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LEARNING RUSSIAN

Each language is a symbol of the country where it exists and develops. It is a product and a translator of a nation's culture at the same time. No wonder that the global role and importance of a language depend on a country's role and place in the world, in particular, in politics, economy, science, and culture. In the 21st century, Russia's role in global politics and economy becomes more and more prominent, which increases the popularity of the Russian language in large part: an interest in Russia keeps up an interest in the language as well.

Natalia Tatarinova, Dean of the Pre-University Education Department of Pushkin State Russian Language Institute, answers our questions about the aspects of Russian language learning.

How difficult is Russian for foreign citizens?

--Russian is spoken outside Russia, too. Russian is the world's sixth language by popularity among language students and the eighth most spoken language by the number of native speakers. Russian is also one of the official languages in Belarus, Kazakhstan, and other former USSR countries. A total of around 270 million people speak Russian worldwide. Besides, it is considered a world language and has the status of an official language at international organizations such as the UN, UNESCO, the IOC, the IMF, and others. And there is one more interesting fact: Russian is the second most popular internet language.

Russian is difficult to learn: unfamiliar phonetic and intonation structure (e.g., sound [s] or a question without a question word: "Eto tvoj telefon?"/Is this your phone?, six cases, verbs of motion (prijti—

ujti—vyjti—podojti—otojti—zajti—dojti—...). So, to answer the question about how difficult Russian is for foreigners, we have to revise general linguistics.


Russian is a **synthetic language**. What does it mean? Simplifying a convoluted theory, we can say that synthetic languages are languages that convey relationships between words in sentences by way of flexions (endings). And languages that primarily convey relationships between words by way of prepositions and word order are called **analytic**. French and English are analytic languages.

Chinese, Vietnamese, and other languages belong to the group of **isolating languages**. In such languages, words do not change, and relationships between words are conveyed by way of functional words and word order in sentences. A sentence itself is a sequence of unchangeable roots whose boundaries coincide with the word boundaries.

Native speakers of English, French, Chinese languages often choose to study Russian! They find it difficult, but it is possible to learn Russian. Well-developed RFL teaching methods and highly qualified RFL teachers are the keys to success in learning Russian.





? Who learns Russian more easily or less easily?

—To answer this question, let us analyze people who start studying Russian: their age, their language environment, their nationality, and other parameters. There is an exception to every rule. However, we will try to identify some components of effective teaching.

Firstly, does the age of a person who starts studying Russian influence their success? Some people believe that children learn foreign languages (including Russian) better than adults. But it is not quite so. Teaching foreign languages to people of all ages has its advantages. For example, younger children are excellent mimics. They are not afraid to pronounce foreign words and make mistakes in their speech. Adults find it much easier to analyze the similarities and differences between their mother tongue and foreign language, which simplifies the teaching process considerably.

Secondly, the language environment is known to help students to learn the Russian language system, replenish their vocabulary, overcome a language barrier much faster. Also, they have no real challenges while listening and speaking. Given the situation, it is clear that students are temporarily unable to come to Russia. But teachers can simulate the language environment even online if they competently organize the learning process.

Thirdly, nationality is what matters. Russian is easier to learn for native speakers of Slavic languages: East Slavic (Belorussian, Ukrainian), West Slavic (Polish, Czech, Slovak), South Slavic languages (Bulgarian, Serbian, Slovenian, Macedonian).

The similarity between phonetic, lexical, and grammatical systems makes it much easier for international students to learn Russian. But any teacher has students—native speakers of non-Slavic languages and members of non-Slavic cultures, who became proficient in Russian.

Lastly, there are different ways to study the language: by yourself or with a teacher. If you study the language with a teacher, you should take into account their qualification. International students' success in learning Russian also depends on their teachers' professional competence. Competent teachers have the methods of teaching Russian as a foreign language at their fingertips. They are aware of the psychological and socio-cultural characteristics of international students. They can choose the textbooks and study guides that will help achieve their teaching goals.





You can start studying Russian at any age, preferably in the language environment. But you should not think that it is impossible to simulate the language environment online. The most important thing is that **the language will be easier to learn for students who work with real professionals. Professional teachers are highly proficient in RFL teaching methods, can teach foreigners to speak, read and write in Russian, open the world of Russian culture for them, regardless of their students' age, ethnic and other characteristics.** $\sim \sim \sim$

However, everybody shares an opinion that studying the Russian language and Russian culture in general is exciting. It is no secret that the best way to learn the language is to immerse in the language environment and constantly communicate with native speakers. So though seemingly impossible to overcome all difficulties, students master the language. Some start speaking fluently, reading the best classic Russian books.

DOCUMENT EXECUTION GUIDE, PART 1

Every person applying to a Russian university has been dreaming of seeing their last name on the enrollment order. Success in entrance exams is a significant part of the whole thing.

However, no international student can

do without properly executed entry and registration documents.

Here is a detailed university case study guide for you to be mindful of all aspects of obtaining a visa, migration registration, and health coverage.

HOW TO GET A STUDENT VISA

What is a student visa? A visa is the permission to enter and stay in Russia issued by the authorized government body.

Who obtains it?—Foreign citizens or stateless persons, if they come to earn an academic degree in Russia.

What are the grounds for obtaining a visa?—An entry invitation executed by local offices of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Russia at the request of educational institutions.

What is the visa validity period?—A single entry visa is issued for three months and is extended every year.

Where do I obtain my visa?—At the Russian consular institution or the visa application center at your place of permanent residence.

Students from visa countries should prefer to apply for a short-term student visa. You can have some other non-student visa only while taking entrance exams, but you will have to leave Russia and reenter with a student visa to be enrolled.

PASPORT

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5 STEPS TO OBTAINING A STUDENT VISA

GETTING AN INVITATION

To get an invitation, foreign citizens must submit the package of documents to the chosen university (check out the procedures for legalization and recognition of academic credentials in Issue 6 of HED). When applying within the quota, applicants send their documents to Russian House (formerly called Rossotrudnichestvo), take entrance exams in their country of permanent residence (see more information in Issue 5).

You will have to wait for an invitation for approximately 45 days. It will be valid for three months. Within these months, you must settle the issue of further stay in Russia: sign a contract with the university or return home if you did not manage to enter the university.

Stamp duty on the issue of an invitation to study in state-accredited academic programs does not apply.

BUYING INSURANCE

Any insurance company operating in the Russian Federation issues health insurance policies. Compare the service packages on the websites of insurance companies and choose a suitable option. Insurance will cost approximately **4,000–20,000 RUB per year**, depending on the scope.

GETTING AN HIV CERTIFICATE

You can get it at health care centers. You must fill It out in Russian and English or get its notarized translation into Russian. The certificate is valid for three months. The fee is **1,000—3,000 RUB**.

PREPARING A VISA APPLICATION FORM

Fill out the application form on the website **visa.kdmid.ru**. You must print it out and glue the photos to it. You need two 3.5 x 4.5 cm photos (black and white or color). If it is not technically feasible to provide the information in electronic format, you are allowed to fill out the visa application form in the handwritten or printed form.



PAYING CONSULAR FEES

Overall visa fees also depend on consular fees collected in a foreign state. You can get detailed information about visa fees on the website of a relevant Russian consular institution abroad. For European Union citizens, the visa fee is 35 Euro, and it doubles in case of urgent visa processing (not more than three calendar days). You will also have to pay for the annual extension of the visa. The stamp duty is **1,600 RUB**.



IMPORTANT!

 The list of visa application documents can be expanded. For detailed information, contact the Russian diplomatic institution in your country.

 Check the expiration date of your international passport or any other ID document. It must be valid for at least 1.5 years from the visa issuance date.

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Invitation to enter Russia (form)

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The consular institution processes visas only after applicants or their legal representatives submit a complete package of documents. After submitting the documents and paying the fee, foreign citizens get a receipt specifying the visa preparation dates. They must submit it to obtain their visa. The usual response time after submitting the documents is two-three weeks.



As soon as you get your visa, check it to make sure all your personal information is correct: last name, travel dates, passport number, date of birth, etc. If you notice some errors, give the visa back for correction at once.

You can obtain an initial visa at the Russian Embassy/consulate in your country of residence. It is valid for not more than 90 days. Later, this visa must be extended by the General Administration for Migration Issues of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Russia. There you will get a multiple entry visa for one year. Within this year, you can stay in Russia, leave and come back. After your visa expires, you must extend it every year until you graduate. Every time you extend your visa, you must apply for migration registration again. We will talk about it a little bit later.

HOW TO EXTEND YOUR STUDENT VISA?

You should contact the university's passport and visa support department not later than 45 days before your current visa expires and submit your document package, which usually includes:

- A completed application form
- 3.5 x 4.5 cm photo
- Copies of all passport pages
- A copy of the enrollment agreement or recommendation from the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of Russia
- The university's written request in any format specifying the reason for visa extension
- Stamp duty payment receipt
- A detachable section of arrival notification (you can get it during migration registration)
- The original migration card and its copies

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

Russia maintains a **visa-free regime** with some countries. As a rule, it lasts from 1 to 3 months and is not suitable for permanent stay in Russia. A student visa is not required for students who come to Russian universities from **Belarus**, **Kazakhstan**, **Kyrgyzstan**, **Moldova**, **Tajikistan**, **Azerbaijan**, **Uzbekistan**, **South Ossetia**, **Armenia**, **Abkhazia**, **Ukraine**.

Citizens of **Armenia, Belarus, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan** may enter Russia on their internal (national) passports. Students from other states, including the CIS countries, must have international passports.

If international students have a Russian exit visa document, they will have to leave the country within 15 calendar days upon its receipt. Otherwise, they can be penalized and even deported.



HOW TO GET THE MIGRATION REGISTRATION

For legal residence in Russia, international applicants or students must fill out a migration card and register at their place of stay. Foreign citizens can get the migration registration only at their place of actual residence.

1. FILLING OUT A MIGRATION CARD


- All foreign citizens coming to Russia with a visa and without it must fill out a migration card. It serves as evidence of legal border crossing and is an official document in addition to a passport. You can get a free form on board a plane, on a train, and before going through passport control at the airport or at the railway station. All international students must specify "study" as a purpose of their arrival on their migration card
- Be careful while filling out the card. Otherwise, you will have to spend much time and effort correcting it later. You must fill out all fields in Russian. If you do not know Russian, fill it out using Latin letters. You should write legibly, without erasures and corrections
- After you hand in the card to a staff member of the Border Service, you will get a detachable section of the form. This document will be required for registration at your place of stay
- Your migration card is valid while you are in Russia. When leaving the country, you must hand in your card at border control. Every time you come back, you must fill out a new card

2. GETTING THE MIGRATION REGISTRATION

- Foreign citizens coming to study in Russia must get the migration registration within seven days from the entry date. It is the university that carries out this procedure. The staff member of the international student support department will explain when you must submit the documents
- You must submit the documents for registration within three calendar days after crossing the border. If you have come from a **visa country**, you will get registration for the visa validity period. Students from **visa-free countries** can get the initial registration for 90 calendar days from the entry date. Then you can extend your registration for the enrollment agreement period not exceeding a year from the entry date
- Foreign citizens having a temporary residence permit or a permanent residence permit can get registration at once for the enrollment agreement period not exceeding a year from the entry date
- The place of registration and the residence address must be the same. If you are going to live in the university dormitory, it is the dormitory administration that will be responsible for your migration registration. If you want to rent an apartment, the landlord must register you at the place of its location



REGISTRATION AT THE PLACE OF STAY



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If you register at the university dormitory, it is the university that carries out the migration registration procedures.

If you are absent from the dormitory for over three calendar days running without notifying the administrator about the reasons for your absence, the university is obliged to deregister you.



If you register at the apartment, your landlord must help you get the migration registration every time you exit or re-enter Russia.



3. EXTENDING AN ARRIVAL NOTIFICATION

- You must extend the arrival notification two weeks before it expires. For this, students usually contact the university's international student support department
- You must apply for an arrival notification again to the relevant university department if you are planning to travel around Russia, to check in the hotel, when you leave Russia, come back, change your passport information
- Stamp duty is not charged on migration registration and arrival notification extension

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IMPORTANT!

Non-compliance with the migration regulations is punishable. The amount of a fine depends on the circumstances and the region where the violation was committed.

For example, you will have to pay 5,000— 7,000 RUB (80—115 USD) in Moscow and Saint Petersburg. If you have no required documents, you can be deported, and if you repeatedly violate the migration regulations, a five-year entry ban will apply.



WHAT SHOULD I DO



Is your migration card lost or damaged? Contact the university

damaged? Contact the university or the General Administration for Migration Issues of the Ministry of Internal Affairs, where you are registered, within three days. When you show your passport, visa, student ID card, a detachable section of the notification arrival (you should find out what the document package must include), you will get a free duplicate copy. .

Is your section of the arrival notification form lost? You must report this loss to the General Administration for Migration Issues of the Ministry of Internal Affairs, where you are registered. You can also contact the university's international student support department. After the information check, you will get a free duplicate copy within three days.

4. LEAVING RUSSIA

Foreign citizens must leave the country if they have no current visa, after graduation or exclusion for any reason, early termination of employment. cancellation of a temporary residence permit or a permanent residence permit.

Foreign citizens or stateless persons must obtain a transit visa to leave the country. To obtain it, after the issuance of the enrollment termination order or termination of the employment agreement, foreign citizens must immediately come to the university's passport and visa support department or international student support department to agree upon the time to leave. A transit visa can be only a single entry visa, and it is issued for a period of up to ten days. You must leave the country within these days.

You must submit the following **documents** ten business days before leaving Russia:

- Passport and two copies of all pages
- Migration card and two copies
- A detachable section of the foreign citizen arrival form (registration certificate) and two copies on both sides
- 3 x 4 cm color matte photo
- A receipt for payment of 1,000 RUB stamp duty for a transit visa (you can get the receipt at the university)
- A travel card (plane or train) valid for leaving Russia
- An extract from the enrollment termination or academic leave order, or an extract from the employment agreement termination order

MIGRATION REGISTRATION VIOLATIONS

- The student did not register in due time. Foreign citizens are obliged to inform the General Administration for Migration Issues of their entry to Russia within seven days. For some countries, other dates are provided
- The student informed of their arrival in due time, but the provided information turned out to be incorrect
- The places of registration and residence are different
- The temporary residential registration in Russia expired, but the student did not leave the country

We have roughly described the steps international students must take while entering and leaving Russia. Please note that the procedures for migration registration and registration at the place of residence can have their specific features and can be carried out at the different departments, depending on the university.

Now let us see how to resolve the problems with the assistance of competent staff members from VISU named after Alexander and Nikolay Stoletovs, Peter the Great St. Petersburg Polytechnic University, and Siberian Federal University.



To save its guests the trouble and "pain in the neck" related to migration registration, **Siberian Federal University** delegates this work to its **Social and Cultural Adaptation Group**.

The department staff meets new students at the airport or the railway station and assists them in contacting the admissions office, the bank, the protocol office, and the migration service. SibFU international students do not have to bother themselves with dates, documents for registration, specific features of their submission. The assistant explains what they should do step by step and supports them throughout all steps. At **Peter the Great St. Petersburg Polytechnic University**, it is the university's **passport and visa support department** that executes the documents for the registration of students in the dormitories.

If an international student lives in a rented apartment, the apartment owner (landlord) will register them for 90 days or the visa validity period at the Multiservice Center or the Migration Department of the Administration of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Russia in the landlord's district.

To register at the dormitory address, international students must:


- Prepare the documents required for initial registration for 90 calendar days or the visa validity period. Document copies must be of good quality, with recognizable faces and readable text:
 - originals of passport and migration card
 - copies of all passport pages and migration card
 - Form-1 from the dormitory, original
- Send the document copies or come to the university's passport and visa support department with the documents and submit them for initial registration
- On the appointed day, collect the ready documents confirming their registration at their place of stay

To register at their place of residence in a rented apartment, international students must:

- Agree upon registration with the landlord
- Get the registration with their landlord's assistance at the Multiservice Center of the district where the rented apartment is located (the list of conditions and documents should be checked in advance)
- Submit a copy of the initial registration certificate and migration card to the university's passport and visa support department

Dates for migration registration of foreign citizens at private addresses:

- 30 calendar days—for citizens of **Belarus**, **Kazakhstan**, **Armenia**, **Kyrgyzstan**
- 15 calendar days—for citizens of Tajikistan
- 7 business days—for citizens of all other visa and visa-free countries

FOLLOW THESE RULES TO AVOID DEPORTATION

TIPS FROM UNIVERSITIES

? What should I do if I did not return to the place of my registration in time for any reason?

SPbPU: Foreign citizens must have the originals or certified copies of their current documents: international passport, migration card, registration certificate.

What should I do if I have been invited over to another region?

VISU: If you are going to visit another region, you should inform the Center of International Education (Dean's Office for International Students) of your trip in advance. You must also inform the dormitory staff if you live in the dormitory and coordinate the travel dates with the Dean's Office. Besides, you had better travel during your study-free time.

You must bring along your passport, foreign citizen arrival notification (registration certificate), migration card, and a VHI policy. After coming back, do not forget to inform the Center of International Education of your arrival.

SPbPU: If foreign citizens visit another region, they must bring along their current documents, notify the passport and visa support department about the dates of their departure and return. Upon arrival in Saint Petersburg, they must get a new registration at their place of stay (in case of reregistration in the region).

SibFU: If you are planning a trip, notify the SibFU's Protocol Department in advance at +7 391 206-39-44. Get ready to submit electronic ticket copies.

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? What should I do if I have lost my documents?

VISU: If you **have lost an important personal document**, you must inform the university's competent service, the Center of International Education in our case. The staff will tell you how to act in a difficult situation, what you should do to have the lost documents re-issued.

If you have lost the most important document the passport, you must report your loss to the police at once. You will get a certificate that confirms an acceptance of your application. With this certificate, contact a consular division of your country's embassy. You will get further instructions there.

Much depends on your country's legislation. Sometimes you can get a passport at the embassy. In some cases, foreign citizens must leave for their country to get a passport. In the latter case, the consulate will issue a "homecoming certificate" that will allow you to leave for your country of permanent residence without any obstacles.

If you have lost your migration card and/or registration certificate, inform a competent university staff member about it. They will schedule your appointment with the office of the Administration of the Ministry of Internal Affairs. Here you will report your loss and get necessary instructions on obtaining duplicate copies.

SPbPU: If an international student has lost their documents: international passport/ID, migration card, registration certificate, they must contact the university's passport and visa support department. The department staff will consult them and help them have their documents re-issued.

SibFU: You must immediately contact the Social and Cultural Adaptation Group at +7 902 966-13-60 for further instructions.

? What should I do if the police have arrested me?

SPbPU: International students must always have current documents or their certified copies: international passport, migration card, registration certificate.

SibFU: If the police have arrested you for any reason, you should immediately inform the Social and Cultural Adaptation Group at +7 902 966-13-60.

? What should I do if I have been hospitalized for a few days?

VISU: The first thing that can help you in case of illness is a health insurance policy.

There are a lot of VHI policies in Russia—different companies offer all kinds of insurance. Act responsibly while choosing a package of services in the policy. You should take into consideration your state of health, chronic diseases.

If hospitalized, you must inform, first of all, a competent university staff member. At VISU, contact the Center of International Education. You can write or call yourself or ask your friends to do it. For such cases, you must always have the contacts of the international student support department. If you have no such contacts, try to inform any university representative—advisor, teacher, Dean's Office staff member, campus staff member and ask them to pass the information along to the international services. You must explain in detail what has happened, where you are, whether you have contacted the insurance company, and what you need now.

You must also inform your advisor or group monitor so that your stay in the hospital does not disrupt your academic progress. Be sure to get a hospital certificate specifying your diagnosis and doctor's advice.

SPbPU: If an international student is hospitalized for any length of time, they are registered there according to the law. So, their registration, effective up to that moment, is suspended.

While being discharged, you must get back your registration certificate from the hospital. With this certificate and the package of documents, international students living in the university dormitories must contact the passport and visa support department within three days for a new registration in the dormitory.

International students living at private addresses must register at this address by contacting the landlord.

SibFU: In case of a serious illness or an injury requiring hospitalization, you must inform the Social and Cultural Adaptation Group at +7 902 966-13-60 or by e-mail oska@sfu-kras.ru.

After being discharged, on the very first business day, you must register again at the SibFU's Protocol Department. You must bring along your passport, migration card, a statement from the dormitory, two copies of passport pages with markings, and two copies of your migration card (on both sides).





ENTRY TO RUSSIA DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

By order of the Government of the Russian Federation as of the end of March 2021, international students, PhD students, medical residents, participants of preparatory courses are allowed to return to Russia to continue their studies. Only citizens of the countries recommended by the Russian Federal State Agency for Health and Consumer Rights as states with a safe epidemiological situation will be allowed to enter Russia.

As of the date of the order, Russia only receives students from the following countries:



The list of countries will be regularly updated. You can monitor the situation via your accounts on universities' websites and their official pages on social media platforms.

- International students must inform the university about their entry date by email at least ten days before their arrival
- You must take a COVID-19 PCR test not earlier than three calendar days before you arrive in Russia. If the result is negative, you must obtain a corresponding document in Russian or English in your country
- You must take a PCR retest within 72 hours after entering Russia—you will not be allowed to attend your classes without it. Until you get the test results, you will have to follow lockdown rules at your place of residence. You will have your classes online

If international students who arrived in Russia develop the first acute respiratory disease symptoms (fever, sore throat, runny nose, cough) during self-isolation, they must immediately inform the university and call a doctor.

Detailed information on what must be done before arrival in Russia and within the first weeks after arrival will be sent to all international students by email, posted on the universities' websites and social media platforms.



Upon arrival, all foreigners are met by the university staff, accompanied to the dormitory (2 campuses), and helped with accommodation. International students occupy three separate floors, living in 2-3-person rooms.

The accommodation fee is **9,600 RUB** (704 \$ at the exchange rate of the Central Bank as of February 15, 2021) per year.



FEELING SECURE

The university and dormitory have access control systems. Each entry point has turnstiles with builtin contactless card readers. Students living in the dormitory get single electronic access cards to enter the university and dormitory. These measures ensure anti-terrorist security according to Russian legislation.



REGIONAL SPECIFIC FEATURES

The Lipetsk Region is located in Central European Russia, 500 km from Moscow. It is a large industrial region with a few open economic zones and one of Russia's largest steel mills.

Lipetsk is an administrative center of the Lipetsk Region, a special industrial economic zone, and a major metallurgy center. The city founded thanks to Peter the Great was recognized as the most welldesigned Russian city in 2005.

The population of Lipetsk is > **500,000 people**.

The climate is moderately continental, with warm summer and moderately cold winter. All seasons are well-defined.

PLACES OF INTEREST

The Lipetsk mineral springs with chloride and sulfate water were discovered in 1805. The city obtained the status of a resort center. The chemical content of Lipetsk mineral water is similar to that of the mineral waters of famous German resorts Liebenstein and Termont.

The famous **Novolipetsk steel mill** located on the left bank of the Voronezh river is almost as big as the city!

The Galichya Mountain reserve has plants that are completely uncharacteristic of the Russian Plain.

The Kudykina Mountain amusement park is located near Kamenka village. It has attractions for kids, a reserve with exotic animals, a wooden fortress, and a small lake with a beach.

GASTRONOMIC SPECIALTIES

The Lipetsk Region is rich in numerous gastronomic specialties. Here you can taste the most delicious cucumbers, white kvass with thyme, pancake cake, monastery honey, and even local wine (over 130 grape varieties are grown in the region), duck and cabbage soup simmered in the Russian stove, many liquors made from local berries and herbs.



ADAPTATION

The teachers actively help students during both classes and extracurricular activities, improving their oral communication skills and replenishing their ethnic and cultural knowledge.

International students take part in various educational and mass cultural events such as student fairs, the **Russian Language Club** meetings.

At the **International Friendship Club**, students tell about their native countries, share their customs and traditions, show national costumes, perform songs and dances.

The tutor helps international newcomers with their adaptation. The psychologist assists in resolving complex life problems and conflicts. Joint meetings are regularly organized in the dormitories.

The most creative students take part in making videos for student social media platforms.

To familiarize students with Russian customs and traditions, the university organizes tours around the city and region, to theaters, museums, exhibitions of all kinds. In winter, students go to the **ski resort** and take part in Russian winter entertainments.





In my country, I completed my Bachelor's degree in microbiology and chemistry. Then I studied for a year in a Master's program. Later I entered TPU Master's program in Nuclear Science and Technology with a specialization in nuclear medicine. TPU delivers this program at an operating facility. I have studied for more than a year, and I am not disappointed. I believe that TPU is the best Russian university to offer this program. The program is very popular with African students because the number of cancer patients has considerably increased on the African continent. The development of nuclear medicine has become a fundamental issue for many African countries.

South Africa already has the equipment to treat these patients. However, there is a shortage of personnel able to work with it. Here I can get the skills to work with this equipment. When I return to South Africa, I will not need time to undergo additional training. I will be able to work in the field of nuclear medicine on the equipment already available there.

There are nuclear reactors in South Africa. One of them, in Pretoria, produces radioisotopes. I hope I will find a job as a specialist in the production of medical radioisotopes.

I pursued the unique TPU program in Nuclear Power Plants: Design, Operation and Engineering. Egyptian students enrolled in the program within the quota of the Russian Ministry of Science and Higher Education. Graduates will have a chance to get a job at Rosatom enterprises in Egypt and nuclear research centers.

I liked the Russian education system very much. The subjects I studied were very useful and gave me much theoretical and practical knowledge. If you asked me to assess the quality of training, I'd give TPU 300 points out of 100.

A lot of practical training is what makes studying at the TPU different. This is very important for our profession. Egypt doesn't offer such opportunities.

I am going to return to my home country and work at El Dabaa nuclear power plant, which is now under construction. I am sure my knowledge will be of use to me in my future career.





Its ensemble includes Saint Isaac's Cathedral, the Monument to Nickolas I, Mariinsky Palace, administrative buildings, hotels, the Blue Bridge over the Moyka River. The square is included in the UNESCO World Heritage List.

> **Palace Square** has a few historical and architectural landmarks. Among them are the former residence of Russian emperors—Winter Palace, the Small Hermitage, the New Hermitage, the General Staff building with Triumphal Arch, the Alexander Column dedicated to the Russian victory in the war with Napoleon's France. The square is included in the UNESCO World Heritage List.

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Senate Square is one of the city's oldest architectural centers. On the north side, it looks out on Neva. You can see Saint Isaac's Cathedral behind Alexander Garden on the south side. The Senate Building and the Synod Building are on the west side, and the Admiralty is on the east side. Bronze Horseman, the monument to Russian emperor Peter the Great, is a calling card of the square and a symbol of the city.





Adapters is a program that helps first-year students adapt to a new learning environment and new people.

The university is located in the northwestern part of Saint Petersburg.





HOW TO GET A HEALTH INSURANCE POLICY

A VHI policy is one of the most important documents required to apply for a student visa (see above), and all Russian universities require students to have it from the first day of their stay in Russia. So you should buy insurance in advance before leaving your country. When you come to Russia, you will be able to extend your insurance policy after it expires or apply for a new one.

If foreign citizens have no policy, they

violate the law and have to pay the fine of

obtaining a 086/V certificate. This certificate is submitted to the admissions office with other documents and is required for student dormitory check-in.



You should bear in mind that a health insurance policy does not cover all diseases. It only covers those falling under the insured event criteria. The list of such circumstances is governed by the agreement concluded by the parties at the moment of policy issuance.

You should realize that buying insurance is not only a legislative requirement. It also guarantees the protection of a student's health. It is easy enough for international applicants or students to get a VHI policy. You can choose a required package of services yourself on the official websites of insurance companies. You can also seek advice from the university specialists from the international student support department. They will

offer you a list of insurance companies that have agreements with the university.

If an insured event occurs, you must:

- Call the hotline number specified in the agreement
- Give the insured's full name
- Give the insurance program name
- Give the VHI policy number
- Give the policy period
- Describe your sensations and symptoms of the disease
- Give your exact location
- Give your contact phone number

Who assists applicants/students with health coverage?

—Students apply for a policy themselves. They can contact the insurance company directly or the university's international student support department.

Besides, insurance company staff consult students at the university or at the admissions office at a fixed time. And it is an insured who chooses a company.

Applicants or students can seek advice from the university on choosing an insurance company. They will get the necessary guidance there. Universities carry out an initial analysis of programs, including coverage for insured events, risks, cost. University staff will help you choose the one which is most suitable for a foreign citizen.

? What documents must students have to get health insurance? What deadlines must they meet?

—As you know, you must have a health insurance policy when applying to a university. To obtain a policy, you must have a passport (passport translation), registration information, and a student ID card (if any). If you appear in person, you will get your policy on the same day. If you send your documents by email, the policy will be ready in time.

What medical aid can students get if they have a policy?

—A VHI policy provides guaranteed medical aid if an insured event occurs.

You can get outpatient care, in-patient dental care, emergency medical care, depending on the chosen program. It can also include the services of compulsory medical examination and/or repatriation.

Without a policy, you will only get free emergency medical care. Life-threatening conditions will be relieved, but you will have to pay for follow-up examination and treatment.

What health service packages would you advise students to choose?

—You must check the minimum requirements for the program scope with the university.

We recommend that you buy the abovementioned VHI package program and consider buying extended coverage programs.

What should students do in case of force majeure, for example, if an accident happens?

—If an insured event occurs, you must contact a 24-hour medical helpline at the insurance company at the phone number specified in the policy.

For how long do students conclude the agreement when applying for a health insurance policy? Who is responsible for its renewal?

—The standard policy period is one calendar year. When it expires, you must conclude a new agreement. Applicants and students can renew the policy themselves by contacting the insurance company directly or ask the university's international student support department for help.

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
