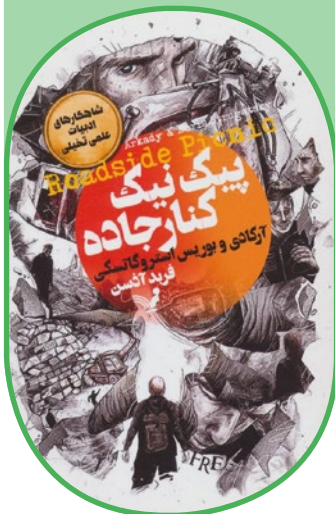

Russian Education

for Students from the Islamic Republic of Iran

Today, when Iran-Russia relations are rapidly developing, we can witness an explosion of interest in Russia, Russian education, and studying Russian in Iran. The HED editorial staff addressed the Rossotrudnichestvo representative in the Islamic Republic of Iran, Lilia Votnova, asking her to comment on the enrollment campaign process and give recommendations for applicants.

To date, around 6,000 students from Iran are studying in Russia, and this number is increasing and will increase in the foreseeable future. Strengthening of bilateral relations and development of interaction in science and technology and culture boost a mutual interest in culture, language, and educational opportunities. The Russian Government allocated 300 quota places for citizens of the Islamic Republic of Iran. This allows 300 Iranian citizens to apply to Russian universities on a state-funded basis (for free). This year, the competition was around seven applicants per place, and this result indicates a strong interest.



Medical specialties are in special demand among Iranian students. Physics and mathematics are traditionally in second place. Humanities such as Russian language and literature, journalism, international relations, Russian studies, and tourism are in third place. For the second academic year in a row, we have been observing creative majors such as art history and choreography getting more and more attractive for talented young people from Iran.

For participation in competitive selection to get a quota place and the right to free education, candidates must submit their documents via the special electronic form of the State Information System "Education in the Russian Federation for Foreigners" education-in-russia.com.

Everyone interested can participate. The main thing is to properly prepare documents and apply.

It is important that you are not afraid to make yourself known. Your achievements deserve to be noticed!

When the time came to apply to a university, my choice was determined by my desire to study Russian. It is a serious challenge to study this unique and strikingly rich language of famous writers and great literature. I knew that Russian grammar is one of the most difficult in the world, but this fact motivated rather than frightened me. I wanted to know Russian, understand it, speak it, and I wanted to get closer to understanding the Russian soul about which so much has been written.

I had another reason for my choice. It was practical and rational. The development of Iran-Russia relations has huge potential. Knowledge of the Russian language will be my competitive edge in the future.

After studying at university for a while, I realized that studying the language with full immersion in the cultural environment would be more effective. So said, so done. After completing my Bachelor's degree with honors, I applied for the Master's program in Russian as a Foreign Language in the Interaction of Languages and Cultures. I passed the interview and was admitted to Higher School of Economics in Moscow.

I can see Iranians' increasing interest in the Russian language, Russia, and Russian culture. I want to get a high-quality education and gain the knowledge required for further participation in the promotion of the Russian language and assistance in the harmonization of international relations between Russia and Iran. That's why I decided to continue my studies, and now I am a PhD student!

Russian literature is a treasure cave for readers

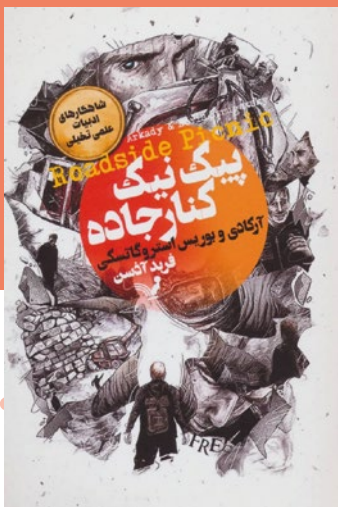
It is hardly an exaggeration to say that the image of Russia and Russians in the minds of Iranians has been developed mainly under the influence of mass media and the Western pop culture products. And this fact mainly explains why well-known stereotypes are so widespread, including lands covered by permanent snow, bears with balalaikas in the streets, the exaggerated grimness and unfriendliness of Russians. The HED editorial staff believes that immersion in Russian culture, literature and art can help dispel many false beliefs and, probably, see that we are not that different.

Today our magazine starts a new column “Cultural Code” where we will tell you about art, literature, history, traditions and cultural diversity of Russia.

Over the last years, there has been a considerable revival of Iranians’ interest in Russian literature. This is evidenced by an increased number of original Russian-language texts translated into Persian (Farsi) and the fact that Russian names are consistently ranked among the most read authors. Interestingly, Iranian readers get access not only to Russian classical literature included in the global collection but also to the books of different genres by contemporary authors.

Tolstoy, Dostoevsky, Chekhov, Pushkin, Lermontov, Iskander, Zamyatin have become very popular authors among Iranians. According to the Head of the Russian Center of Tehran University, translator Zahra Mohammadi, Chekhov has been the most read foreign author in Iran for five years in a row.

As noted by the literary scholars and translators, the content and spirit of Russian literature are very congenial to Iranians, and readers will inevitably open their hearts to it. Moral search and choice, self-sacrifice, sympathy and compassion, comprehension of the role of personality in society – all of this unites Iranian and Russian readers. The masterpieces of Russian classical literature are more or less known to a great many people, but the situation with the works written in the 20th and 21st centuries is quite different. 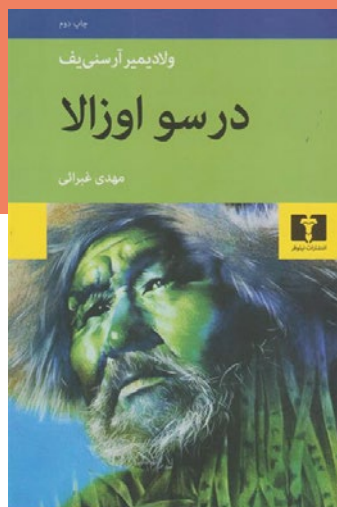

The Zone is an altered space where neither people nor animals can live. This is a story of the Ussuriland expedition inspired by real events. The Russian scholar and writer Vladimir Arsenyev heading an expedition to the wild pristine taiga meets Dersu Uzala, a local resident. The novel sets readers off on a journey to the vast expanses of the Russian Far East and acquaints them with the region's nature, people living there, numerous legends and ceremonies. The novel ranks among the best adventure books. The famous Japanese filmmaker Akira Kurosawa directed the same-name movie in 1975.

The Little Golden Calf

satirical novel

This is a satirical novel about the adventures of charismatic schemer and crook Ostap Bender. It is included in the golden collection of Russian literature. The action takes place against the backdrop of Soviet mundanity of the 1930s and is a bright parody of reality. A combination of realism and such literary techniques as hyperbole, pun, grotesque produced a facetious story with multiple meanings. In 1949-1956, the novel was called ideological sabotage and banned.



YEVGENY ZAMYATIN

dystopian novel

This is a classical dystopian novel, a black comedy masterpiece that influenced the works by Aldous Huxley, George Orwell, Vladimir Nabokov, Kurt Vonnegut. There are no people in the One State, only numbers. The society of nameless people is under total and strict control of the almighty ruler called the Benefactor. Emotions and instincts must be suppressed, and people must live according to the regulations and standards for the benefit of the One State. The mathematical genius, one of the *Integral* spaceship constructors, meets a woman by chance, which leads to unintended consequences – he discovers an ancient disease which was called a soul back in the old days.



ANNA AKHMATOVA

Grey-eyed King

poetry

This is a book of poems by one of the most outstanding Russian women poets. This is very feminine, heart-felt, emotional and intimate lyric poetry that touches everybody's heart. Anna Akhmatova, a classic of the Russian poetry of the Silver Age, was short-listed for the Nobel Prize in Literature twice. The woman with a difficult fate and a talent to delicately convey the most complex feelings by words and make the reader a co-present witness. The book of poems translated by Shapur Ahmadi gives readers the opportunity to immerse themselves in the wealth of Russian lyric poetry which is in sync with Iranian hearts.



KIR BULYCHEV

Alisa's Voyage

children's fantastic fiction

This is the most famous book in the science fiction series about Alisa Selezneva, a girl who goes on an exciting journey with her father, a famous space zoologist. In this book, Alisa will take part in an amazing expedition aimed at finding animals on other planets for the Moscow Zoo. The main characters will face strange events, a fierce clash with space pirates, and the riddles to be solved by all means. The book is considered an iconic piece of children's fantastic fiction.

The Dawns Here Are Quiet

war prose

This is a poignant example of the Soviet war prose, which is dedicated to the courage and bravery of the Soviet women who protected their Motherland from fascist invaders on equal terms with the men. There were six against sixteen. The eventful plot developing around the confrontation of five artillery girls and their commander, Fedot Vaskov, with the enemy sabotage group holds us in suspense until the very end. Philosophical contemplation about war, humans, moral choice and death makes the book a landmark work of the war and post-war Russian literature. The same-name movie was made in 1972, which has won the love of numerous viewers all over the world.



MIKHAIL BULGAKOV

The Master and Margarita

novel

Without exaggeration, this is a great work included in the golden fund of world literature. This is a surrealist novel about the great power of love capable of overcoming all obstacles, if this love is true. The multilayered plot develops against the background of the Moscow streets and interiors with multiple senses. Everything is in confusion on the pages of the timeless book: good and evil, fate and will, crime and punishment, love and infernal cynicism. The novel is considered unfinished, and Bulgakov's drafts were edited by his wife Elena after his death.



How to read in Russian

Reading is definitely the best way to replenish your vocabulary and memorize grammar. Teachers of Russian as a Foreign Language recommend going beyond study materials and reading original literary works to see how numerous grammar rules are used in the language and really feel it. At the same time, reading remains one of the key challenges for Russian language learners. Today we want to try to gain insight into the reading difficulties that arise, why they arise and how you can overcome them.

READ BOOKS YOU ARE INTERESTED IN

If you read something you are not interested in, you will not get much benefit out of such reading. Be serious about choosing the genre, author and even text length. If you are a fan of a short story genre, don't compromise your integrity. Be pragmatic and rational. Reading for pleasure is your main assistant.

PAY ATTENTION TO TRANSLATED LITERATURE

If you have already read the book by the foreign author in your native language, it pays to start reading the same book in Russian. Getting a general idea of the book content and context will help you easily understand a text written in Russian.

CHOOSE A DIFFICULTY LEVEL THAT SUITS YOU

If your dream is to read *Crime and Punishment* in the original, but your level of Russian is far from being advanced, pay attention to more understandable Russian literature classics. For example, Chekhov is famous for his simple writing style and is a good choice for those who continue learning Russian.



GO BEYOND NOVELS

Read short stories, journals, thematic websites and articles. They will provide insight into a variety of genres of the language and styles. Short modern texts will help you intersperse your speech by including new phrases and words in it.

RUSSIAN FAIRY TALES ARE NOT EASY READING

Children's literature is considered easy to read but this cannot be said about Russian fairy tales and folklore. Originality and abundance of Russian fairy tales has its roots in ancient ages. Many words and terms are considered obsolete and are not used in everyday speech today. All of this can become a great obstacle with a mixed result. If you have paid attention to children's books, choose contemporary authors.

Prejudices and Stereotypes are Confusing

We keep talking about how and why applicants from all over the world choose Russian universities. Today our guest is Emmanuel Chijioke, the fifth-year student specializing in General Medicine at Pirogov Russian National Research Medical University. As the process of international student adaptation in Russia is related to debunking many stereotypes about Russia and Russians, we asked our interlocutor to tell us about the expectations and reality.



I was beside myself with delight when I learned that I would study in Russia.

In our changing and developing world, Russia remains one of the most powerful and technologically advanced countries. Nevertheless, I doubted my decision because of the way the Internet describes this country and its education system. A huge number of prejudices, stereotypes and blatant myths about Russia and people living here are confusing and, frankly speaking, frightening. So, what definitely was to become the best time of my life seemed to be going to become the worst one.

I am a Nigerian, and my first and biggest fear was to be surrounded by racists. Probably the most popular myth among Nigerians tells us that Russian people are racists and that they are very harsh and unsmiling. I thought I would be mocked and bullied, and I was ready for it. But the reality turned out to be the exact opposite. When I came here, I felt welcome, and this made my acquaintance with Russia special. I joined many university clubs, and my fellow students accepted and loved me, though it took some time for some of them to confide in me.

The Russian education system is so different from the Nigerian one that I was literally shocked by high-quality training and a great number of academic subjects. RNRMU is one of the top medical universities in Russia, and this leaves its mark. The most difficult thing was the Russian language. I really do not know how I would study if it wasn't for my fellow students who helped and supported me. RNRMU not only provides training but also offers an eventful extracurricular life, pays attention to personality, supports and develops talents.

Preparing for coming here, I was looking forward to learning and feeling what the weather was like in this country. I fancied all snow angels that I would draw on the white snow. I anticipated autumn photo sessions with multicolored leaves with pleasure. The idea that I will have of the opportunity to experience all seasons of the year in their full splendor was exciting.

Now I can definitely say that autumn is the best season, and winter is the worst one. I adore autumn. Not only because of favorable weather conditions and pure beauty of the changing nature but also because I can comfortably wear a trench coat. 😊

I am thankful to God for the opportunity to study here, for personal development and for all the love I get. I found balance in God – this is the best thing that could have happened because medicine is not only about extensive knowledge, the highest level of professional competence and medical skills but also about support from higher powers even during tough times!

ABOUT CHOOSING A COUNTRY AND A UNIVERSITY

Several years ago, I spent my vacation in Armenia and Georgia, and I was surprised by the fact that many people in the countries located north of Iran speak Russian. It is this journey that aroused my interest in the Russian language. And almost at the same time I decided to study at the preparatory faculty in Russia not only to study Russian but also to have the opportunity to continue my education at a Russian university.

Speaking of the universities, there are around 500 universities in Russia, and the choice is a big deal. Finally, I decided on St. Petersburg Polytechnic University. Today it is one of the best engineering universities in Russia and in the world. It is a university with a proud long history and the established system of training world-class professionals. Among those who studied and taught here are Nobel laureates, famous scientists and researchers.

ABOUT THE “GREAT AND MIGHTY” RUSSIAN LANGUAGE

Before I came to Russia, I studied Russian in Tehran for around two years, three hours per week. But I consider my success at that time as rather modest. I lacked practice because I had no one to talk to in Russian.

When I came to Russia, I preferred communicating with my fellow students and roommates in English. I communicated in Russian with great difficulty. But now, after I spent nine months in my foundation program, I feel I can speak.

Russian is hard to learn. To master it, you must make a conscious effort. The language grammar has a great number of laws and rules that always have exceptions 😊. And these huge words! They are so big that reading, writing and memorizing them is a real challenge and a severe trial. We, Iranians, find it difficult to pronounce some Russian sounds, for examples, the letters “ы” and “щ”. My teacher says that I often forget to write the letter “ь” in the words because there is no such letter in my language.

EXPECTATIONS AND REALITY

Before coming here, I thought that cars can't go along the roads in winter because of snowdrifts, that is why people have to skate and ski to get from A to B. Also, I was sure that Russians drink vodka every day to survive cold winters. I had no doubt that Russia is dangerous, and you had better not go outside alone at night 😊. None of this turned out to be true.

It is a pity that Iranians and Russians know so little about each other and our conceptions are so warped. I believe that we should increase the number of joint Russian-Iranian projects in education, culture, tourism, student exchange.

Before coming to Russia, I didn't see a single Russian movie or series, I didn't see a single history documentary about this wonderful country, I didn't talk to a single Russian tourist in Iran, and I had so little information on real Russia. And that's what we should and can work on.

ABOUT LEISURE ACTIVITIES AND PLANS FOR THE FUTURE

In my spare time, if the weather is fine, I go for a bike ride in the adjacent parks looking like forests. I go to parties or museums with my Russian friends. I like watching Russian music videos on Youtube and translating lyrics.

I give a great deal of thought to my future and the ways to move forward. I want to register a commercial company in Russia to familiarize the Russian market with Iranian products. This definitely has a huge potential. Especially now, when our countries are under Western sanctions. Anyway, these are favorable conditions for the development of Iranian-Russian business, cultural and educational projects.

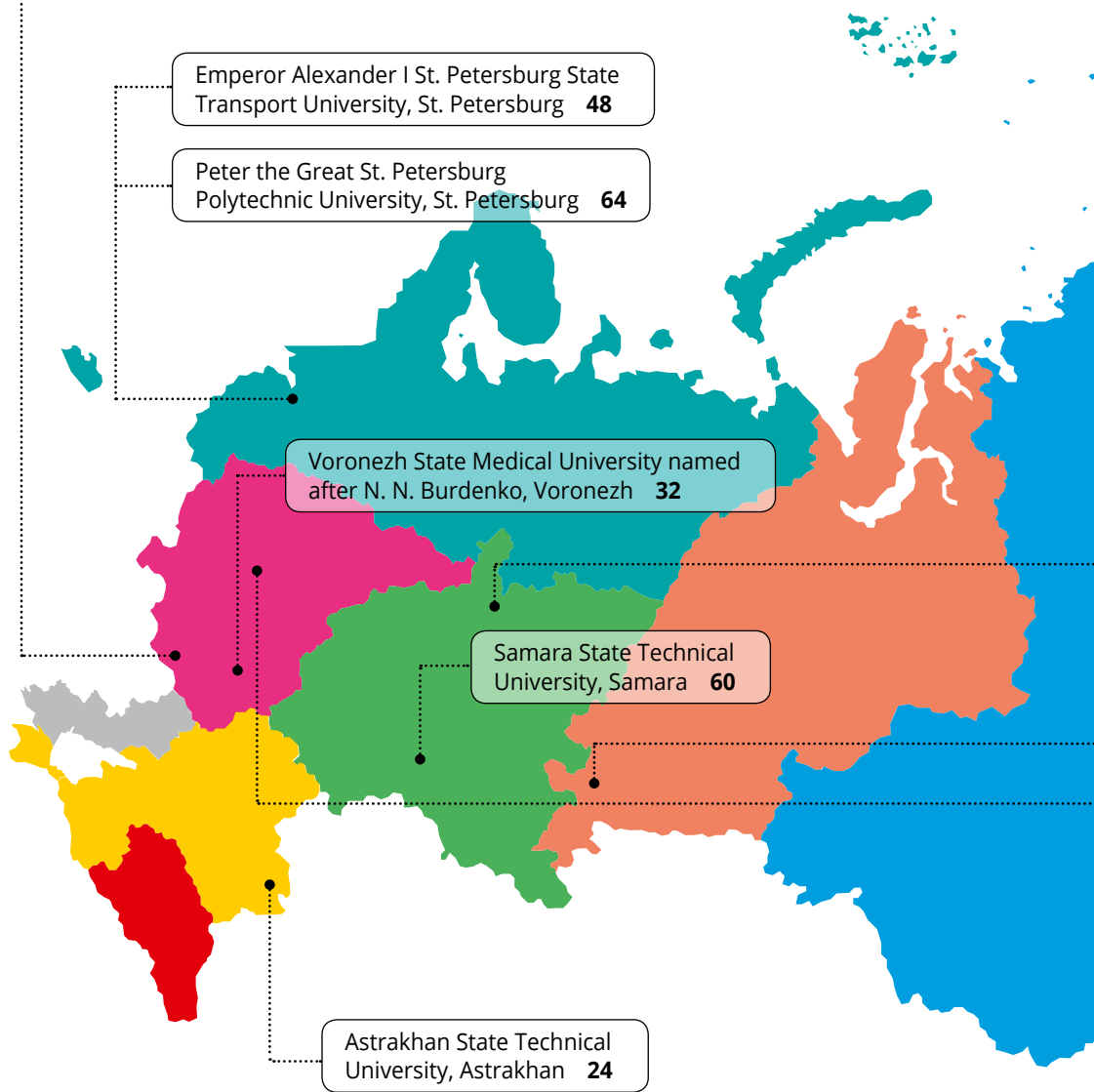

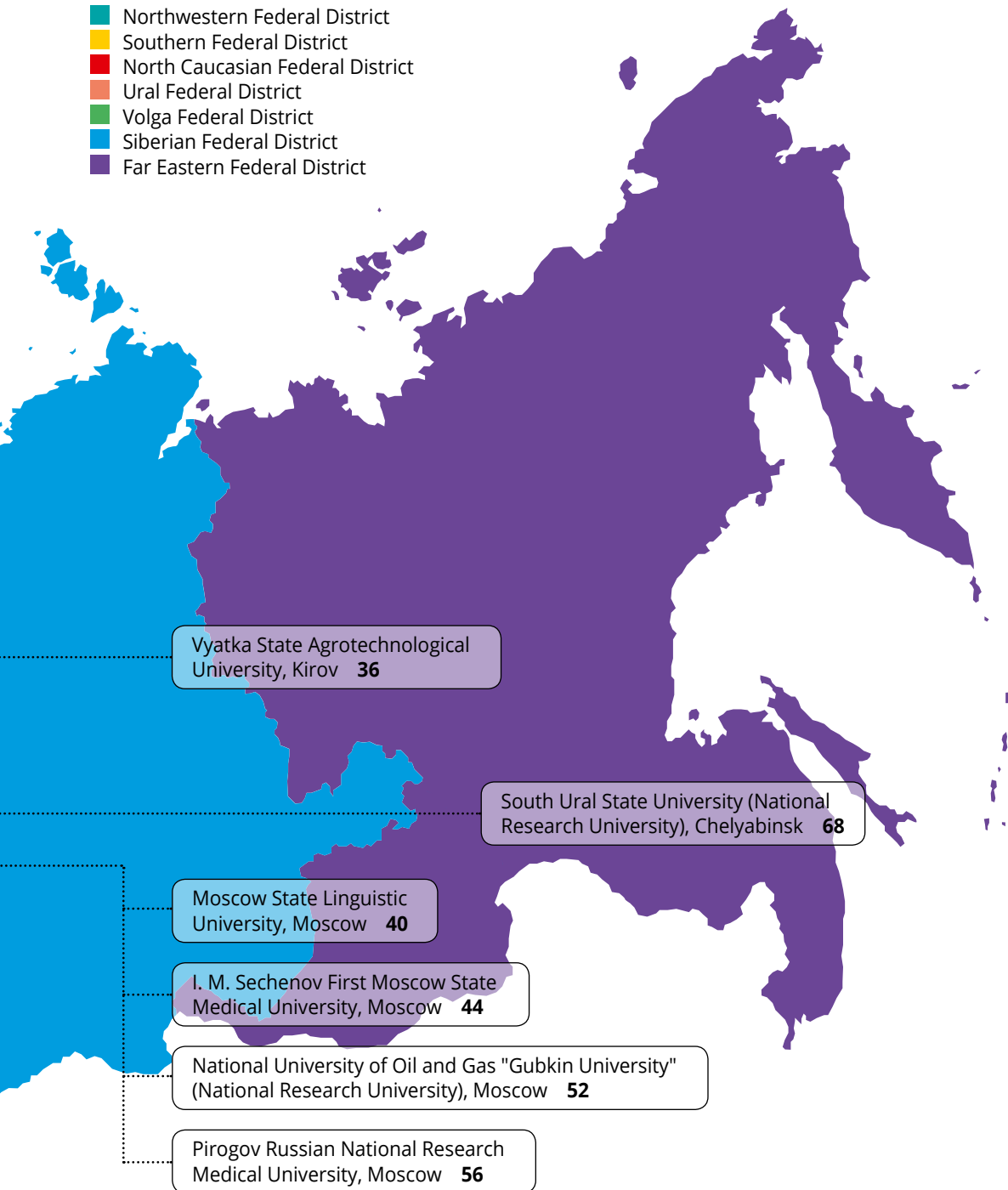

ADMISSION

- 1 You can enroll at ASTU in state-funded places (the Russian Government quota) and fee-paying places (on a contract basis).
- 2 You can apply for a quota place, get an admission consultation, take entrance exams at the Rossotrudnichestvo representative office as well as at the Russian Embassy in Tehran.
- 3 To enroll at the university, you are not required to legalize foreign academic credentials issued in the Islamic Republic of Iran. However, you must have your foreign academic credential recognized at nic.gov.ru


Students may enroll and study at the university if they have a certificate of education at the corresponding level:

- Bachelor's/Specialist's programs
 - secondary general education
 - higher education
 - secondary vocational education
- Master's programs
 - higher education
- PhD programs
 - higher education at the level of Master's/ Specialist's/PhD degree

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PREPARATORY FACULTY

The faculty provides pre-university training for foreign citizens so that they can pursue higher professional education programs (Bachelor's, Specialist's, Master's, PhD programs).

After students successfully complete the course, they get a standard **certificate** which attests to the fact that they have sufficient Russian language proficiency to get education at a Russian university.

International students undergo adaptation and socialization which includes sightseeing in the city, visiting museums, holding educational tours and various **events** such as:

- Poetry contest
- Russian song contest
- Celebration of Shrovetide at the Merchant Tetyushinov House
- The Russian Language Olympiad
- Graduation party




The Russian language is the primary means of adaptation of Iranian students studying at the Preparatory Faculty.

The traits of Iranian students' national character include self-esteem, national pride, love of independence and freedom, love of their native land and home. 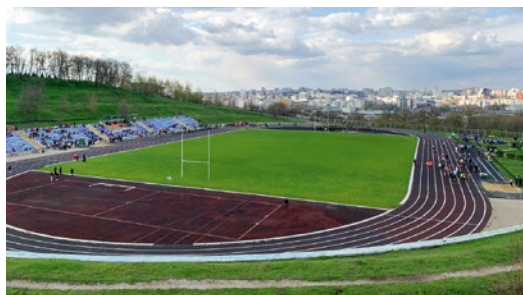

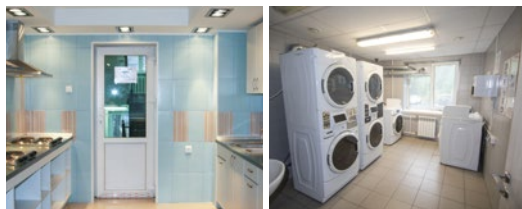
