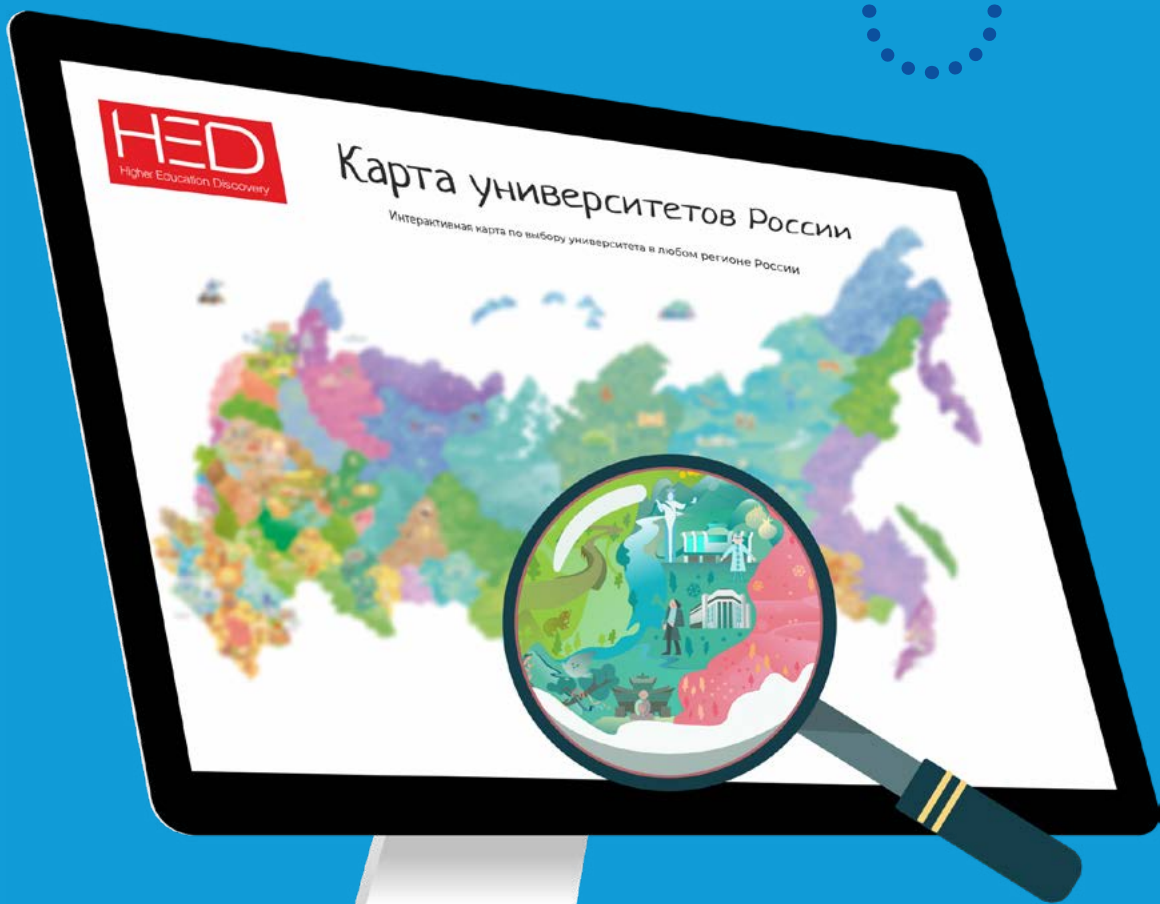

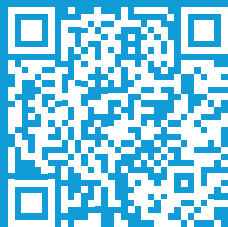

It has become a modern place for culture and education. It has creative associations for people of all ages. To increase young people's interest in the Russian language, it holds various events such as Olympiads, competitions, quizzes, concerts, movie screenings, Russian Language days, and other events. Let's look at the most informative and entertaining activities in Mongolia.

SPECIAL COURSE FOR RUSSIAN LANGUAGE TEACHERS IN BURYATIA

To improve the quality of Russian language teaching, advanced training courses are offered for Mongolian teachers. For example, 12 teachers from the Orkhon aimak have recently received training at Buryat Republican Pedagogical College. The teachers have studied new teaching methods, taken part in master classes, deepened their knowledge of the Russian language, and familiarized themselves with the culture of the region.

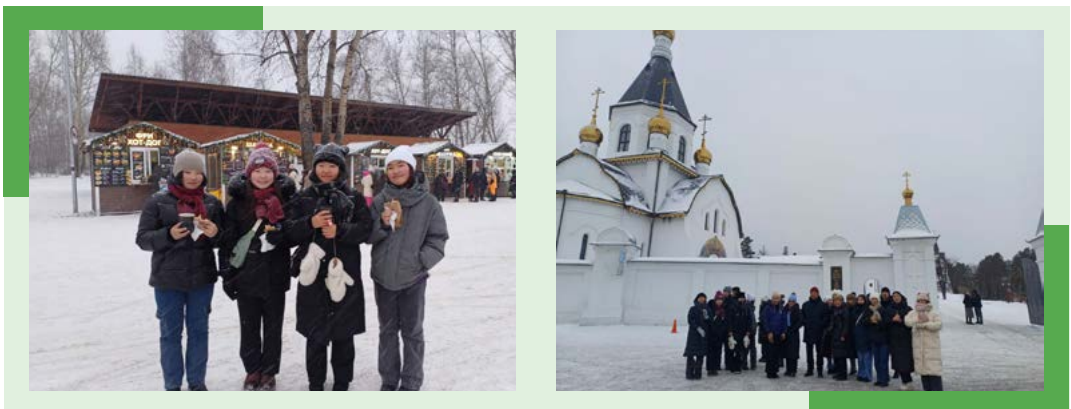
Since 2022, educational institutions in Buryatia have been accepting students from Mongolia for free.



WINTER SCHOOL FOR MONGOLIAN SCHOOL STUDENTS

This winter, a group of 16 school students and four teachers from different regions of Mongolia came to Krasnoyarsk. Krasnoyarsk State Agrarian University organized the Russian Language Winter School for them.

For a week, the participants got acquainted with the university, its teachers and sights in the Krasnoyarsk Territory and discussed the opportunities to study at Russian universities. The program included intensive Russian language classes and city tours that helped students not only improve their language skills but also find out more about Russian culture and life in Russia.



INTENSIVE RUSSIAN LANGUAGE COURSES

The Russian House in Ulaanbaatar supports Mongolian young people who want to get an education in Russia. In February 2025, the Russian Language Center launched an intensive Russian language course for prospective students of Russian universities for art. The course program, designed by the experienced Russian language teachers from the Russian House, covers all the key language aspects such as vocabulary, grammar, writing, reading, speaking, and listening. For two months, the attendees will prepare for studying at Russian universities.

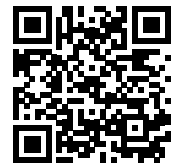

Scientists of the Global South, Unite!

On January 23, 2025, the Faculty of Global Studies of Lomonosov Moscow State University hosted the International Scientific and Practical Conference "Russia, Brazil and Africa: Strengthening Cooperation of the Global South." The conference was organized by the Faculty of Global Studies of Lomonosov Moscow State University, the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro, Russian-African Network University, the Russian-African Club of Lomonosov Moscow State University, and the International Club of Russian-Latin American Studies of Lomonosov Moscow State University.

The aim of the conference was to help consolidate the intellectual elites of the Global South in search for answers to global challenges and threats.

The event was held in a hybrid format and brought together more than 110 leading scholars, experts and analysts from Russia, Brazil, and Africa.

The solemn part of the conference was opened by the Dean of the Faculty of Global Studies, Professor Ilya Ilyin. He welcomed the conference participants and highly appreciated the work of the Russian-African Club of Lomonosov Moscow State University, whose active efforts helped achieve an impressive scale in the cooperation with African countries.

In his welcoming speech, Prof. Roberto de Andrade Medroño, Rector of the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro emphasized that the interaction policy between Russia, Brazil and Africa is successfully developing both in the BRICS association and within cooperation with the countries of the Global South.

The representatives of the universities in Egypt, Tunisia, and Zambia also extended their greetings to the conference participants.

The event continued with a plenary session, as part of which more than 20 leading international and Russian scholars spoke on international cooperation, educational initiatives, and issues the Global Youth has to face.

Prof. Daniel Barreiros, an expert in economics from the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro, believes that a special responsibility amid the new circumstances rests on the interdisciplinary cooperation in science and education, which is the foundation for the comprehensive cooperation both with the countries of the Global South and other regions.

Inga Koryagina, Director for International Development of the Russian-African Club of Lomonosov Moscow State University, Associate Professor at the Marketing Department of Plekhanov Russian Economic University, shared a presentation on the activities of the Russian-African Club of Lomonosov Moscow State University, which, according to the speaker, is a platform for global international cooperation. By creating inclusive platforms for dialogue between scientists, entrepreneurs, youth representatives and cultural figures, the club identifies and promotes opportunities for cooperation that contribute to sustainable development and shared success.

Associate Professor at the Department of Foreign Regional Studies of Moscow State Linguistic University Maria Kolesnikova emphasized that Russia has the richest school of African studies and vast experience, which should be used in Russian-African cooperation.

The youth session of the conference – the Tribune of Young Scientists – was held at the end of the plenary session. During the session, young scientists from universities in Russia, Brazil, and Africa presented their papers in English and offered their options to respond to global challenges and threats facing humanity. Thus, the young intellectual elite of the Global South is already being formed and consolidated.

All the conference participants noted the high significance of the event in strengthening international ties and future joint initiatives between the countries of the Global South. The organizers expressed their hope that such meetings would become regular and would lay the foundation for new initiatives in the field of international cooperation, contributing to the strengthening of mutual understanding and cultural exchange between countries.

LEARNING RUSSIAN IN RUSSIA

My name is Liu Hui, I am from China. I am 28 years old. I study at the Faculty of Russian Philology and major in Theoretical, Applied, and Comparative and Contrastive Linguistics.

I came to Kuban State University as part of the student exchange program. Then I fell in love with it. At that time, we had a few study destinations to choose from. I studied Russian in China and wanted to live in the Russian language environment to improve my language proficiency. That's why I decided to come to Russia.

I am interested in learning Russian and going over grammar. That's why everything goes off without a hitch. But I find it hard to pronounce the letter P [R].

I attended the classes of the Russian Language Club at the university where I got help with correcting my grammar and pronunciation.

In the future, I plan to become a Russian language teacher at a university.



LIFE IN KRASNODAR IS INTERESTING AND FUN!

I've had vivid impressions of the tours around the Krasnodar Territory. I visited Sochi, Adler, Anapa, Gelendzhik, Novorossiysk, and other cities. I like Krasnodar very much. My favorite places in the city are Krasnaya Street, the city center, and Krasnodar Park.



International students have all the opportunities to lead an eventful student life at Kuban State University. I used to participate in the university's social life, too. For example, my compatriots and I were invited to take part in the events held by the Faculty of Oriental Studies so that we familiarized students with Chinese culture and aspects of the Chinese language. It was fun. But it was quite a long time ago. Most recently, I've been studying hard.

The most memorable event at university for me was getting a letter of appreciation from the university after completing my Master's degree.

I would advise young people from various countries, who plan to study in Russia, to be active, participate in various events, and familiarize themselves with Russian culture. And don't forget to certify the documents required for admission!

Lu Jie, an economist and a first-year PhD student at M.K. Ammosov North-Eastern Federal University

I was born in a small village in Qujing, Yunnan Province. Since childhood, I had often listened to my grandmother's stories about famous historical figures of China, which aroused my interest in Chinese and foreign history. That's how I started dreaming of building a career in trade.

WHY NEFU?

When I entered the university in Harbin, I learned about the Russian language for the first time, saw many Russian goods and buildings. In the last year of my studies, I was lucky to get a place at M.K. Ammosov North-Eastern Federal University as part of the exchange program. During my exchange year, I fell in love with this university and resolved to stay here to pursue my PhD degree. After my successful participation in the Olympiad, I got the opportunity to embark on my PhD studies at NEFU. This victory helped me overcome the challenges, better myself and gave me strength and courage to go ahead on my life's journey.

I didn't choose North-Eastern Federal University at random, I was meant to study here. I consider it a beautiful and interesting place. Our university employs well-known professors and many experienced teachers.

I am very happy to have been able to enroll at this university. The most difficult thing for me in my studies is to learn professional vocabulary. I read words and texts every morning. If I have any questions, I address my teachers.

After getting accepted to university, I took a completely fresh look at myself. All my ideas of my knowledge changed radically. I realized how poor my knowledge was.

BE A GOOD STUDENT

I believe that broad-minded students will be in demand in the future.

A good student is someone who is well-versed in scientific achievements and has a solid theoretical background in their profession. That is why students must study hard and always improve themselves.

I major in Economics. I consider that this is the most practical and interesting subject in the world. Every time I discuss academic issues with my fellow students, I feel inspired. In the context of the rapidly developing economy, we must be very sensitive to analysis of various economic issues and information. When I engage in trade, economic situation analysis will be urgently needed.

ABOUT LIFE IN RUSSIA

The first thing you should do to easily adapt to a new environment is to prepare well and study local culture, climate and customs. You should also provide yourselves with necessary things and food you like as it is difficult to get used to life in a new country in the beginning. Besides, it is important to prepare all required documents such as your passport, visa, student ID card, etc.

Secondly, active integration into local life is important. When you come to Russia, try to make new friends and immerse yourselves in the culture and language of the country. If you face the language barrier, don't be afraid to use your knowledge of the Russian language to communicate with local citizens, don't be shy and don't avoid this.

Besides, make the most of the university's resources while studying abroad. For example, take part in entertainment events to relax as well as attend lectures and training courses. These events will not only deepen your knowledge but also expand your circle of contacts.

As far as your life is concerned, it is important to learn to live independently. Learn how to allocate your expenses and do shopping reasonably and develop good habits.

The university has a great stadium where you can run. It is important for you to take care of your health, manage your time, and boost your mood. Finally, abide by local laws and the university rules. Respect local customs and religious beliefs and don't partake in any illegal activities. Take care of yourselves and look after your belongings.



RUSSIAN TRADITIONS AT A GLANCE

Russia is a country with a rich culture and traditions. Many of them are related to festivals, hospitality and special customs. Let's get acquainted with some of them to better understand how Russian people live and relax.

MERRY MASLENITSA

Maslenitsa (Pancake Week) is one of the funniest and brightest festivals in Russia. It lasts a whole week and signifies saying goodbye to winter and welcoming spring. During this time, people make pancakes, a traditional Russian dish. They are round as a sun and symbolize warmth and light. People make pancakes for a whole week and treat their friends and relatives with them. You can eat pancakes, for example, with jam, sour cream, honey, or caviar, etc. Maslenitsa traditions include fairs, open celebrations, and sledding. On Forgiveness Sunday at the end of Maslenitsa Week, people ask their relatives and friends for forgiveness for offending them. And, at the end of the festival, they burn a straw-stuffed doll representing the leaving winter.

Foreign guests visiting Russia consider participation in the Maslenitsa celebration a great piece of luck. Indeed, this is a chance to come in touch with unique Russian culture and see original Russian traditions for themselves.



RUSSIAN HOSPITALITY

If your Russian friends invite you to celebrate a festival, be ready for a warm and generous welcome. Back in the day, guests were greeted with bread and salt. It meant that the hosts wished their guests peace and well. The guest must break off a piece of bread, salt it and eat it. Today this tradition is rather uncommon but it still persists in some cases. For example, at Russian wedding parties, parents greet newlyweds with a loaf of bread and a salt cellar after the wedding ceremony. Moreover, guests of special importance are still greeted with bread and salt.

Holiday feasts are an important part of Russian hospitality. There are always many dishes on the table. Enjoy your meal and feel free to ask questions because Russians like talking about their traditions. And after the feast, they often send treats to their guests. These can be treats such as pies, pickles, or sweets.

SMALL GIFTS WITH BIG LOVE

In Russia, bringing presents is a long-standing and kind tradition. These are small gifts or treats that guests present to hosts when visiting them. There are all kinds of treats such as fruit, sweets, for example, chocolate or cake, or something symbolic, for example, a travel souvenir. When you visit Russian people with treats, you show respect for them and appreciate their hospitality.



RUSSIAN BATH

When it comes to Russian culture, many people imagine matrioshkas (Russian dolls) or snowy landscapes. But there is another tradition that has a special place in the hearts of Russians. This is Russian bath. The bath is a traditional Russian steam room where you can relax and clean your body and soul. In the steam room, people warm up first, and then it comes to a bath broom that is used to pat the body. Bath brooms are made of birch or oak. After the steam room, it is important to cool down by jumping into a plunge tub or taking a cold shower. In winter, you can dry yourself with snow or plunge into an ice hole for this purpose.



After bath procedures, it is customary to drink herbal tea with honey, mint or lime tree leaves. It helps regain strength and enjoy a pleasant smell.



SIT FOR A MOMENT BEFORE THE TRIP

So, you are on a visit to your Russian friends. Before you leave, they can ask you to sit for a moment before your trip. Do not be surprised, it is not a joke or an attempt to keep you longer. Before starting on a trip, Russians often sit for a moment. They believe that if they sit quietly for a while before leaving home, their trip will go smoothly. Today this tradition helps them recollect their thoughts, think if they have taken everything they need, and set themselves up for the upcoming trip.

Russian traditions are not only a tradition but also a part of the Russian people's soul.

Traditions reflect respect for ancestors, love of nature, and the pursuit of warmth and coziness. If you have the occasion to visit Russia, be sure to taste pancakes for Maslenitsa, enjoy the atmosphere of Russian bath and sit for a moment before your trip.

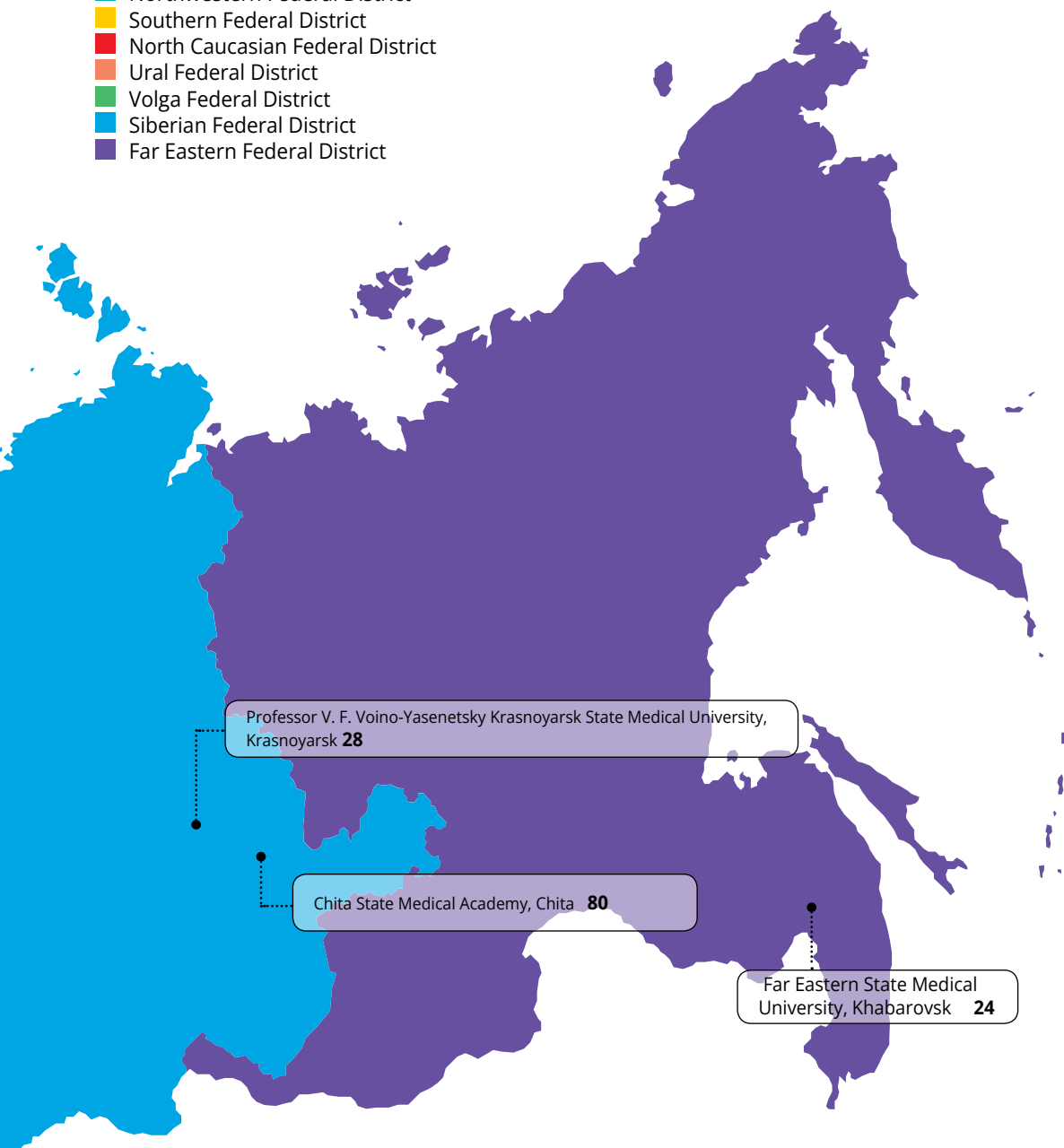


HED Map
