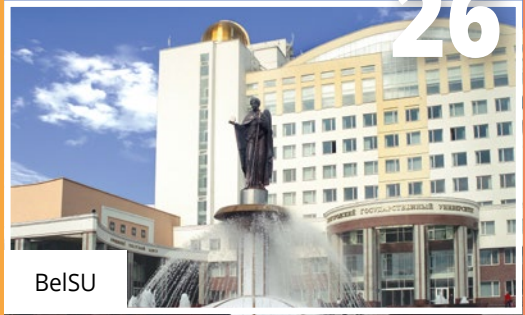

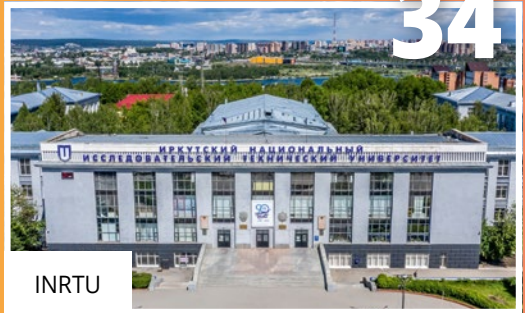

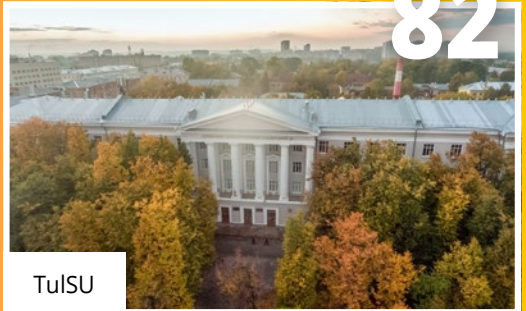

Changes in the Migration Registration

THE PROCEDURE FOR EXECUTING DOCUMENTS TO STUDY IN RUSSIA HAS BEEN SIMPLIFIED

The migration regulations set by the law apply to all foreign citizens coming to Russia for different reasons. Let's look at the changes that have taken place in the migration legislation over the last months.

PERMISSION TO STAY IN RUSSIA WHILE STUDYING

For a special category of migrants – international students at Russian universities – a new type of document went into effect in Russia on January 1, 2023 – a **temporary residence permit for the purpose of obtaining education (RVPO)**.

EXECUTION REQUIREMENTS AND VALIDITY PERIODS

- International students or PhD students studying full time at state universities or scientific organizations may obtain* an RVPO. Students must prepare their documents and submit them in person to the Migration Department of the Directorate of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the region where they study, or online via the State Services portal
- The documents are usually executed within around two months if they are submitted in full and with no errors
- If you transfer to another university or another educational program, your RVPO will remain valid. The main thing is that you should still study full time and your new program should be state-accredited too. Do not forget to send your package of transfer documents to the Ministry of Internal Affairs within 30 calendar days, otherwise your RVPO may be revoked

*The order of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Russian Federation of December 14, 2022 № 949

The innovation will facilitate migration registration for students and will allow them to focus on their studies. Now they do not have to be anxious about upcoming expiration of any document. They do not have to extend their RVPO every year.

RVPO ADVANTAGES

An RVPO gives you the right to live in Russia for the entire period of your study, get free medical care under your compulsory health insurance policy, get permanent registration as well as find formal employment without a patent and work permit in the RVPO-issuing region.

In contrast to an ordinary temporary residence permit (RVP), if you have an RVPO, you do not have to submit the report on your stay in Russia to the Directorate for Migration Affairs every year. The ordinary RVP is valid for three years, and the RVPO is valid for the entire period of your study and for 180 days afterwards.

When getting an RVPO, international students from visa counties obtain a visa for the entire period of their study at once (for example, first-year Bachelor's students obtain a visa for four years at once). **Now they do not have to extend their visa every year.**



DOCUMENTS

The procedure for obtaining a temporary residence permit for the period of study is rather simple. Students must submit their package of documents.

1 The application in two copies (there are eight different options, and the application form is issued and filled in on the spot)

2 The identity document, at the applicant's option: a passport, the stateless person's temporary identity document, or any other document recognized in Russia. The passport is valid for at least three months until the expiration date as of the day of submission

3 The certificates of no criminal record of the applicant who has come to Russia on a visa (applicants from visa-free countries do not need these certificates). The document must be issued not earlier than three months prior to the application submission date

4 The documents proving family relationships such as a birth certificate, a marriage/divorce certificate, a change of name certificate, an adoption certificate, a document confirming the guardian's authorities

5 The order for enrollment at the university or research organization

7 The applicant's representative must submit an identity document, at their option: Russian citizen's passport, foreign citizen's passport, or any other document recognized in Russia

6 The documents the applicant has the right to submit upon their own initiative: a migration card (for visa-free countries)

8 Two 35×45 mm photos, black and white or color matte

Additionally, the following documents may be required:

- Birth, marriage, change of name certificates
- A green card confirming that the applicant has undergone mandatory fingerprinting
- Documents written in a foreign language are attached to an application with notarized translations into Russian

9 Medical certificates such as an addiction psychiatrist's opinion; an HIV certificate; a medical certificate confirming the absence of infectious diseases

10 Stamp duty payment receipt, 1,600 RUB

FINGERPRINTING

Fingerprinting is a mandatory procedure for all foreign citizens. It is undergone once within 90 calendar days from the date of entry into Russia, for free. You can leave your fingerprint samples when submitting documents or getting an RVP.

GETTING A PERMIT

- After the application for an RVPO is accepted, the international student will get a certificate confirming that the documents have been accepted
- In case of a positive decision on the issue of the RVPO, a corresponding stamp will be marked on the foreign citizen's identity document and the temporary resident's multiple entry visa will be issued for the duration of the permit
- In case of a negative decision on the issue of the RVPO, the foreign citizen will get a corresponding notice of denial

FOR PART-TIME AND EXTRAMURAL STUDENTS

Part-time and extramural international students will stay in the Russian Federation on the previous terms as temporary foreign residents:

- **visa-free foreign citizens** – based on the migration card specifying study as the purpose of the visit
- **visa-requiring foreign citizens** – based on the student visa

Based on the temporary residence permit issued for the period of study, international graduates may be eligible for a permanent residence permit. Young specialists will be able to submit an application within three years after graduation. Starting from 2023, this option is available to any graduate who has completed their degree. Before now, only honors student could take this privilege.

REASONS FOR RVPO DENIAL

- The RVPO is revoked if the student changes their mode of study from full-time to extramural and if they stay outside Russia for more than six months in total during one calendar year
- The RVPO will be denied if the student is expelled from the university
- If the applicant is taking drugs or psychotropic substances or suffering from an infectious disease which is dangerous for people around them
- The RVPO issuance service will be suspended if it turns out that the student has submitted fake documents or provided the knowingly false information about themselves

SIDE JOBS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

International students often combine their study and work. The main thing here is to comply with the essential requirements when employing students with temporary residence permits for the period of their study:

- students must be of age
- their work and study places must be located in the same region
- their work schedule must take into account their academic load

Foreign citizens can get employed in a simplified manner only if they are full-time students. Part-time or extramural international students must get a work permit.



How to Obtain a Student Visa?

And now you have become a Russian university student. We congratulate you and wish you academic excellence! Now it's time to have your migration documents executed to enter the country without any issues.

Residents of the countries, which do not have mutual visa-free travel agreements with Russia, must have officially confirmed reasons for visiting the country. That is why obtaining a visa to enter Russia starts for Chinese citizens with getting an invitation from the university they were enrolled at.

The consular institution processes visas only after applicants or their legal representatives submit a complete package of documents. After submitting the documents and paying the fee, foreign citizens get a receipt specifying the visa preparation dates. They must submit it when the time is due. The usual response time after submitting the documents is two-three weeks.



TIP

As soon as you get your visa, check it to make sure all your personal information is correct: last name, travel dates, passport number, date of birth, etc. If you notice some errors, give the visa back for correction at once. You can obtain an initial visa at the Russian Embassy/consulate in your country of residence. It is valid for not more than 90 days.

Later, this visa must be extended by the General Administration for Migration Issues of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Russia. There you will get a multiple entry visa for one year. Within this year, you can stay in Russia, leave and come back. After your visa expires, you must extend it every year until you graduate (except for those citizens who will obtain an RVPO (a temporary residence permit for students) – read on page...). Every time you extend your visa, you must apply for migration registration again.

HOW TO EXTEND YOUR STUDENT VISA?

You should contact the university's passport and visa support department not later than 45 days before your current visa expires and submit your document package, which usually includes:

- A completed application form
- 3.5×4.5 cm photo
- Copies of all passport pages
- A copy of the enrollment agreement or recommendation from the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of Russia
- The university's written request in any format specifying the reason for visa extension
- A stamp duty payment receipt
- A detachable section of arrival notification (you can get it during migration registration)
- An original migration card and its copies

E-VISA

Today the only visa format is a paper document which is glued in a passport. However, visas will be electronic soon, and foreign citizens will just have to upload them to their smartphones.

We have some more good news. To obtain a single e-visa, foreign citizens will not have to get an invitation to enter Russia from a natural person or legal entity.

The single e-visa system for foreign citizens is ready. We are waiting for it to be launched. Follow the news.

5 STEPS TO OBTAINING A STUDENT VISA

1

GETTING AN INVITATION

To get an invitation, foreign citizens must submit the package of documents to the chosen university (read about the procedures for legalization and recognition of academic credentials in HED № 6).

When applying within the quota, applicants send their documents to Rossotrudnichestvo and take entrance exams in their country of permanent residence.

You will have to wait for an invitation for approximately 45 days. It will be valid for three months. Within these months, you must settle the issue of further stay in Russia: sign a contract with the university or return home if you did not manage to enter the university.

Stamp duty on the issue of an invitation to study in state-accredited academic programs does not apply.

2

BUYING INSURANCE

Any insurance company operating in the Russian Federation issues health insurance policies. Compare the service packages on the websites of insurance companies and choose a suitable option. Insurance will cost approximately **4,000 – 20,000 RUB per year**, depending on the scope.

3

GETTING AN HIV CERTIFICATE

You can get it at health care centers. You must fill it out in Russian and English or get its notarized translation into Russian. The certificate is valid for three months. The fee is **1,000 – 3,000 RUB**.

PREPARING A VISA APPLICATION FORM

Fill out the application form on the website **visa.kdmid.ru**. You must print it out and glue the photos to it. You need two 3.5×4.5 cm photos (black and white or color). If it is not technically feasible to provide the information in electronic format, you are allowed to fill out the visa application form in the handwritten or printed form.

PAYING CONSULAR FEES

Overall visa fees also depend on consular fees collected in your country. You can get detailed information about visa fees on the website of the relevant Russian consulate abroad.



IMPORTANT!

- The list of visa application documents can be expanded. For detailed information, contact the Russian diplomatic institution in your country
- Check the expiration date of your international passport or any other ID document. It must be valid for at least 1.5 years from the visa issuance date

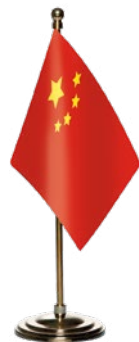


How Chinese Students Learn Russian

In one of our previous issues, we wrote that the Russian language is rightly considered one of the most difficult languages to study. As noted by Russian language teachers themselves, there are a lot of reasons for that, from Cyrillic alphabet and the difference between spelling and pronunciation to grammatical collisions. An impressive list of rules and an even more impressive list of exclusions to these rules do not make things easier for students at all.

Specialists point out that the Russian language learning process can vary in different groups of students. This can depend on what their native language is. Taking into account Russia and China's foreign policy aimed at rapprochement, in particular, in cooperation in science and technology and humanitarian cooperation, we expect an increase in Chinese citizens' interest in the Russian language and culture.

The editorial staff of Higher Education Discovery decided to ask the staff of Russian universities about the nuances of learning Russian as a foreign language for students from China. And here's what we have found out.





It gives us great pleasure to see **Chinese students showing a strong interest in the Russian language and Russian culture.** Indeed, there is something special about how Chinese students learn Russian and what difficulties this process is fraught with.

For example, the main challenge for students from China is phonetics. The Chinese language does not have some sounds that Russian has, for example, [r], [zh], [z], that is why teaching these sounds is a basic stage we place emphasis on at the beginning of the course. If you have a problem with sounds, lexical issues inevitable arise, the meaning is lost, and the words are distorted.

Word stress can also become a stumbling stone. Chinese students often point out the difficulties with Russian word stress, which is also caused by the specific features of the Chinese language.

Word order in sentences is worth mentioning as a separate point. Students say that word order in a sentence is not so important in the Chinese language, while Russian word order often adds a certain meaning to the text.

However, you can overcome all difficulties if you are diligent in your studies and have an attentive teacher. It should be noted here that most students from China take their studies seriously: they do necessary tasks, are active at the lessons, and try to get good grades. And this makes the learning process much easier.

The MIPT Preparatory Office for International Students offers Russian language courses (from the beginner level to B1) for natural sciences and engineering and technology. Within these study areas, the Russian language course is complemented by major subjects such as Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry/Informatics starting from the second semester. Besides, this year we have launched a **new program "IT Start"** which includes, besides the Russian language course, the intensive Informatics course helping students prepare for their entrance exams at the top Russian engineering and technology universities.

When the time came for me to apply to a university, it took me a long time to choose between Russia and China. Finally, the advantages of studying in Russia determined my choice. I realized that I wanted to become a professional translator and decided that I would have more prospects for professional self-fulfillment in Russia.

By that time, I had found myself missing my friends from Krasnoyarsk, and I made the right decision to apply to Siberian Federal University. Here I earned my Bachelor's degree in Russian as a Foreign Language and completed my Master's degree. I never regretted my choice during my university years. I am endlessly grateful to my teachers. And I wish everyone – teachers and current and prospective students – success, development, and new knowledge.

I wanted to become a translator because I like working with texts, and because this offers great prospects, given the current state of Russia-China relations. After graduation, I worked as a translator in China. And then I was invited to work at the translation department at SibFU, and I thought, why not?

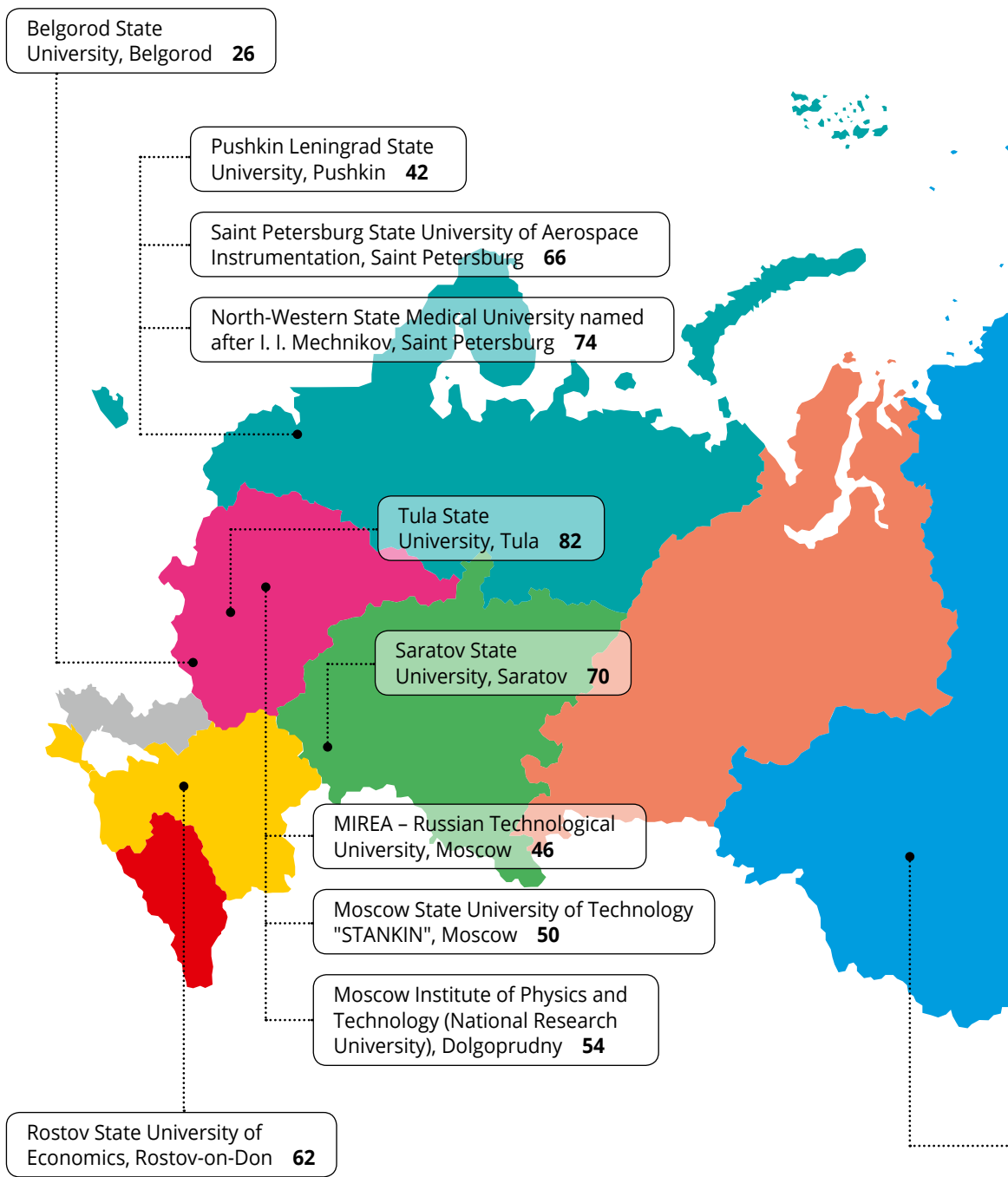
I am a celebrity for the Chinese in Krasnoyarsk. My compatriots often turn to me for advice or assistance. And I never refuse because I know how difficult it is to adapt to new life in a foreign country in the beginning. I can help when students have just come to Krasnoyarsk, are applying to the university and don't know what documents they should execute and where, where the rooms are, where the canteen is, and so on.

If I calculate, I've lived even for a longer time in Russia than in China, so it's hard to say which country I consider my home country. It seems to me that my home country is both here and there. I definitely love both Russia and China.

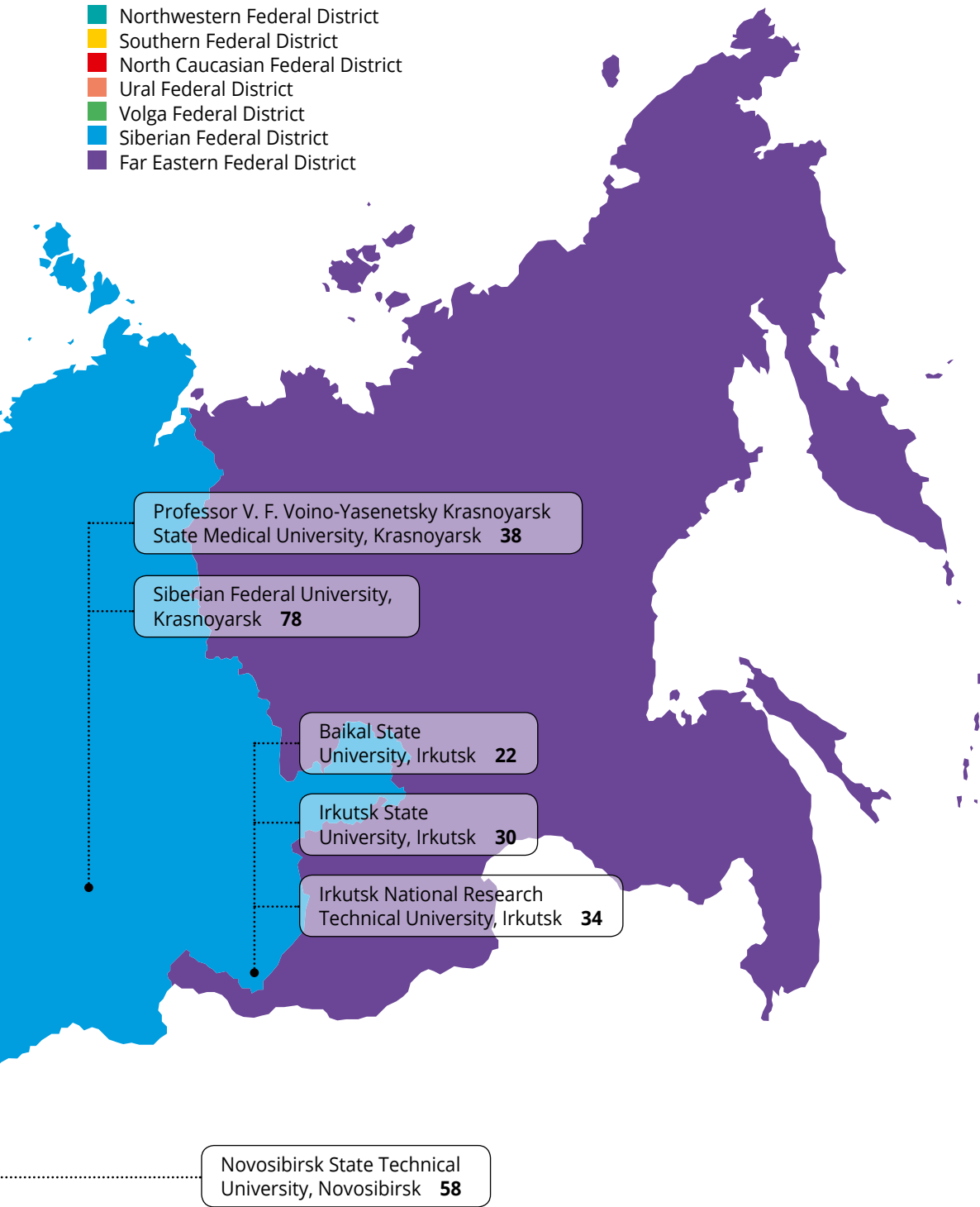


HED Map

- The application starting date – **June 20**

- Copy of passport with a notarized translation into Russian
- Copy of academic credentials with transcripts and a notarized translation into Russian
- Academic credential recognition certificate (if necessary)

RECOGNITION OF ACADEMIC CREDENTIALS

Chinese citizens 🇨🇳 planning to study in Russia must have their academic credentials recognized. This procedure will confirm the importance of the document proving their previous education – school leaving certificate, university diploma.

The recognition procedure is often confused with the legalization procedure. That is why it is important to know that the legalization procedure confirms the authenticity of the academic credential and its compliance with the issuing state's legislation. The recognition procedure confirms that the credential belongs to a particular person, is authentic and gives the right to apply to NRU "BeISU."

You can have your academic credentials recognized at the regional resource center "Expert Center for Evaluation of Foreign Academic Credentials" of Belgorod State University.

The program aims to:

ADMISSION

Chinese  citizens can apply to MIPT for state-funded (the Russian Government Scholarship) or fee-paying places.

Admission within the quota (state-funded places)

To participate in the competitive selection, candidates stating their willingness to study in the Russian Federation within the quota must:

- Register in the information system education-in-russia.com
- Fill in the application form in the best possible way
- Submit their photo, scanned passport, scanned academic credential (or certificate confirming their study period)

Based on the competitive selection results, the list of candidates is compiled. The candidates who successfully passed the competitive selection and were included in the list get the study scholarship.

NB! The number of state-funded places at MIPT for Chinese citizens is not limited.

To enroll at a particular phystech school, candidates who got the Russian Government quota must pass an additional selection. The selection can include the test, interview or portfolio competition.

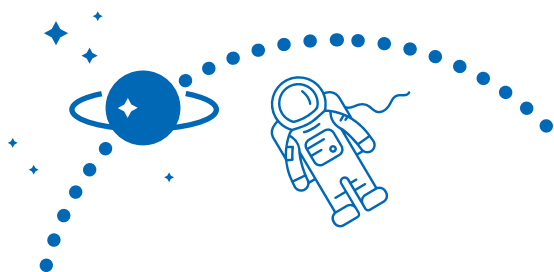

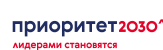

The university provides the opportunity to pursue the pre-university Russian language program for those Chinese applicants who do not speak Russian.

The major study areas of the program are:

Classes can be conducted both offline and online (6-10 months).
