## The First Russian Education Fair in Latin America

**Russian House in Chile** 



The Russian House in Chile continues its active efforts to promote Russian education among the citizens of the country. The editorial team of the HED magazine previously wrote about its role for Chilean applicants seeking to get a highquality education and develop their career prospects in Russia. As part of its activities, the Russian House in Santiago organizes various events aimed at familiarizing Chileans with educational opportunities in Russia. For example, Latin America held the first large-scale Russian education fair entitled "Russia: Education without Borders." This unique event brought together 30 top Russian universities and attracted more than 500 participants, including school students, applicants and representatives of Chilean educational institutions.

The guests met with the representatives of the universities in person, found out about their educational programs and special aspects of student life in Russia and asked about everything they wanted to know. In her speech, the Head of the Rossotrudnichestvo representative office in Chile Nina Milovidova emphasized the importance of friendly relations between Russia and Chile. Today these relations are maintained by the Russian House that creates opportunities to get a highquality higher education.



Every year the Russian Government allocates almost 30,000 scholarships to international students, providing them with a great opportunity to use this program.



One of the bright moments of the fair was a demonstration lesson in the format of standup show from the famous Russian linguist and TV host Dmitry Petrov, the author of the unique methodology of intensive language training.

#### **SPACE GREETING**

There was a surprise for all guests – they were greeted by the polar explorers from the Bellingsgausen Russian Antarctic Station and the Cosmonaut Training Center.

Anna Kikina, the only female cosmonaut in the Roscosmos team, met with the participants of the fair and emphasized the importance of studying the Russian language for future cosmonauts. "...I can safely say that Russian is a language spoken in space," she noted.





#### SANTIAGO MEMORANDUM: A STEP TOWARDS COOPERATION

The education fair included a working session organized by the Russian House in cooperation with the Center for Research and Development of the Faculty of Humanities of the University of Santiago, Chile represented by Dante Castillo. It brought together the representatives of state Russian and Chilean universities. During the meeting, the Santiago Memorandum was signed.

The main aim of the meeting was to unite academicians and researchers from the universities in both countries to share experience, collaborate and conclude cooperation agreements. For example, Higher School of Economics and the University of Santiago, Chile agreed to sign a cooperation agreement in the near future.

The fair "Russia: Education without Borders" has become not only a platform for acquainting oneself with study opportunities in Russia but also an important step towards strengthening relations between educational institutions in the two countries.

## **Towards Learning Russian** Russian House in the Central African Republic



In the Central African Republic, there has been a rapidly increasing interest in the Russian language and Russian culture. Getting a higher education in Russia has become a dream and a status symbol for many young people in CAR. So, a growing number of people want to study Russian – not only university students but also school students. The HED editorial team asked the Head of the Russian House in CAR Dimitri Sytyi about how the Russian language is promoted in CAR. The Russian House in Bangui is a non-governmental organization established to promote the Russian language and culture in the entire territory of CAR. It maintains active cooperation with Rossotrudnichestvo and Russian universities. We get many requests from various educational institutions, government authorities and ministries for organization of teaching the Russian language. Consistent activities are conducted mainly in the capital of CAR, the city of Bangui, but the Russian House regularly organizes events in different regions of the country, including its most remote parts.





#### **RUSSIAN LANGUAGE FOR EVERYONE**

Today, Russian language classes are conducted at the Russian House, at Bangui University as well as at two secondary schools and the orthodox parish school.

In CAR, everyone interested can take Russian language courses for free. When people have a low income, even small fee can become a great obstacle to getting education. Our aim is to make Russian language learning and acquaintance with Russian culture as accessible as possible.

The initial course lasts three months. During this period, students master basic grammar and learn to read and maintain a simple dialogue. There are around ten groups comprising 30-50 people.

We regularly hold a variety of educational events dedicated to the history and culture of Russia for everyone interested. The Russian House in Bangui has become an important venue for important city events. In the past month, it held CAR's first national sambo wrestling championship, the festival of slam – modern poetry, the city ping-pong tour, and the international online chess tournament for children and adolescents.

The children in CAR show a keen interest in theatrical performances based on famous Russian fairy tales – the country's only children's plays in the tradition of the Russian theater.

The Russian House in Bangui has special interest clubs where students can do handicraft, draw and paint, dance as well as play chess and table tennis. Classes are available for people of all ages and are absolutely free.





#### Admission. Supported by Rossotrudnichestvo

All our events are consistently aimed at promoting Russian culture and language. These can be screenings of movies about the Second World War, celebration of Alexander Pushkin's birthday, intellectual games dedicated to the history and culture of Russia, or concerts where students sing famous Russian songs.

The Russian House is often visited by students of Bangui Sunday schools who come to participate in entertainment programs with games, contests and master classes on Russian folk crafts as well as attend Russian language classes. After such visits, many students gladly come back to the Russian House again.

The Russian House is a modern center for training and development seeking to provide students with the best conditions. Here we have everything we need for live streaming. In the future, the center plans to create a fully equipped computer classroom with internet access so that students can study innovative IT and participate in group online courses.

The Russian House in Bangui is the only center in CAR where you can study the Russian language. There has been an increasing interest in the language, especially among school and university students who dream of getting an education in Russia.





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#### ACHIEVEMENTS AND PLANS OF THE RUSSIAN HOUSE

In 2024, the Russian House successfully held Russian language courses for CAR military officers and members of the High Council for Communications. The Ministry of Culture also submitted a similar request. As the number of students increases, we need more study materials, so each new textbook kit from Rossotrudnichestvo and Russian universities is a valuable acquisition for us. Moreover, we are grateful for the support from Russian teachers sent here by Rossotrudnichestvo and coming as part of partner programs with universities.

At the moment, the Russian House in Bangui employs three national teachers who constitute the main teaching staff and teach Russian at the Russian House and educational institutions in the city. We encourage our teachers to participate in online and offline advanced training activities conducted by Rossotrudnichestvo and other Russian education centers. For example, one of our teachers participated in the conference for RFL teachers in Senegal. At the moment, we offer online advanced training courses for national teachers of the Russian language in cooperation with St. Petersburg State University.

We plan to increase the number of Russian language teachers so that more people in CAR can study it. Here we count on the programs of Rossotrudnichestvo and grants for Russian universities teaching Russian as a foreign language. We also intend to start teaching Russian in different regions of CAR. Our aim is to make the Russian language accessible in all schools of the country so that every citizen of the Russian African Republic can speak Russian. That's an ambitious and longterm objective, but we are well on the way to achieving it.

At Russian educational institutions you can meet outstanding people and highly qualified specialists. They work for the benefit of their country and serve as a role model for young specialists and students. Their experience plays an important role in educational initiatives as well as international relations. In our interview, Inga Anatolyevna, Associate Professor at the Marketing Department of Plekhanov Russian University of Economics, will share her vision of the development of Russian-African relations and give some advice to international students who want to study in Russia.



#### Inga Anatolyevna, could you tell us about your professional journey? How do your diverse experience and education influence your career?

My journey is really diverse, and I am proud of it. I started my career as a teacher of English language and History, which helped me understand the cultural characteristics of different countries. Then I deepened my knowledge of international relations, management and marketing and gained practical skills to work in business and international development. Working as an UNDP Expert and Director for International Development of the Russian-African Club of Lomonosov Moscow State University, I participated in initiatives strengthening cooperation between Russia and Africa. These roles allowed me to organize international projects and interact with people from different cultures.

I think that my experience helps me see the bigger picture and find solutions in difficult situations as well as create successful projects and establish long-term international relations.

#### As Director for International Development of the Russian-African Club, could you tell us what its main mission is?

The Russian-African Club at MSU is seeking to develop cooperation between Russia and Africa, placing the emphasis on education, science, culture, and business to establish sustainable partnership relationships. As a director, I focus



on experience exchange initiatives, including forums of rectors of Russian and African universities, joint educational programs, and double degree courses.

Moreover, the club takes an active part in cultural projects such as art, cinema and fashion festivals, creation of the African Culture Museum, and the installation of a monument to Nelson Mandela in Moscow. We work with African expat communities to strengthen social relations.



What prospects for the development of Russian-African relations can you see? How important is cooperation between Russian and African universities?

Today we can observe an increasing interest in strengthening partnership relationships based on equal rights and mutual benefit, especially in education and science. Inter-university cooperation is of strategic importance. Double degree programs, student and teacher exchange, and joint research form a new generation of specialists who are ready to respond to global challenges.

Innovations and technologies are also important. Africa has huge development potential, and Russia's experience in science can play a key role in power engineering, agriculture, medicine, and ecology.

Cultural interaction strengthens trust and mutual understanding. Festivals, exhibitions,

and music and art projects provide the basis for long-term dialogue. Expansion of inter-university cooperation is an investment in the future that allows us to join efforts to solve global tasks and provide conditions for sustainable development.

#### What advice would you give to international students who want to study in Russia and build a career in international business?

First of all, **be open to new opportunities** and be actively engaged in the educational and professional process. Russia has unique educational traditions and cultural and economic relations. This offers many prospects for development.

Take full advantage of the opportunities offered by universities. Double degree programs, international projects and research initiatives will help you not only get a high-






quality education but also establish important professional contacts. Many students expand their career horizons by participating in international forums.

**Be active and proactive.** Participate in conferences, internships and international exchanges and come up with ideas. The Russian

academic community welcomes people who are ready to take responsibility.

Lastly, **develop your cross-cultural communication skills** as international business requires the ability to work with people from different cultures. Use available resources, and you will be able to build a successful career in international business.

Study the Russian language and culture. Even a basic knowledge of the Russian language and understanding cultural characteristics will give you a big edge and help you build relationships more quickly.


#### WELCOME TO KRASNODAR!

The capital of the Krasnodar Territory, the city of Krasnodar, is a major economic and cultural center in the North Caucasus and the Southern Federal District, is located on the right bank of the Kuban River. Krasnodar is also called the capital of the South of Russia. It is located 1,300 km south of Moscow – approximately 1.5 hours by plane.

In Krasnodar, summers are hot and long (they last from May to September) and winters are moderately warm (they last approximately from the middle of January till the end of February).

Krasnodar is famous for its picturesque streets, green parks and cozy public gardens that create a cozy and quiet atmosphere. The city is buried in verdure, and its residents are proud of numerous avenues and gardens.

One of the most popular places is Krasnodar Park, which has become the true pearl of the city thanks to its modern design. The park infrastructure comprises cafés and restaurants, an amphitheater showing movies in summer, fountains, a skate park, water bodies with fish. mirror. musical and water mazes, and many other things.



Kuban educational institutions are open for international applicants from all over the world. The multinational atmosphere and communication with people from different cultures make studying in Krasnodar especially attractive.

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The cultural life of Krasnodar is also eventful and diverse. Here you can go to various festivals, exhibitions and concerts that attract both local residents and guests of the city. This is a place where everyone can find something for themselves.

Krasnodar attracts not only tourists but also students who can get an education here in such fields as economics, engineering, medicine, humanities, physical culture and sports.



#### **SKI RESORTS**

In the Krasnodar Territory, you will find the warm Black Sea, sunny beaches, and magnificent ski resorts that attract winter sports enthusiasts from all over Russia and the world. In the foothills of the Caucasus Mountains, there are several popular ski resorts that offer excellent conditions for skiing, snowboarding, and other winter activities.

**Krasnaya Polyana** is the most famous ski resort in Russia that became popular after the 2014 Winter Olympics in Sochi. It has several ski areas, including Rosa Khutor and Gazprom. The resort offers pistes of different difficulty levels, which makes it an ideal place both for beginners and experienced skiers. Here you can ride a bike, a quad bike, a scooter, and a drag bike. Guests can also fly a balloon, a paraplane, or a helicopter.

**Rosa Khutor** is a ski resort with the longest network of pistes in Russia – they are 105 km long. There is enough entertainment to suit any taste here. You can taste local cuisine in cozy restaurants and enjoy evening walks around the resort.

The Gazprom Mountain Tourist Center is famous for its diverse pistes and modern ropeway lifts. At the center, you can fly a paraplane or a paratrike, ride a snowmobile, or try snowtubing. The center has a year-round waterpark with an outdoor swimming pool that offers a fascinating view of the mountains.



Tip: All the resorts are very big and have well-developed infrastructure. We recommend that you download the resort map to your phone to navigate more easily.

# Fast facts!

- The region's main feature is the diversity of its landscape. Here you can find high mountains with extensive forests, glaciers, rivers flowing through mountain gorges, boundless steppes, and caves.
- **Novorossiysk Sea Port,** located in the Krasnodar Territory, is the largest port in Russia.

**Sochi** is the longest city in Europe and Russia as well as the second longest in the world after Mexico. The city stretches for 148 km.

- In the entire Krasnodar Territory there are around 2,000 dolmens. Dolmens are ancient structures used as burial chambers or as places of worship. They are classified as megaliths (large stone structures).
- The **Bolshoy Utrish** attraction is Russia's only open-air dolphinarium, located in the natural sea lagoon. The dolphins live and perform in the natural environment, and spectators watch the show from the platform on the shore.

• The **Lotus Valley** is a unique natural site in the Krasnodar Territory. This manmade attraction is a water garden dotted with Indian lotuses.. The **Safari Park** in Krasnodar is the only private safari in Russia. The park with an area of 10 ha is inhabited by 250 animal and bird species. In the park, you can visit the pinnipeds theater and the dinosaur park.

 The Krasnodar Territory residents are famous for their hospitality and cordiality, which makes it a friendly place for guests from all over the world.

## READ CHEKHOV AND IMPROVE YOUR RUSSIAN

It is no secret that you need to use an integrated approach to achieve the best results in learning any language. It is not enough to learn the rules. You need to understand and feel deeply how these rules are used in the living language. Reading, listening, and speaking are of use here. How can reading Russian literature help? Let's look at the works by Russian classic Anton Chekhov.

### For reference:

Anton Chekhov (1860-1904) is one of the most popular and favorite Russian writers in Russia and worldwide. His works were translated into more than 100 languages. Chekhov's plays are included in the repertoire of the world's top theaters and are acted out willingly by chamber ensembles as well. Over 25 years, more than 500 short prose works, including short stories, short novels, and plays emerged from the pen of the master. The characteristic feature of Chekhov's prose is that his characters are ordinary people, and the events he describes can be called commonplace with full confidence. Chekhov falls into the category of writers whose works are still relevant today. Absolutely ordinary people, you can easily associate yourself with, face the circumstances of ordinary life, allowing for the historical context.

Chekhov's works are permeated with humanity characteristic of Russian literature in general, and that is partly why they touch the readers' hearts no matter what their first language is.



The clear language of Chekhov's works is understandable to students with any level of language proficiency: from elementary to advanced. While reading, you can conveniently study specific rules and language norms.

Chekhov's prose is suitable for independent study. In the texts of his short novels and stories you will find fascinating portraits of people, personality traits, observed in a masterly fashion, as well as a lot of subtle descriptions of nature and its states. And his short humorous stories, for example, *Fat and Thin, A Horsey Name, A Malefactor, Joy*, can become a source of fun and a good mood.

Translation + original text + audio version + discussion of the work = full immersion in the Russian language and mentality.


Chekhov's works have been translated into many languages. And this can make it easier to understand the original text and work with it. You can add listening to reading by choosing an audio book or audio play.

And the last thing. Some enthusiastic students often say that they want to read Chekhov in the original as much as Dostoevsky. And this is a really good objective. However, if your level of Russian language proficiency is A–B, you had better start with more understandable, simple and short works. Fortunately, you are spoiled for choice. And then you can even get to Demons by Dostoevsky or War and Peace by Tolstoy.

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




