and erudite people will not remain indifferent. Citizens of Mongolia, China, Korea, Vietnam, and Serbia show special respect to Russia. The degree earned in our country is highly valued in students' home countries. A prestigious degree is a key to career success. Many people like the Russian mentality: sociability, hospitality, warmheartedness, sincerity. This is especially attractive to people living in Asia
- Solid academic background provides the opportunity for personal development both in profession and research
- Foreigners are attracted by strong financial support during their studies: scholarships and bonuses for academic excellence and active efforts. Besides, those proving themselves during the semester are awarded various prizes such as tourist trips, movie or theater tickets

FIRST-YEAR STUDENT ADAPTATION

To quickly familiarize international first-year students with the environment, society and local culture, Russian universities have developed and successfully apply various adaptation programs for international students.

For example, Volga State University of Water Transport has everything international students need for interesting and comfortable studies.

- The staff members of the International Relations Office keep in contact with applicants 24/7 using messengers and email. They help students in arriving in Russia, obtaining and extending visas, accommodating in the dormitory and provide assistance in obtaining health insurance and undergoing medical examination and dactyloscopy
- The student group advisors monitor the performance of international students, and monthly attestation allows them to track student progress, identify the problems in time and provide required assistance to students
- International students of Volga University take an active part in all cultural, entertainment and sports events held by the university

The issue of socio-cultural adaptation of international students at Nizhny Novgorod universities is supervised at the level of the Ministry of Education, Science and Youth Policy of the region. Every year the university holds the We are Together workshop for international students as part of which international students from different universities of the city meet, visit theaters and museums, go on tours, take part in festivals of national cultures and Spartakiads.

These events unite VSUWT students, provide them with an excellent opportunity to creatively tell others about themselves and their culture, learn a lot of interesting things about other peoples, prove themselves in sports, make friends with the representatives of other nationalities and countries.

POPULARITY OF RUSSIAN EDUCATION

Astana and Moscow have built strong ties at all levels. The presidents of the states often hold meetings. There are joint commissions of ministries and government agencies. The business and educational projects are developed. Russians and Kazakhstanis maintain multilevel horizontal relationships.

Students studying in Russia get high-quality education. As a rule, they go back home and contribute significantly to the development of their country. Now the borders are open, and young men or girls can go to any country in the world and acquire a profession there.

The competition among higher education institutions is high. But for all that, many Kazakhstanis strive to enter Russian universities. On the one hand, this is facilitated by geographical proximity of the countries, the language environment which continues to be Russian, and on the other hand, the level of Russian education which is on the rise. Kazakhstani students choose sought-after professions and fields of study such as IT, robotics, radio electronics, mining, engineering. However, we can notice that such professions as lawyers and financiers are losing popularity.

EDUCATION QUOTAS

Today the number of Kazakhstanis is 25% of the total number of international students in Russia. The number of quota places allocated by the Russian Federation Government for applicants from Kazakhstan is trending upward. There were 500 places last year, and all of them were used. Seven hundred places have already been allocated for the academic year 2023/2024, and we can see prospective students' interest in Russian education. This is illustrated by the last year's competition which was three applicants per place.

According to the Embassy of the Republic Kazakhstan in the Russian Federation, there are 61,000 Kazakhstani students pursuing different educational programs in Russia at the moment. The educational grants to study are allocated as part of the intergovernmental agreements. These also include the quota places for students from Kazakhstan whose tuition costs are fully covered by the Russian budget. Most Kazakhstanis try to apply to Russian universities within the quota through Rossotrudnichestvo but there are people applying independently.

I will reveal a secret to applicants – universities value not only your grades in your secondary school certificates but also your proactive attitude, your participation in public life, Olympiads, sports and your achievements. All of this increases your admission chances.

RUSSIAN HOUSE IN ASTANA

Russian Education



for Students from Kyrgyzstan

Throughout their centuries-old history, Russia and Kyrgyzstan have been maintaining reliable, friendly and strategic relationships. Education in Russia has always been in high and stable demand with Kyrgyz school leavers. Highquality and fundamental education obtained at Russian universities provides graduates with the opportunity to pursue career and research as well as find a job not only in Russia and Kyrgyzstan but also all over the world.

Albert Zulkharneev, Head of the Russian House in Bishkek, talks about Kyrgyz school students' interest in Russian higher education and training highly qualified specialists for Kyrgyzstan economy.

AFFORDABILITY OF RUSSIAN EDUCATION

In Kyrgyzstan, Russian universities have proved themselves as leaders in such disciplines as mathematics, physics, chemistry, in training competent IT programmers, medical professionals, creative professionals.

For the academic year 2022-2023, the Russian Government allocated 500 quota places for citizens of Kyrgyzstan to study at Russian universities. Given the Kyrzyz school leavers' demand for Russian education which increases from year to year, it was decided to increase the number of state-funded places up to 700 for the academic year 2023-2024. Thus, the trends of recent years show a gradual and stable increase in the number of quota places. The competition is three applicants per place. As of October 1, 2021 over 8,000 citizens of Kyrgyzstan pursue educational programs of higher education – Bachelor's, Specialist's, Master's programs in all modes of study at Russian universities, including foreign branches of Russian universities and joint educational organizations.



According to the statistics, such fields of study such as medicine, economics, informatics and computer engineering as well as all engineering majors have been in high demand among Kyrgyz applicants over the last years. Prospective applicants choose all available and alternative ways to get admitted to Russian universities. However, it should be noted that most school leavers apply within the Russian Federation Government quotas as this guarantees stability, security and scholarships while studying.





UNIVERSITY ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Candidates to study at Russian universities within the Russian Government quotas are selected in the territory of Kyrgyzstan only by efforts of the representative office. This is stipulated by the bilateral agreements and eliminates all corruption risks to the greatest possible extent.

Prospective applicants upload the required documents only online! Applicants get all the detailed information on the documents through all the social media platforms of the representative office, through handouts at the meetings, and from mass media. The consultations are given in different formats.

If we do a quick recap of document requirements, candidates must register in the education-in-russia.com system and attach to their application the scanned original documents, the list of which is posted on the official web pages of the representative office.

- 11th graders must upload their 10th grade transcript
- All candidates must upload the notarized translation of their regular passport (international passport) as well as documents confirming their individual achievements: certificates and diplomas, including those confirming their participation in volunteering, sports and cultural and educational contests, Olympiads

Candidates can choose up to six universities in three federal districts of Russia at the same time. Applying for Bachelor's and Specialist's programs, applicants must take compulsory tests in major subjects. For other degree levels, the portfolio competition is held.

According to the selection results, the lists are compiled, which are approved by the working group. The representative office does not conduct the interview, and candidates are selected according to the authorized procedure. All the procedures are extremely transparent for everyone interested.

We advise candidates to prepare all the required documents for application in the best possible way, meet all the technical requirements for filling in the application form and adhere to the document upload dates.

The Rossotrudnichestvo representative office in Kyrgyzstan

makes extensive focused efforts to attract Kyrgyz school leavers to Russian universities. Twice a year, in recent years, the Russian education weeks are held with the participation of the top Russian universities. Specialists from the universities meet with school and university students of educational organizations in all the regions of the country.

Every week we publish the information on the Russian universities and their Olympiads. The online career guidance marathon "Russia is with You" took place in Kyrgyzstan in October-November. The school students asked the career guidance specialist their questions and got more detailed information on different fields and professions, on how to achieve career success and how to pay much attention to the secrets of successful communication and personal presentation that will help adapt to any team.

Good high-quality and fundamental education allowed many of them to occupy leadership positions at government entities and various commercial organizations.

The country's economy needs top-notch specialists at the moment. We are talking about many sectors, be it mining engineering, pedagogy, medicine, or any other sought-after area of activity. In this regard, graduates of technical universities are promising specialists with expected high salaries in Kyrgyzstan.

Russian Education



for Students from Tajikistan

Russia and Tajikistan are strategic partners and allies in many areas. This is also supported by the number of allocated education quota places – it grows from year to year. If 750 quota places were allocated for the republic (around 5,000 people submitted their applications then) last year, around 1,000 places are expected in a new quota campaign for the academic year 2023/2024, as agreed by the heads of the two states – Vladimir Putin and Emomali Rahmon. Thus, one of the biggest education quotas in the world has consistently been allocated for Tajikistan.

Ivan Ivanov, Head of the Rossotrudnichestvo representative office in Tajikistan, talks about how the representative offices of Rossotrudnichestvo in Tajikistan help students prepare for admission to Russian universities and what applicants should know to successfully pass the competitive selection for quota places.

PREPARATION FOR ADMISSION

Today around 30,000 students from Tajikistan study at Russian universities at all education levels from Bachelor's degree to PhD degree. Russian higher education is rightfully sought after by local young people. So it comes as no surprise that we can observe a dynamic increase in applicants' interest every year.

The most ambitious 10-11th graders start preparing for the quota campaign of admission to Russian universities in advance, taking preparatory courses at the Russian Houses in Dushanbe and Khodzhent. The courses offer in-depth study of engineering, humanities, medicine, and economics subjects. Students are taught by the participants of the Russian Teacher Abroad project – subject teachers who work using Russian educational programs. This also gives an edge to those who apply to Russian universities directly and on equal terms with Russian citizens using the materials that they have already studied and meeting the requirements that are already familiar to them.

The remarkable thing is that the level of training is so high that around 80% of students who completed our preparatory courses get successfully admitted to Russian higher education institutions within the quotas or as part of direct recruitment.

HOW ARE CANDIDATES FOR QUOTA PLACES SELECTED?

The quota campaign starts when the electronic registration system is launched. All candidates create personal accounts where they upload their personal data, scanned documents, portfolios and specify their achievements. Then candidates are assigned identification numbers. Only applicants have access to personal accounts, and third party intervention is out of question.

Last year the procedure for testing and **selecting applicants for Bachelor's and Specialist's programs** was conducted online, in the system of so-called proctoring. On the appointed day, applicants took major subject tests online, with mandatory video surveillance – Russian specialists monitored the procedure integrity to prevent violations and fraud. After the results had been processed, the applicants got the total score through their Personal Accounts. Their current place in the ranking was also displayed there.

NB. Taking into account that 93% of the country area are occupied by mountains, stable high-speed internet is not available everywhere, and this can affect the online testing procedure. That's why, to provide equal opportunities for applicants, we created the external testing center in cooperation with our partners – the MegaFon Tajikistan company and the cultural and educational center under Dushanbe eparchy. More than 100 computer workplaces with high-speed internet were allocated. Young men and girls managed to connect and take the test. This practice approved itself, and we will extend similar practices in the future.

Applicants for Master's, PhD and residency programs are selected as in the old times: in the format of oral in-person/ remote interviews. For this purpose, a special commission consisting of Russian universities' representatives is established- for example, last year more than 50 people from 24 universities made up the group. The commission works as part of four clusters: technology, medicine, humanities, and creativity.

The applicants' level of competence is assessed not only by the universities' representatives in the commissions but also by the representatives of the Ministry of Education and Science of Tajikistan, the Russian diplomatic mission, business entities and even doctors from the military hospital of the 201th Russian military base. As a result, we have a qualified group of specialists competent in all areas.

The documents for everybody changing their status from applicant to student at the final stage are executed by our colleagues from the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of Russia.





EDUCATION FAIRS AND MEETINGS

Career guidance at the Russian Houses in Tajikistan comprises a broad range of activities. We place the information on the Internet, on social media platforms, in mass media, in the HED magazine. We openly participate in live radio and TV programs, answering applicants and their relatives' questions.

It is important to bear in mind that Tajikistan is a friendly country, and families take an active part in their children's life. That's why we always meet applicants halfway and give explanatory consultations both in the capital and in the regions.

Another area is offline meetings with the representatives of partner universities. They not only come to our platform with their career guidance activities but also conduct tests and hold Olympiads. We also work a lot with the universities as part of the traditional education exhibition fair. This summer the 10th anniversary exhibition of Russian education took place in Dushanbe and Khodzhent. The representatives of 34 universities came here, and the exhibition was visited by around 9,000 people – school students and their parents, university students and teachers during three days.

The exhibition aims to present universities' opportunities, fields of study, help young people decide on their future profession, familiarize them with the regional universities and cities of Russia. Local applicants traditionally choose Top 3: Moscow – Saint Petersburg – Kazan. However, there are a lot of decent universities and scientific centers in other regions of our country.

And we want to get across this idea so that parents and children can ask the university representatives some questions themselves, get the information not only about studies and scholarships but also about living conditions, extracurricular activities, the city itself, climate and even about the Tajik compatriot association in the region (this aspect is also important to many).

We consider the big annual event from our friend and partner, the MegaFon Tajikistan company – MegaFon Fest one of the mass events to keep the public informed. In 2022, this real festival for the city residents brought together over 20,000 people. The Rossotrudnichestvo information center was engaged in the event.

POPULAR PROFESSIONS

The technology cluster is our unconditional priority. In particular, the **IT industry**. Russia is an apparent leader in this field, that's why a great number of universities with many years of tradition, with the constantly updating methodological framework and well-developed facilities and resources are sought after by applicants.

Architecture, civil engineering, electric power engineering and electrical engineering are also popular in our country. Medicine: general medicine, dentistry, surgery is a traditionally important field in the republic. Humanities are in great demand. The priorities change a little from year to year but economics, international relations and law are always in Top 3.

The top creative professions are **design**, **directing and TV**, **musical and instrumental arts**. Speaking from my own experience, being a judge in the cultural cluster is a right that should be deserved because students prepare, come with their instruments, someone plays scenes from stage performances, someone sings, someone dances – this is always a very decent performance. We have built close ties with Russian universities for culture and arts.

Russian Education for Students from Turkmenistan

Citizens of Turkmenistan apply to Russian universities in different ways. Many of them make significant efforts to get a coveted state-funded place within the quota. Some senior high school students take an active part in online international and university Olympiads, win prizes, get bonuses when applying. Russian education is in great demand in Turkmenistan, that's why many students are ready to study even on a fee-paying basis.

Yulia Zaytseva, a Rossotrudnichestvo representative in Turkmenistan, talks about how applicants are selected for Russian universities and how to prepare for an interview.

ADMISSION WITHIN EDUCATION QUOTAS

In 2022, the Russian Government allocated 250 quota places for Turkmenistan for all study programs – from Specialist's degrees to PhD degrees. This is 50 places more than in 2020. Every year we can observe a significant increase in the number of those wishing to get into Russian universities, the competition is very high. So, over 2,000 applications were submitted in 2021, this is actually eight applicants per place.

Russian universities recruit students to apply for Bachelor's, Specialist's, Master's, PhD programs. Besides applying within employer-sponsored education quotas, citizens of Turkmenistan can participate in entrance exams for various majors held by the universities offline and online. Fee-paying education is also available.

It is difficult to determine the specific number of students at Russian universities because many people contact educational organizations directly. But we think that thousands of students study in Russia.



THE RUSSIAN HOUSE'S ACTIVITIES

This year the Russian House in Ashgabat took part in the major international exhibition "Healthcare, Education and Sports in the Era of Renaissance of a New Epoch of the Mighty State." The big exhibition stand displayed all the information on selection within the quota for the academic year 2022/2023, materials about top Russian universities every foreign citizen can apply to. The information was also available online.

The Russian House actively cooperates with the Turkmen-Russian secondary school named after A.S. Pushkin where school students are taught according to Russian standards. This is one of the leading schools in the country with highly motivated school leavers – they score high in the Unified State Exams, get admitted to Russian universities within the quota, study in state-funded places.

Besides, we make presentations, post the information on the Russian universities, enrollment campaign aspects, Olympiads and competitions on our social media platforms, talk about majors and living conditions. We try to give as much useful information as possible about the city and region where applicants plan to study.



HOW APPLICANTS ARE SELECTED BY RUSSIAN UNIVERSITIES

The selection process has two stages.

The first stage – application submission: candidates fill in the application form, attach the required package of documents and wait for verification. All these steps are done online on the specially designed portal education-in-russia.com. This is a very convenient and modern way because you can do all the required steps from home.

Later, at the fixed time, applicants undergo selection tests: a test for prospective Bachelors and Specialists and an interview for Masters, PhD students and medical residents. This is the most difficult period for prospective candidates.

The portfolio competition is held, where bonus points for individual achievements are calculated, for example, for participation in international Olympiads, volunteering and sports victories. All the points are calculated exactly based on the fixed routine with categorization.

At the end of the first stage, the sheet with the selection tests results is attached to the application of each candidate who successfully passed the test or interview.



2 The second stage – sending applications of candidates who successfully passed the selection tests for verification to the central office of Rossotrudnichestvo. Later, the applications are sent to the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of Russia for further distribution, referral and enrollment of applicants at the universities.

You can successfully pass the selection tests if you study every day. Do not wait for your final year at school to start preparing anxiously for your exams. Learning new material, looking through the tasks of the Unified State Exams, doing all possible tests, reading imaginative and academic literature, participating in intellectual games, developing yourself – all of this should be done every day, and you should start doing it now and pursue your goal systematically. This is a key to success.

Definitely, the strongest piece of advice is to choose a major and future profession to your liking, as the saying goes. It is important for us not only to provide students with high-quality education but also to allow them to make constant progress, reveal their best character traits, intellectual abilities, become respected citizens and professionals.

International Student Admission and Adaptation

at M. K. Ammosov North–Eastern Federal University

Foreign citizens and stateless persons have the right to apply to Russian universities for educational programs of higher, secondary and continuing professional education.

Today over 300,000 international students study in state-funded and feepaying places at Russian universities. In the following years, Russia plans to increase the number of students up to 710,000. Russian education is especially popular among students from the CIS countries – around 30% of students enrolled through Rossotrudnichestvo are our nearest neighbors.

Let's look at the aspects of admission, studying and adaptation of international students at Russian universities considering an example of North-Eastern Federal University.

THE WAYS TO GET ADMITTED

The most popular ways to get admitted to Russian universities are to get a quota from the Russian Government and pass the universities' internal entrance exams.

To apply for **quota** places, you must register in the education-in-russia. com system, fill in the application form, attach your documents and follow further instructions. You are to pass the competitive selection organized by Rossotrudnichestvo in your country and choose the university you want to apply to.

For example, you can specify North-Eastern Federal University in your application form as a priority university to apply to. Later you will get a referral to the university, and you can come and begin you studies after you obtain your visa.

If you want to apply for a state-funded place or a fee-paying place **on equal terms**, register on the NEFU website postupi.s-vfu.ru.

In Applicant's Personal Account on the NEFU website upload your documents, secondary school certificate or university diploma with the translation into Russian and your passport also translated into Russian. After you fill in the application form, your entrance exam date will be fixed. To apply on a contract basis, you must pass only one exam

in your major subject. After you get the exam result, you must sign the enrollment consent and the agreement.

Why did you decide to study at NEFU?

 After finishing school, I took part in the presentation of Russian universities in Bishkek, where NEFU was presented. We took the test, I passed it successfully and managed to enter NEFU.

Did you take a pre-university training course at the preparatory faculty?

 No, I learned Russian quite well at school, and that's why I could join the university without studying at the preparatory department.

How did you imagine studying at the university you chose? Did it meet your expectations?

- I was afraid that it would be very cold and I wouldn't be able to adapt. But now I have a lot friends and a job in Yakutsk, and I've got used to the climate.

What is your field of study? Share your impressions of your studies.

 Now I am pursuing a residency in Pediatrics and before that I had completed my Specialist's degree in this field at NEFU.
 Surely, studying is difficult but you can cope with it.

Do you have a favorite set of disciplines?

– Topographic anatomy. It is interesting because we can study each human organ.

What difficulties do you have to face while studying? Who helps you overcome them?

- Now the main difficulty is to handle patients, or rather their parents. We have a lot of difficult situations but we can cope with everything thanks to our senior colleagues. Higher education in Russia is pursued by a great number of students from the countries of Central Asia:

The university has one of the two Russia's centers accredited by the Society for Simulation in Europe (SESAM). The center allows students to acquire practical skills and master the methods for providing medical care on state-of-the-art equipment.

Students have the opportunity to pursue science and research. The university offers grants in the amount of up to **500,000 RUB** to students for the implementation of their own projects. In 2019-2021, more than 70 SibMed students got such payments.

Research

SibMed comprises seven world-class laboratories implementing special projects on bionic digital platforms, targeted theranostics, education, precision medicine.

SibMed's multidisciplinary clinics

SibMed students have a unique opportunity to study and undertake internships at ten multidisciplinary clinics of the university fitted with state-of-the-art expert-class equipment. Every year over 20,000 patients

from Russia and the CIS countries receive medical care here.



SibMed has ten specialized clinics: the Obstetrics and Gynecology Clinic, the

Urology Clinic, the Surgery Clinic, the Ophthalmology Clinic, the Endocrinology Clinic, the Neurology Clinic, the Children's Clinic, the General Medicine Clinic, the Infectious Disease Clinic, and the Rheumatology Clinic.

International students can undergo practical training both at the SibMed clinics and other medical organizations, including the organizations in the CIS countries and other foreign countries.



INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

Among the partners are leading universities of China . India . Brazil . CIS countries, and others.

In cooperation with Tashkent Medical Academy in Uzbekistan —, the university is preparing to launch the **Master's program in Management**.
